CIRCLE CITY ROUNDUP

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Columbus Clippers slugged three home runs and defeated the Indianapolis Indians on Saturday night at Huntington Park, 12-0. Home run trouble arrived early for Indianapolis in the bottom of the first inning. Will Wilson walked and Travis Bazzana singled to begin the rally. It was capped when Jonathan Rodriguez clubbed his 11th home run of the season over the left-center field wall. In the bottom of the third, Wilson began the inning for Columbus with a single. Bazzana then hammered a ball on a line over the wall in right field for a two-run blast. Bazzana would do it again in the fifth when he led off the inning with a homer over the right-center field wall. The two blasts in Saturday's contest were the second and third home runs of the series for the 2024 top overall pick, his first was a walk-off blast on Thursday night. Columbus capped the scoring in the bottom of the eighth with a six-run rally. It was highlighted by a trio of hits from Dayan Fries, Milan Tolentino and Petey Halpin. Indianapolis' offense was held in check by four different Clippers' pitchers. Starter Doug Nikhazy worked two frames, but Will Dion earned the victory as he handled the bulk work out of the bullpen. The left-hander limited the Indians to two hits over four shutout innings. Nick Dombkowski started for Indy and allowed six runs in the loss.

RAFA RAKES: Rafael Flores continued to contribute at the plate in last night's contest, drawing a walk. His streak of four straight multi-hit performances ended as he did so for the first time since June 21-25 with Double-A Somerset and had four consecutive games with an RBI for the first time since June 28-July 2 (2) with Somerset. He has hit safely in 12 of his last 16 games since Aug. 20 at Syracuse. Across this span, he is hitting .407 (24-for-59) with two doubles, one triple, five homers, 17 RBI and a 1.184 OPS. In 29 games with the Indians since being traded from New York (AL), Flores is hitting .315 (34-for-108) with 14 runs, four doubles, one triple, five home runs, 22 RBI, 13 walks and a .901 OPS.

ON-BASE BOWEN: Jase Bowen is on a tear over his last seven games since Aug. 30, reaching safely in all of them and hitting safely in six of those, including four straight. In this span, he is hitting .375 (9-for-24) with two runs, three doubles, two triples, two RBI, three walks, two stolen bases and a 1.111 OPS.

NICK IS THERE IN A PINCH: On Thursday night, Nick Solak led off the top of the ninth inning as a pinch hitter in a 3-2 game and tied the contest with a 100.0 mph, 369-foot blast for his 14th home run of the season. Solak owns both Indianapolis pinch-hit homers this season, with his last coming on April 27 at St. Paul. He joined Will Robertson as the only minor leaguers with two pinch hit homers on the campaign. Robertson collected both of his with Triple-A Buffalo. Solak is the first Indians player with two-plus pinch-hit longballs in a single season since Brendt Citta hit a pair in 2022. As one of Minor League Baseball's best hitters in 2025, Solak has reached safely in 90 of 100 games this season and has hit safely in 80 of those.

BRANDAN BLANKS: Brandon Bidiois shined out of the bullpen on Friday night, tossing 2.0 perfect innings to conclude the game and pick up his first Triple-A save. Bidiois is yet to allow a hit or run in five games and 7.2 innings with Indy, walking four and striking out 10. Among all minor leaguers with at least 50.0 innings pitched, he has the lowest batting average against (.114, 21-for-184), lowest OPS against (.355), second-lowest ERA (0.81) and second-lowest hits per nine (3.40). In addition to these stats, he has an 8-0 record across 36 total appearances in 2025.

TODAY'S MATCHUP: The Indianapolis Indians conclude this week's six-game series against the Columbus Clippers today at 1:05 PM at Huntington Park. With a win, Indy can split the series. Tonight's contest decides if the Indians can split the season series against the Clippers with an 8-9 record to date. Indy has not won a season series against Columbus since going 6-5 in 2021 and has not won a series at Columbus since taking three of four games from May 24-27, 2019. Since the 2021 season, Indianapolis is 35-48 (.422) against the club. Taking the mound for Indy is RHP Jarod Bayless who opens a bullpen game. Bayless started Tuesday's series opener, allowing just one run, a solo homer, across 4.2 ninings with one strikeout. Opposite Bayless is LHP John Means, who is set to make his third start on the campaign. In two starts at Louisville in the prior series, Means allowed four earned runs across 7.0 innings with six strikeouts. It marks his first career start against Indianapolis.

ON THIS DATE IN 1984: After winning the American Association pennant with a 91-63 record, the top-seeded Indians lost Game 1, 5-1, and Game 2, 1-0, before securing a shutout win of their own over fourth-seeded Louisville in Game 3, 6-0. Razor Shines and Sal Butera collected home runs, and Tim Burke yielded six hits and one walk with five punchouts over 9.0 stellar innings. The semifinal series concluded on a sour note in Louisville, where Indy dropped Game 4, 10-0, and Game 6, 2-1, to be eliminated from the postseason.
