SATURDAY IN THE PARK: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Beloit Snappers 4-1 at Neuroscience Group Field.](#) Felix Valerio and Xavier Warren homered for Wisconsin. Nick Bennett pitched 5-2/3 shutout innings, struck out six, and picked up the win for the Timber Rattlers. Last night was Bennett's first scoreless game in twenty games this season.

CLINCHER: The Rattlers clinched a winning record against the Snappers in the season series with Saturday's victory. This is the first time since 2011 Wisconsin has won the season series from Beloit. The Snappers had won four season series and the teams had tied four season series between 2012 and 2019.

V IS FOR VICTORY: Valerio hit his homer with one out in the first inning yesterday. The blast was his fifth since joining the Rattlers. He has thirteen extra base hits, fourteen RBI, and an OPS of .970 in seventeen games with Wisconsin. Valerio is also on a seven-game hitting streak.

IT'S BEEN A WHILE: Warren's home run was his first as a Rattler and his eleventh of the year between Wisconsin and Carolina. Yesterday's homer was his first since July 6.

HOW DO YOU SPELL RELIEF? Kent Hasler, Nash Walters, and Harold Chirino allowed one run over the final 3-1/3 innings on Saturday. In the first five games of this series, the Wisconsin bullpen has allowed four runs – three earned – over 19 innings.

ABOUT BELOIT: The Beloit Snappers are in their first season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11 and [moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3.](#) Mike Jacobs is in his first season as the manager of the Snappers. Jacobs managed the Clinton LumberKings in 2019, Clinton's last year as an affiliate of the Marlins.

ABOUT THE MARLINS: The Florida/Miami Marlins had a history in the old Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and current Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan. The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings and went 78-61 to qualify for the playoffs. They were swept by the South Bend Cubs in the 2019 MWL Championship Series.

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER

RHP TJ SHOOK: The Brewers signed Shook as a non-drafted free agent out of the University of South Carolina on July 24, 2020.

GAMER: Shook pitched three seasons for the Gamecocks. He was 6-1 with three saves in 41 appearances – nine starts – at South Carolina. He struck out 92 and walked 35 in 74 innings pitched with a 3.04 ERA in his college career.

TEAMMATES: Shook was on the same pitching staff as Adam Hill in 2018. Hill was a Timber Rattler in the 2019 season.

TJ AND THE BLOWFISH: Shook pitched for the Lexington County Blowfish in the Coastal Plain League in 2017 and 2018. He was 2-0 with a 1.89 ERA with 28 strikeouts in 33-1/3 innings pitched in 2017. Shook had no record in four games – three starts – for the Blowfish in 2018.

GOLD, TJ....GOLD! Shook started this season with the ACL Brewers Gold. He allowed a run on a hit and struck out ten over 4-2/3 innings in two starts with no record before a quick promotion to the Carolina Mudcats.

COOL CAT: Shook was 4-1 in six starts for Carolina. He walked eleven and struck out 36 in 28 innings before his promotion to Wisconsin.

LAST START: Shook [lost at Quad Cities on August 28](#). He allowed seven runs on six hits, including two homers, with four walks and four strikeouts over two innings.

VS. BELOIT: Shook has never faced the Snappers prior to this afternoon. This is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Miami Marlins.

BELOIT STARTING PITCHER

RHP GEORGE SORIANO: Signed by the Miami Marlins as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic on August 19, 2015.

2016 to 2018 : Soriano started his professional career in the Dominican Summer League in 2016 and was 1-6 with two saves, a 3.56ERA, and 56 strikeouts over 55-2/3 innings over 17 games (nine starts). He missed the 2017 season and returned to the mound in the Gulf Coast League in 2018 to go 2-1 with a save, a 1.91ERA, and 36 strikeouts over 42-1/3 innings over eleven games – three starts.

ON TO IOWA: Soriano pitched for the Clinton LumberKings during the 2019 season. He was 4-7 with a save and a 3.91 ERA in 23 games – 20 starts – for the LumberKings. He walked 50 and struck out 99 in 119-2/3 innings pitched that season.

IN THE PRESENT: Soriano started this season with the Jupiter Hammerheads in the Low-A Southeast. He was 3-0 with a 2.91 ERA and 47 strikeouts over 34 innings in seven starts before his promotion to the Snappers on June 29.

LAST START: Soriano had a no decision [against Cedar Rapids at home on August 29](#). He allowed five runs on seven hits, including two homers, with two walks and nine strikeouts over four innings.

VS. WISCONSIN (2021): Soriano is 1-1 in two starts against Wisconsin this season. He has allowed four runs on eight hits with five walks and eleven strikeouts over 10-1/3 innings against the Rattlers in 2021.
