ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Beloit Sky Carp 11-1 at ABC Supply Stadium.](#)

Wisconsin set a season-high for hits in a game with sixteen. Gregory Barrios went 4-for-5 and Luke Adams drove in four runs, with a three-run home run.

Wisconsin held the Sky Carp hitless through seven innings. The win was the fifth in a row for the Rattlers, their third five-game winning streak of the season.

FORE! Barrios had his second four-hit game of the season last night. He is 10-for-20 during his current five-game hitting streak. Barrios is second in the Midwest League in average at .317. Cooper Ingle of Lake County leads the league with a .330 average.

DEATH BY A THOUSAND CUTS: Wisconsin had fifteen singles out of their sixteen hits last night.

MR. ADAMS, DEAR MR. ADAMS: Adams had the only Wisconsin extra-base hit last night when he launched his team-leading seventh homer of the season in the fifth inning to give the Rattlers a 5-0 lead.

WHAT A RUN: In their five-game winning streak, Wisconsin has outscored opponents 32-5. The Rattlers have outhit their opponents 50-26 in the last five games.

RELAY: Three Wisconsin pitchers held the Sky Carp to an unearned run on two hits last night. Mark Manfredi walked three in the bottom of the first but got the final out of the inning and retired the first two batters of the second. Tyler Wehrle got the final out of the second and pitched a 1-2-3 third. Patricio Aquino took the mound in the bottom of the fourth and worked the final six innings. He retired the first nine batters he faced before a lead-off walk in the seventh broke a streak of sixteen straight Beloit hitters retired. Sam Praytor broke up the no-hitter with a lead-off single in the eighth. He scored later in the inning after an error and a fielder's choice.

YEOMAN'S WORK: Aquino struck out six over six innings and earned the win. He walked two, hit one, and allowed two hits.

ABOUT BELOIT: The Beloit Sky Carp changed their name from Snappers after the 2021 season. This is Beloit's fourth season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3, 2021. Billy Gardner Jr is in his second season as the manager of the Sky Carp. Prince Fielder, Rickie Weeks, Chris Bosio, Greg Vaughn, Joey Meyer, BJ Surhoff, Tim Dillard, and Mitch Stetter played in Beloit.

ABOUT THE MARLINS: The Florida/Miami Marlins have lots of history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan. The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for 2021.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

LHP TATE KUEHNER: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Kuehner in the seventh round of the 2023 draft out of the University of Louisville.

MARSHALLING THE PAST: Kuehner played high school baseball in Marshalltown, Iowa. Former Timber Rattlers catcher Jeff Clement, the #3 pick in the 2005 draft, also played his high school baseball at Marshalltown.

CARDINAL RULE: Kuehner pitched four seasons with Louisville. He was 15-13 with nine saves and a 3.69 ERA over 70 appearances – fourteen starts – for the Cardinals. Kuehner had 193 strikeouts over 165-2/3 innings. During the 2022 NCAA Regionals in Louisville, Kuehner earned two saves and a win over seven innings in three scoreless appearances for the Cardinals.

COLLEGE SUMMER LEAGUES: Kuehner made five appearances for Waterloo in the Northwoods League in 2020 and four appearances for Danbury in the New England Collegiate Baseball League in 2021.

DOWN IN THE DESERT: Kuehner made two appearances – one start – for the ACL Brewers in the regular season after signing with Milwaukee in 2023. He had no record with a walk and two strikeouts over three scoreless innings.

PLAYOFF CALL: Kuehner was the winning pitcher for the ACL Brewers in the ACL Semifinal Game against the ACL Rockies on [August 24, 2023](#). He allowed a hit over two scoreless innings with no walks and two strikeouts. The Brewers won the game to advance to the ACL Championship Series.

LAST START: Kuehner had a no decision against South Bend at home on [June 26](#). He allowed one hit, walked one, and struck out five over five shutout innings.

VS. БЕЛОIT: Kuehner won as a reliever at home against the Sky Carp on [May 15](#). He allowed three hits over four scoreless innings. Kuehner walked two and struck out three.

BELOIT STARTING PITCHER:

LHP EMMETT OLSON: The Miami Marlins selected Olson in the 4th round of the 2023 draft out of the University of Nebraska.

KING OF CORN: Olson pitched three seasons at Nebraska. He was 10-6 with a save and a 3.83 ERA in 44 games – 23 starts. Olson had 161 strikeouts over 160 innings in his career. In his final season with the Cornhuskers, Olson was 6-3 with a 4.50 ERA in fifteen starts.

SUMMER BALL: Olson played in three different Collegiate Wood Bat Leagues during the summers of 2020, 2021, and 2022. There was time with Fremont in the Expedition League, La Crosse in the Northwoods League, and Fremont in the Independence League.

ONE FOR THE MONEY: Olson made a relief appearance for Miami's Florida Complex League affiliate after signing with the Marlins. On [August 18, 2023](#), he allowed a run on a hit with a walk and two strikeouts over 1-2/3 innings against the FCL Cardinals for his pro debut.

FAST MOVER: Olson started this season with Jupiter and made three starts in April while going sixteen scoreless innings with nineteen strikeouts. He was promoted to Beloit on April 27, 2024.

LAST START: Olson had a no decision at Cedar Rapids on [June 26](#). He allowed two runs – one earned – on three hits with three walks and four strikeouts over five innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Olson lost at Wisconsin on [May 15](#). The Rattlers scored three runs – one earned – on five hits over 4-2/3 innings. Olson walked three and struck out four in the game.
