ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Cedar Rapids Kernels 4-3 at Rise 2 Greatness Field. Wisconsin scored three runs in the first inning and added a run in the ninth for a 4-0 lead. The Kernels scored three runs in the bottom of the ninth to make the score close. Cedar Rapids had the tying run at second base when the game ended.

OUT OF THE BLOCKS: Luke Adams drove in the first run of the game with a sacrifice fly. Ramón Rodríguez added a two-out, two-run double later in the inning for a 3-0 lead. Wisconsin has outscored opponents 70-24 in the first inning this season.

PEACHY KEEN: Tate Kuehner, the Wisconsin starting pitcher, allowed three hits, walked two and struck out five over five scoreless innings for the win. In his last two starts. Kuehner is 2-0 with eleven scoreless innings while allowing just four hits.

MAKING HIS MARK: Wisconsin reliever Mark Manfredi allowed one hit and struck out five over 2-1/3 scoreless innings. He did not walk a batter.

YOUR IN GOOD HANDS: Matt Wood doubled to start the top of the ninth. The Rattlers designated hitter had three hits, including two doubles, last night. Tayden Hall knocked in an insurance run with a two-out single to score pinch-runner Felix Valerio for a 4-0 lead.

HOLD FAST: Aaron Rund got the final two outs of the eighth inning and the first out of the ninth before a single, a double, an error, and a hit batsman scored a run and brought the tying run to the plate. Rund got the second out with a strikeout before a double off the top of the wall in left from Misael Urbina drove in two runs. Rund ended the game with a strikeout for his fourth save of the season

TOUGH ENDING: Wisconsin left fielder Jheremy Vargas went 3-for-3 with three singles last night. However, Vargas had to leave the game after crashing into the wall trying to catch the ball off Urbina's bat in the bottom of the ninth.

ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS: The current franchise began its existence in 1949 as the Cedar Rapids Rockets, an unaffiliated team in the Central Association. They moved to the Three-I League as the Cedar Rapids Indians as an affiliate of Cleveland in 1950. They were affiliated with the Milwaukee Braves from 1954 through 1962. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels have made the Midwest League playoffs every year they have been affiliated with the Twins, including a Midwest League Championship last season. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, Trevor Hoffman, Brewers Pitching Coach Chris Hook, and Ted Simmons. Hall of Famers John McGraw (1891 Canaries) and Lou Boudreau (1938 Raiders) played for earlier pro teams in Cedar Rapids.

ABOUT THE TWINS: Minnesota has a long history of in the Midwest League. They started out with Wisconsin Rapids (1964-1983) and moved to Kenosha (1984-1992) and to Fort Wayne (1993-1998) as the franchise moved around the league. Minnesota has also been with Quad Cities (1999-2004) and Beloit (2005-2012) before their current affiliation with Cedar Rapids Kernels started in

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Luis Lara (#8), Luke Adams (#15), Jadher Areinamo (#21), and Patricio Aquino (#28). MLB Pi has four active Kernels on their list of Minnesota prospects: Gabriel Gonzalez (#6), Ricardo Olivar (#20), Darren Bowen (#27), and Rayne Doncon (#28). CJ Culpepper (#9) and Danny DeAndrade (#14) are currently on the IL.

THAT CHAMPIONSHIP SEASON: Cedar Rapids is the reigning Midwest League Champion. The Kernels beat the Peoria Chiefs in Game Three of the best-of-three Western Division Finals and the Great Lakes Loons in Game Three of the best-of-three Championship Series to claim their first Midwest League pennant since 1994. The Kernels were 82-50 during the 2023 regular season to finish last year with the best record in the Midwest League.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP WILL RUDY: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Rudy in the fifth round of the 2022 draft out of the California Polytechnic State University, Pomona.

WHAT A SEASON: Rudy was at Cal Poly Pomona for three seasons but had just one full season due to COVID-19 abbreviating 2020 and canceling the 2021 season for the Broncos. In 2022, which was still his freshman season, Rudy went 8-1 with a 3.10 ERA over thirteen starts. He walked fifteen and struck out 96 in 87 innings pitched during that season.

TROPHY ROOM: Rudy was a three-time Pitcher of the Week in the California Collegiate Athletic Association, two-time National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association West Region Pitcher of the Week, a First Team All-CCAA selection, and the CCAA's Most Valuable pitcher last season.

OUR OLD FRIEND FROM POMONA: Rudy was the highest draft selection of a Poly Pomona player since Cody Ponce was picked 55th overall in the 2015 draft. The Brewers also picked Ponce, who pitched for the Timber Rattlers right after the 2015 draft.

THE CAPE: Rudy made one start for Yarmouth-Dennis in the Cape Cod League in 2022 before the draft. He did not pitch in the Brewers system until 2023

THE MUDCAT: Rudy was 5-3 in eighteen starts for Carolina in 2023 for his professional debut. Rudy had a 3.46 ERA, 26 walks, and 69 strikeouts over 80-2/3 innings.

LAST START: Rudy beat West Michigan at home on <u>July 12</u>. He allowed two hits, walked two, and struck out five over five scoreless innings in the game.

VS. CEDAR RAPIDS: Rudy lost at home to the Kernels on <u>April 18</u>. Cedar Rapids got to him for six runs on eight hits over four innings.

CEDAR RAPIDS STARTING PITCHER:

LHP JORDAN CARR: The Minnesota Twins signed Carr as a minor league free agent from the roster of the Utica Unicorns of independent United Shore Baseball League on August 5, 2021.

WELL-TRAVELED: Carr pitched three seasons for the University of North Carolina-Asheville from 2016 through 2019 with a redshirt year in 2017. He transferred to the College of Charleston for 2020 and made four starts before the season was shutdown. Carr finished his college career with the Cougars in 2021 and was 3-3 with three saves in 23 games – six starts. As a Unicorn, Carr was 3-0 with a 1.38 ERA in seven games – five starts.

CLIMBING THE LADDER: Carr started his pro career in the Florida Complex League in 2021 with five relief appearances. In 2022, he spent the entire season with Fort Myers in the Florida State League where he went 6-2 with a 3.84 ERA in fourteen games – ten starts.

LAST SEASON: Carr started 2023 with Cedar Rapids, was promoted to Wichita in August, and pitched for Glendale in the Arizona Fall League after the season ended. In his stops in the Twins system with the Kernels and Wind Surge, Carr was 5-3 with a save and a 2.15 ERA in 22 games – seven starts. In the AFL, he was 1-1 with a 2.57 ERA in six games – four starts.

LAST START: Carr lost at Beloit on <u>July 9</u>. He allowed five runs – three earned – on nine hits over five innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Carr allowed a run on two hits with three walks and three strikeouts over four innings as a reliever for a no decision at Wisconsin on April 19. In 2023, Carr made four relief appearances against the Rattlers and allowed an unearned run with twelve strikeouts over twelve innings. He was 1-0 in those games.
