JULY. 2024:

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Beloit Sky Carp 3-2 in ten innings at ABC Supply Stadium. The Sky Carp scored a run in the second inning on an RBI single by Cam Barstad. Luke Adams tied the game with an RBI single in the fourth. Luis Lara broke a 1-1 tie with a two-run double in the top of the tenth inning to give the Rattlers a 3-1 lead. Bayden Root, who pitched a perfect ninth inning, allowed the placed runner to score in the tenth by closed out the game for his second win. Wisconsin earned their 60th win of the season with last night's victory. The Timber Rattlers are 28 games over .500 for the first time since they were 77-49 on August 24, 2001

**IN THE HUNT:** K.C. Hunt, the Wisconsin starting pitcher scattered six hits and a walk over five innings while allowing one run.

**CRUZ CONTROL:** Stiven Cruz allowed one hit and struck out three over three innings. He faced the minimum with help from a double play in the eighth inning. In five July appearances, Cruz has allowed four hits over nine scoreless innings with six strikeouts.

STAYING HOT IN JULY: Wisconsin is 13-4 in July. The pitching staff has an ERA of 2.09 this month with 174 strikeouts over 151 innings while holding opponents to a .196 average and a .554 OPS. The Wisconsin hitters are batting .245 with a .708 OPS. The Rattlers are outscoring opponents 79-39 this month

MAKING A RUN: The Timber Rattlers have 191 stolen bases this season. Wisconsin needs to average 1.41 stolen bases per game over the final 39 games of this season to set a new club record.

ABOUT BELOIT: The Beloit Sky Carp changed their name from Snappers after the 2021 season. This is Beloit's fourth season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3, 2021. Billy Gardner Jr is in his second season as the manager of the Sky Carp. Prince Fielder, Rickie Weeks, Chris Bosio, Greg Vaughn, Joey Meyer, BJ Surhoff, Tim Dillard, and Mitch Stetter played in Beloit.

ABOUT THE MARLINS: The Florida/Miami Marlins have lots of history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for 2021.

# PITCHING MATCHUP

### WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP PATRICIO AQUINO: The Milwaukee Brewers signed Aquino as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela on January 15, 2021.

LET'S GET IT STARTED: Aquino made his professional debut with the Brewers #1 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League in 2021. He made eleven starts and was 1-2 with a 2.66 ERA and 54 strikeouts in 44 innings pitched.

LET'S GO TO ARIZONA: Aguino was 2-1 with a 4.72 ERA in eight games seven starts - for the Brewers Gold affiliate in the Arizona Complex League during the 2022 season. He had 49 strikeouts over 34-1/3 innings pitched.

ON TO CAROLINA: Aquino was 5-3 with a 2.75 ERA in 21 games - 19 starts - with 86 strikeouts over 88-1/3 innings pitched during the 2023 regular season.

PLAYOFF CALL: Aquino was the starting pitcher for the Mudcats in Game Two of the first round Carolina League playoff series against the Down East Wood Ducks. He had a no decision with six scoreless innings. The Mudcats would lose the game 6-5 in ten innings.

HOW DOES HE RATE? MLB Pipeline rates Aquino as the #28 prospect in the Brewers organization.

LAST APPEARANCE: Aquino pitched two hitless, scoreless innings in relief at Cedar Rapids on July 21. He walked one and struck out one.

LAST START: Aquino had a no decision at home against Fort Wayne on May 28. He allowed three runs on five hits with a walk and three strikeouts over four innings.

VS. BELOIT: Aquino is 2-0 in two games against Beloit this season. He was the starter on May 14 at home and a reliever at Beloit on July 1. Aquino has allowed two runs - one earned - on seven hits with three walks and eleven strikeouts in twelve innings against the Sky Carp this season.

### **BELOIT STARTING PITCHER:**

RHP JACOB MILLER: The Miami Marlins selected Miller in the second round of the 2022 draft out of Liberty Union High School in

IS IT IN YOU? Miller was the Gatorade Player of the Year for Ohio in his senior season after he was 9-1 with 133 strikeouts in 57 innings.

RATINGS: MLB Pipeline places Miller as the #15 prospect in the Marlins system. Baseball America's recent update puts him at #14.

GETTING YOUR FEET WET: Miller was 0-2 in four starts in the Marlins system in 2022. He was 0-1 in three starts for Miami's Florida Complex League team and 0-1 in a brief start in which he allowed an unearned run for the Jupiter Hammerheads in the Florida State League. He allowed six runs - three earned - on five hits with two walks and six strikeouts over 5-2/3 innings in 2022

SWIMMING WITH SHARKS: Miller spent most of his 2023 season with Jupiter with just two rehab appearances in the FCL. He was 2-4 in fourteen starts with a 4.70 ERA and 50 strikeouts over 59-1/3 innings for Jupiter last season.

LAST START: Miller won at Peoria on July 19. He allowed three runs on six hits with no walks and four strikeouts over seven innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Miller is 0-2 in two starts - May 14 and July 1 against Wisconsin this year. He has allowed 15 runs on 16 hits with five walks and three strikeouts over five innings. Matt Wood and Luke Adams have homered against Miller this season.
