### ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Cedar Rapids Kernels 9-2 at Rise 2 Greatness Field.](#)

Wisconsin hitters had thirteen hits and drew ten walks in the game while pitchers Cameron Wagoner and Stiven Cruz combined for ten strikeouts and two walks.

**HITCH YOUR WAGON:** Wagoner is 4-0 in his last five appearances. Last night he allowed four hits, walked one, and struck out five over five innings. The only run he allowed was a solo homer by Andrew Cossetti in the fourth inning. Wagoner is 3-0 in August and has allowed three runs with three walks and seventeen strikeouts over 14-2/3 innings this month.

**FIRST!** Cruz earned his first professional save with his four innings of work last night. He allowed four hits, walked one, and struck out five. The only run he allowed was a two-out, solo homer in the ninth by Jefferson Morales.

**FIVE BY FIVE:** Robert Moore and Ben Metzinger both reached base five times to lead the Wisconsin offense last night. Moore had two singles and three walks. Metzinger had a single, a double, and three walks with two runs and two RBI. Other offensive highlights for Wisconsin were: three RBI for Mike Boeve and two hits for Luis Lara, Hendry Mendez, and Darrien Miller.

**ON ASSIGNMENT:** Jesse Winker went 1-for-3 with a walk and a double with an RBI as Wisconsin's designated hitter last night. Winker was 2-for-6 in his two games with the Rattlers on his rehabilitation assignment for the Milwaukee Brewers.

**ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS:** The current franchise began its existence as the Cedar Rapids Braves, an affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves in the Three-I League, in 1958. That was the same year and league the current Timber Rattlers franchise joined the Three-I League as the Fox Cities Foxes. Both teams moved to the Midwest League when the Three-I League ended after the 1961 season. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels have made the Midwest League playoffs every year they have been affiliated with the Twins, including this year. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, Trevor Hoffman, Brewers Pitching Coach Chris Hook, and Ted Simmons.

**ABOUT THE TWINS:** Minnesota has a long history of in the Midwest League. They started out with Wisconsin Rapids (1964-1983) and moved to Kenosha (1984-1992) and to Fort Wayne (1993-1998) as the franchise moved. Minnesota has also been with Quad Cities (1999-2004) and Beloit (2005-2012) before their current affiliation with Cedar Rapids Kernels started in 2013.

**PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES:** [MLB Pipeline](#) places seven active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Brock Wilken (#8), Luis Lara (#9), Robert Moore (#17), Mike Boeve (#18), Bradley Blalock (#19), Matthew Wood (#25), and Hendry Mendez (#29). Eric Brown Jr (#12) is currently on Wisconsin's IL. [MLB Pipeline](#) has ten active Kernels on their list of Minnesota prospects: Emmanuel Rodriguez (#3), Cory Lewis (#13), CJ Culpepper (#14), Jose Salas (#17), Kala'i Rosario (#19), Noah Miller (#24), Zebby Matthews (#25), Ben Ross (#26), Alejandro Hidalgo (#28), and Noah Cardenas (#30). Connor Prelipp (#6) is currently on the IL.

## WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP ALEXANDER CORNIELLE:** Milwaukee signed Cornielle as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic on June 15, 2019.

**FAST DEBUT:** Cornielle made his professional debut with one inning of relief against the Cubs #2 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League on August 2, 2019. He allowed one run on no hits with two walks in one inning. Cornielle made three appearances in the DSL in 2019 with no record and one run allowed over four innings.

**HIT PLAY:** Cornielle started the 2021 season with the Brewers Blue affiliate in the Arizona Complex League and was 4-2 in nine games – four starts – with a 4.64 ERA and 50 strikeouts over 33 innings pitched. He was called up to Carolina at the end of the season and was 0-1 in two starts with ten strikeouts in eight innings.

**WEEKLY AWARD:** Cornielle was named the ACL's Pitcher of the Week on September 6, 2021 after his performance against the White Sox on August 31, 2021. He allowed one run on one hit and two walks with six strikeouts over five innings in the game.

**FEELING 2022:** Cornielle was 9-7 in 22 games – 19 starts – with a 3.19 ERA and 124 strikeouts over 101-2/3 innings pitched for the Carolina Mudcats this season before joining the Timber Rattlers on August 23. He was second in the Carolina League in strikeouts and third in the Carolina League in ERA before his promotion to Wisconsin. Cornielle was 1-0 in three starts with Wisconsin and allowed four runs with six walks and 21 strikeouts over 17-1/3 innings pitched.

**LAST START:** Cornielle had a no decision against Dayton on [August 10](#) at home. He allowed a run on three hits with a walk and four strikeouts over five innings. Wisconsin had a 2-1 lead when Cornielle left the game, but the Dragons scored seven runs in the sixth inning and went on to a 9-2 win.

**VS. CEDAR RAPIDS:** Cornielle has no record in two appearances – a start on [May 24](#) and a relief appearance on [July 27](#) – against theernels this season. He has allowed two runs – one earned – on five hits with three walks, a hit batsman, and ten strikeouts over 10-1/3 innings. Misael Urbina has homered against Cornielle this season.

## CEDAR RAPIDS SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP ANDREW MORRIS:** The Minnesota Twins selected Morris in the fourth round of the 2022 draft out of Texas Tech.

**ON THE TABLE:** Morris pitched three seasons (2019-2021) at Colorado Mesa University before attending Texas Tech. Morris was 18-2 with a 3.23 ERA and 215 strikeouts over 175-2/3 innings pitched during his Junior College career.

**AT THE TECH:** Morris was 8-2 in sixteen starts for the Red Raiders in his one season. He had a 4.58 ERA and 91 strikeouts with 28 walks in 88-1/3 innings pitched before the Twins picked him in the draft.

**THERE CAN BE ONLY ONE:** Morris made his pro debut with the Florida Complex League Twins on August 19, 2022 with a scoreless, hitless inning against the FCL Red Sox. Morris walked none and struck out one in his only professional appearance last year.

**MUSSEL BEACH:** Morris started the 2023 season with Fort Myers in the Florida State League. He was 3-1 with a 2.59 ERA in eleven games – ten starts. Morris walked eleven and struck out 52 over 49-2/3 innings pitched with Fort Myers before his promotion to Cedar Rapids on July 24.

**LAST START:** Morris won at Quad Cities on [August 11](#). He allowed an unearned run on four hits with a walk and three strikeouts over five innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Morris made his Midwest League debut in a start against the Timber Rattlers in Wisconsin on [July 30](#). He allowed four runs on ten hits with no walks and two strikeouts over five innings. Jose Acosta hit a three-run homer in the fourth inning of the game and the Rattlers would win the game 4-0.

### THIS DATE IN TIMBER RATTLERS HISTORY

**August 17, 2002:** The Rattlers Clinton 7-1 at home. The story of this game happened before the game started. Phil Cullen was the scheduled starting pitcher for Wisconsin, but he broke his arm while warming up in the bullpen before the game. John Corcoran stepped in as the emergency starting pitcher and he pitched five scoreless innings while allowing one hit. Corcoran faced the minimum (15 batters) because he gave up a lead-off single to Josh Labandeira to start the game before picking him off 1-3-6. Corcoran retired the next 14 in a row. John Cole and Jason Van Meetren each homered, and Shin-Soo Choo had three hits for Wisconsin.

**August 17, 2003:** The Rattlers won 2-1 at Battle Creek. Wisconsin had four hits in the game, but one of those hits was a two-run home run by Jon Nelson in the sixth inning that erased a 1-0 Yankee lead. Bobby Livingston allowed one run over 8-1/3 innings for his fourteenth win of the season.
