INDEPENDENCE DAY: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the South Bend Cubs 9-1 at Four Winds Field.](#) Justin Jarvis allowed one run and struck out eleven over seven innings for his seventh win of the season. Joe Gray Jr, Ashton McGee, and Jose Acosta hit home runs for the Rattlers.

JUST INCREDIBLE: Jarvis went 1-2 with a 7.91 ERA, twelve walks, and fifteen strikeouts over 19-1/3 innings in five starts during April. Since the calendar flipped to May, Jarvis is 6-1 with a 2.44 ERA, 21 walks, and 84 strikeouts over 62-2/3 innings in eleven starts. On Monday, he matched his single-game high as a pro for innings pitched and strikeouts. Jarvis is the Midwest League leader in innings pitched (82.0), tied for the league lead in wins (7), and is second in strikeouts (99). Teammate Antoine Kelly leads with 100 strikeouts.

GOING DEEP: Gray gave Wisconsin a 1-0 lead with a solo home run off MLB rehabber Drew Smyly in the fourth inning. It was Gray's tenth home run of the season. McGee hit a two-run homer later in the inning. McGee has homered in three of his last four games. Acosta hit a two-run home run against Daniel Palencia in the fifth inning and the Rattlers were up 5-0.

IT GOES TO ELEVEN: Xavier Warren was 1-for-3 with two walks on Monday to move his current hitting streak to eleven games. Warren has the longest hitting streak by a Timber Rattler this year.

STARTING STRONG IN THE SECOND HALF: The Timber Rattlers are 9-1 to open the second half of the season. This is the best ten-game start to the second half in team history.

SIX-PACK: The Timber Rattlers are on a six-game winning streak. This is the second six-game winning streak of the season for the Rattlers. The last seven-game winning streak by Wisconsin was from June 2 through June 9, 2014. The last time the Timber Rattlers had a season with two winning streaks of six or more games was in 2012. The 2012 Rattlers had winning streaks of six, seven, and eight games.

ABOUT SOUTH BEND: The South Bend Cubs started as the South Bend White Sox when the Midwest League added them as an expansion team in 1988. They changed their name to the Silver Hawks for the 1994 season and became an affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks in 1997. South Bend became an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs. South Bend won Midwest League pennants in 1989, 1993, 2005, and 2019. Notable alumni for the South Bend franchise include Mike Cameron, Jose Valverde, Chris Capuano, Mark Reynolds, Justin Upton, Wade Miley, Chase Anderson, Keon Broxton, Gleyber Torres, Ian Happ, and Carlos Gonzalez. Terry Francona was the manager of the South Bend White Sox in 1982.

ABOUT THE CUBS: The Chicago Cubs had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in South Bend in 2015. They were affiliated with Quincy from 1965 through 1973 before leaving the Midwest League. The Cubs returned to the MWL with an affiliation with Quad Cities from 1979 through 1984, Peoria from 1985 through 1994 and again from 2005 through 2012, Rockford from 1995 through 1998, Lansing from 1999 through 2004, Kane County in 2013 and 2014.

FIRST HALF: South Bend finished the first half 34-32. They stumbled to the line as they dropped nine out of twelve games to start June. The Cubs put together a ten-game winning streak as they won the final two games of the first half and the first eight games of the second half. That streak was snapped with a 9-3 loss at Beloit on July 3.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: [MLB Pipeline](#) puts five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Tyler Black (#7), Joe Gray Jr. (#13), Antoine Kelly (#14), Russell Smith (#16), and Xavier Warren (#17). Carlos Rodriguez (#21) is on the Wisconsin injured list. [MLB Pipeline](#) has ten current South Bend players on their Top 30 list of Chicago Cubs prospects: Peter Crow-Armstrong (#3), Jordan Wicks (#6), Owen Cassie (#8), DJ Herz (#9), Kohl Franklin (#12), Ed Howard (#14), Yohendrick Pinango (#20), Pablo Aliendo (#21), Jordan Nwogu (#23), and Daniel Palencia (#25).

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP ISRAEL PUELLO: Acquired by Milwaukee as a player to be named later from in a trade that sent David Phelps to the Philadelphia Phillies on August 31, 2020. Puello, Juan Geraldo, and Brandon Ramey were announced at the PTBNL on September 18, 2020.

ORIGIN STORY: Puello was signed by the Phillies out of the Dominican Republic on July 2, 2017.

FIGHTIN' PHIL: Puello pitched two seasons (2018 and 2019) for the Phillies White affiliate in the Dominican Summer League. He went 4-6 with a 4.52 ERA in fourteen starts in 2018 and 2-1 with a 1.92 ERA in fifteen starts in 2019. Puello had 143 strikeouts over 131-1/3 innings pitched. Puello was named a DSL All-Star in 2019.

WHAT'S BREWING? Puello was 1-4 with a 4.94 ERA in ten starts for the Brewers Gold affiliate in the Arizona Complex League in 2021. He walked nine and struck out 37 over 27-1/3 innings pitched.

SWEET CAROLINA: Puello was 3-7 in thirteen games – six starts – with a 5.51 ERA and 61 strikeouts over 49 innings pitched for the Carolina Mudcats before joining the Timber Rattlers on June 28. Puello was 0-2 in four games – two starts in June...BUT, he had a 3.38 ERA, opponents were hitting just .192 against him, and he had sixteen strikeouts over sixteen innings in June.

LAST START: Puello [won his Midwest League debut on June 30](#). He allowed one run on three hits with a walk and seven strikeouts over five innings against the Cedar Rapids Kernels at home.

VS. SOUTH BEND: Puello has never faced the Cubs prior to this evening. He picked up the save with two innings of relief work against Myrtle Beach, the Carolina League affiliate of the Chicago Cubs, on [June 9, 2022](#). Puello allowed a run on a hit with two walks and three strikeouts to close out a win for the Carolina Mudcats.

SOUTH BEND STARTING PITCHER:

LHP JORDAN WICKS: The Chicago Cubs picked Wicks in the first round – 21st overall – in the 2021 draft out of Kansas State. MLB Pipeline ranks Wicks as the #6 prospect in the Cubs system. *Baseball America* rates Wicks at #6 in their mid-season update of Cubs prospects.

WILD, CAT: Wicks pitched at Kansas State from 2019 through 2021. He was 15-6 with a 3.24ERA in 34 starts at Kansas State. He walked 58 and struck out 230 in 203 innings pitched over his career. Wicks was named First Team All-Big Twelve and a Third Team All-American. He was the first Kansas State player to be named an All-American since 2013.

NORTH WOODS: Wicks pitched for the Rockford Rivets during the 2020 Northwoods League season. He made four starts and had 29 strikeouts over 20 innings pitched.

SOUTH BEND: Wicks joined the South Bend Cubs in September of 2021 after signing with Chicago. He had no record in four starts and allowed four runs on seven hits with three walks and five strikeouts over seven innings pitched with South Bend last season.

LAST START: Wicks [beat Beloit on the road on June 29](#). He allowed a run on three hits with no walks and five strikeouts over five innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Wicks had a [no decision against the Timber Rattlers in Wisconsin on May 19](#). He allowed one run on three hits with two walks and eight strikeouts over five innings and left the game with a 2-1 lead. Wisconsin tied the game with a run in the bottom of the ninth. South Bend won the game 3-2 in ten innings.
