**SUNDAY IN SOUTH BEND:** [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers defeated the South Bend Cubs 9-6 at Four Winds Field in the series finale between the teams on Sunday afternoon.](#) The win gave the Timber Rattlers a 4-2 series victory over the Cubs.

**FOUR BY FOUR:** Luke Adams had four RBI and Jadhre Areinamo had four hits to lead Wisconsin's 15-hit attack on Sunday. Adams hit a three-run home run in the first inning and added an RBI in the fifth inning. Areinamo added three stolen bases.

**LUCKY NUMBER SEVEN:** Wisconsin stole seven bases on Sunday. The last time the Rattlers had seven steals in a game was on May 7, 2022 against the Fort Wayne TinCaps. The most stolen bases in a game by the Timber Rattlers since they moved to High-A is eight (June 2, 2021 against Peoria).

**FIRST!** Adams' homer was his first as a Timber Rattler. He began the season 1-for-18 before that blast.

**ON BASE WITH BOEVE:** Mike Boeve was the designated hitter for the Timber Rattlers on Sunday afternoon. He was 2-for-3 with a walk, a run scored, and a sacrifice fly. Boeve has reached base in all nine of Wisconsin's games this season. He is 13-for-27 with ten walks for a slash line of .481/.590/.519 to open 2024.

**RELIEF RELAY:** Four Wisconsin relievers covered the final four innings after Edwin Jimenez turned a 9-5 lead over after the fifth. Tyler Wehrle, Aaron Rund, and Chase Costello pitched the sixth, seventh, and eighth innings respectively. Costello allowed an unearned run but escaped a runner at third with no out situation to hold the lead at 9-6. Craig Yoho pitched a perfect ninth inning with two strikeouts for his second save.

**IN CONTROL:** The five Rattlers pitchers combined to walk just two batters on Sunday. That marks the third time this season Wisconsin pitchers have walked only two batters in a game.

**ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS:** The current franchise began its existence as the Cedar Rapids Braves, an affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves in the Three-I League, in 1958. That was the same year and league the current Timber Rattlers franchise joined the Three-I League as the Fox Cities Foxes. Both teams moved to the Midwest League when the Three-I League ended after the 1961 season. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels have made the Midwest League playoffs every year they have been affiliated with the Twins, including a Midwest League Championship last season. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, Trevor Hoffman, Brewers Pitching Coach Chris Hook, and Ted Simmons.

**ABOUT THE TWINS:** Minnesota has a long history of in the Midwest League. They started out with Wisconsin Rapids (1964-1983) and moved to Kenosha (1984-1992) and to Fort Wayne (1993-1998) as the franchise moved. Minnesota has also been with Quad Cities (1999-2004) and Beloit (2005-2012) before their current affiliation with Cedar Rapids Kernels started in 2013.

**PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES:** [MLB Pipeline](#) places six active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Luis Lara (#9), Mike Boeve (#15), Luke Adams (#16), Dylan O'Rae (#21), Jadhre Areinamo (#23), and Patricio Aquino (#29). [MLB Pipeline](#) has eight active Kernels on their list of Minnesota prospects: Gabriel Gonzalez (#4), CJ Culppepper (#8), Luke Keaschall (#9), Danny DeAndrade (#14), Andrew Morris (#18), Zebby Matthews (#20), Ricardo Olivar (#22), and Darren Bowen (#29). Connor Prelipp (#17) is currently on the IL.

## WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER GAME ONE:

**RHP PATRICIO AQUINO:** The Milwaukee Brewers signed Aquino as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela on January 15, 2021.

**LET'S GET IT STARTED:** Aquino made his professional debut with the Brewers #1 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League in 2021. He made eleven starts and was 1-2 with a 2.66 ERA and 54 strikeouts in 44 innings pitched.

**LET'S GO TO ARIZONA:** Aquino was 2-1 with a 4.72 ERA in eight games – seven starts – for the Brewers Gold affiliate in the Arizona Complex League during the 2022 season. He had 49 strikeouts over 34-1/3 innings pitched.

**ON TO CAROLINA:** Aquino was 5-3 with a 2.75 ERA in 21 games – 19 starts – with 86 strikeouts over 88-1/3 innings pitched during the 2023 regular season.

**PLAYOFF CALL:** Aquino was the starting pitcher for the Mudcats in Game Two of the first round Carolina League playoff series against the Down East Wood Ducks. He had a no decision with six scoreless innings. The Mudcats would lose the game 6-5 in ten innings.

**HOW DOES HE RATE?** MLB Pipeline rates Aquino as the #29 prospect in the Brewers organization.

**LAST START:** Aquino pitched five scoreless innings at South Bend on [April 9](#) for his Timber Rattlers and 2024 debut. He allowed two hits, walked one, and struck out three for a no decision.

**VS. CEDAR RAPIDS:** Aquino has never faced the Cedar Rapids Kernels prior to this afternoon. Today will also be the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Minnesota Twins.

## WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER GAME TWO:

**LHP TATE KUEHNER:** The Milwaukee Brewers selected Kuehner in the seventh round of the 2023 draft out of the University of Louisville.

**MARSHALLING THE PAST:** Kuehner played high school baseball in Marshalltown, Iowa. Former Timber Rattlers catcher Jeff Clement, the #3 pick in the 2005 draft, also played his high school baseball at Marshalltown.

**CARDINAL RULE:** Kuehner pitched four seasons with Louisville. He was 15-13 with nine saves and a 3.69 ERA over 70 appearances – fourteen starts – for the Cardinals. Kuehner had 193 strikeouts over 165-2/3 innings. During the 2022 NCAA Regionals in Louisville, Kuehner earned two saves and a win over seven innings in three scoreless appearances for the Cardinals.

**COLLEGE SUMMER LEAGUES:** Kuehner made five appearances for Waterloo in the Northwoods League in 2020 and four appearances for Danbury in the New England Collegiate Baseball League in 2021.

**DOWN IN THE DESERT:** Kuehner made two appearances – one start – for the ACL Brewers in the regular season after signing with Milwaukee in 2023. He had no record with a walk and two strikeouts over three scoreless innings.

**PLAYOFF CALL:** Kuehner was the winning pitcher for the ACL Brewers in the ACL Semifinal Game against the ACL Rockies on [August 24, 2023](#). He allowed a hit over two scoreless innings with no walks and two strikeouts. The Brewers would win the game 3-2 to advance to the ACL Championship Series.

**LAST APPEARANCE:** Kuehner made his Timber Rattlers debut as a reliever against the South Bend Cubs on [April 10, 2024](#). He allowed three runs on three walks and four hits with five strikeouts over two innings.

**LAST START:** Kuehner pitched two scoreless innings for a no decision against the ACL Mariners on [August 18, 2023](#). He allowed two hits, walked one, and struck out one over two scoreless innings.

**VS. CEDAR RAPIDS:** Kuehner has never faced the Cedar Rapids Kernels prior to this afternoon. He has also never pitched against an affiliate of the Minnesota Twins.

## CEDAR RAPIDS STARTING PITCHER GAME ONE:

**RHP ANDREW MORRIS:** The Minnesota Twins selected Morris in the fourth round of the 2022 draft out of Texas Tech.

**ON THE TABLE:** Morris pitched three seasons (2019-2021) at Colorado Mesa University before attending Texas Tech. Morris was 18-2 with a 3.23 ERA and 215 strikeouts over 175-2/3 innings pitched during his Junior College career.

**AT THE TECH:** Morris was 8-2 in sixteen starts for the Red Raiders in his one season. He had a 4.58 ERA and 91 strikeouts with 28 walks in 88-1/3 innings pitched before the Twins picked him in the draft.

**THERE CAN BE ONLY ONE:** Morris made his pro debut with the Florida Complex League Twins on August 19, 2022 with a scoreless, hitless inning against the FCL Red Sox. Morris walked none and struck out one in his only professional appearance last year.

**MUSSEL BEACH:** Morris started the 2023 season with Fort Myers in the Florida State League. He was 3-1 with a 2.59 ERA in eleven games – ten starts. Morris walked eleven and struck out 52 over 49-2/3 innings pitched with Fort Myers before his promotion to Cedar Rapids on July 24.

**CEDAR CHEST:** Morris went 5-1 with a 3.28 ERA in seven regular season starts with the Kernels after joining the team. He walked eight and struck out 28 over 35-2/3 innings. In the 2023 postseason, Morris went 0-1 in two starts and allowed five runs on ten hits with a walk and twelve strikeouts over ten innings.

**LAST START:** Morris had a no decision against Dayton at home on [April 11](#). He allowed a run on three hits with no walks and nine strikeouts over six innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN (2023):** Morris made three starts against Wisconsin last season. He made his Midwest League debut in a start against the Timber Rattlers in Wisconsin on [July 30](#) and also started against Wisconsin on [August 17](#) in Cedar Rapids and at Wisconsin on [September 5](#). Morris was 1-1 with a 5.27 ERA as he allowed nine runs – eight earned – on 24 hits with three walks and twelve strikeouts over 13-2/3 innings against the Rattlers last season.

## CEDAR RAPIDS STARTING PITCHER GAME TWO:

**RHP ZEBBY MATTHEWS:** The Minnesota Twins selected Matthews in the eighth round of the 2022 draft out of Western Carolina University.

**PARAMOUNT CATAMOUNT:** Matthews was 13-9 with a 3.58 ERA in 36 games – 24 starts – during his career at Western Carolina. He had 211 strikeouts over 183-1/3 innings pitched with just 30 walks during his three-year career. In his final season at WCU, Matthews was 4-6 with four saves in 22 games – ten starts – with 122 strikeouts over 95-2/3 innings.

**MOVING ON UP:** Matthews made two relief appearances as a professional in 2022 after signing with the Twins. He pitched one scoreless inning with two strikeouts for Minnesota's Florida Complex League team before working two scoreless innings with four strikeouts for the Fort Myers Mighty Mussels in the Florida State League.

**BACK IN FLORIDA:** Matthews made eight appearances – seven starts – with Fort Myers to start the 2023 season. He was 3-1 with a 2.56 ERA. Matthews walked five and struck out 53 in 38-2/3 innings in the Florida State League before his promotion to Cedar Rapids on May 28.

**CORN COUNTRY:** Matthews was 4-2 with a 4.59 ERA in fourteen games – twelve starts – in the regular season with the Kernels after his promotion. He walked ten and struck out 59 in 66-2/3 innings with Cedar Rapids. Matthews pitched once in the 2023 playoffs for the Kernels and allowed two runs on two hits with four strikeouts over 3-2/3 innings of relief at Great Lakes on September 17.

**LAST START:** Matthews beat Dayton at home on [April 10](#). He allowed a run on four hits with no walks and eight strikeouts over five innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN (2023):** Matthews had no record in three starts against Wisconsin – [July 27](#), [August 20](#), and [September 8](#) – last season. He has allowed three runs on eleven hits with three walks and fifteen strikeouts over 13-2/3 innings versus the Timber Rattlers in 2023.
