### ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Quad Cities River Bandits 4-1 at Modern Woodmen Park.](#)

A trio of Wisconsin pitchers held the River Bandits to three hits and recorded fourteen strikeouts. Jadherr Areinamo drove in two runs and the Rattlers defense played error-free baseball.

#### FALLING BEHIND BEFORE TAKING THE LEAD:

Carson Roccaforte gave the River Bandits a 1-0 lead with a lead-off homer in the bottom of the first inning. Areinamo tied the game with an RBI single in the second and put the Rattlers ahead with an RBI grounder in the fourth. Luis Lara and Gregory Barrios had consecutive RBI hits in the top of the fifth.

**THREE AMIGOS:** Wisconsin starter Tate Kuehner didn't give up another hit and struck out six over four innings after surrendering the home run. Tyler Wehrle pitched two scoreless innings with a strikeout for the win. Craig Yoho pitched the final three innings with seven strikeouts to close out the game for his fourth save.

**CRAIG'S LIST:** Yoho retired the first eight batters he faced before giving up a two-out single in the ninth. He struck out the final batter of the game. Yoho's final five outs of the game were strikeouts. He has 26 strikeouts and two walks in thirteen innings as a Rattler.

**LOOK OUT...AGAIN!** Luke Adams was hit by a pitch in the fourth inning last night. Adams has been hit by a pitch in six straight games. He has been hit by pitches eleven times this season and leads Minor League Baseball in that category with Ripken Reyes of El Paso. The Major League record for being hit by a pitch in consecutive games is six and was set in August of 2008 by Carlos Quentin of the Chicago White Sox.

**ABSOLUTELY PERFECT:** Wisconsin's defense played their fifth consecutive errorless game last night. The Rattlers have committed two errors in their last eleven games. Both errors occurred in the loss to Great Lakes on May 1 to snap a previous streak of five straight errorless games.

**ABOUT QUAD CITIES:** The River Bandits are the Midwest League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. The current version of Davenport Professional Baseball club started in 1960 as the Midwest League affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves. Quad Cities has affiliated with several MLB teams: The California Angels (1962-1978 and 1985-1992), the Chicago Cubs (1979-1984), the Houston Astros (1993-1998 and 2013-2019), the Minnesota Twins (1999-2004), and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005-2012). The team became the Quad City River Bandits in 1992. They changed their name to the Swing of the Quad Cities from 2004 through 2007 before changing to Quad Cities River Bandits in 2008. Quad Cities won Midwest League pennants in 1968, 1971, 1979, 1990, 2011, 2013, and 2017. They were the High-A Central League champions in 2021. Notable alumni of Quad Cities: Carlos Correa, Joe Mauer, Josh Hader, Billy Wagner, Shawon Dunston, Justin Morneau, and Brett Phillips.

**ABOUT THE ROYALS:** The Kansas City Royals have been Quad Cities' parent club since 2021. They left the Midwest league and an affiliation with Kane County at the end of the 2012 season. The Royals had previously been in the Midwest League with Waterloo (1969-1976), Appleton (1987-1992), Rockford (1993-94), Springfield (1995), Lansing (1996-1998), Burlington (2001-2010), and Kane County (2011-2012).

# PITCHING MATCHUP

## WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP PATRICIO AQUINO:** The Milwaukee Brewers signed Aquino as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela on January 15, 2021.

**LET'S GET IT STARTED:** Aquino made his professional debut with the Brewers #1 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League in 2021. He made eleven starts and was 1-2 with a 2.66 ERA and 54 strikeouts in 44 innings pitched.

**LET'S GO TO ARIZONA:** Aquino was 2-1 with a 4.72 ERA in eight games – seven starts – for the Brewers Gold affiliate in the Arizona Complex League during the 2022 season. He had 49 strikeouts over 34-1/3 innings pitched.

**ON TO CAROLINA:** Aquino was 5-3 with a 2.75 ERA in 21 games – 19 starts – with 86 strikeouts over 88-1/3 innings pitched during the 2023 regular season.

**PLAYOFF CALL:** Aquino was the starting pitcher for the Mudcats in Game Two of the first round Carolina League playoff series against the Down East Wood Ducks. He had a no decision with six scoreless innings. The Mudcats would lose the game 6-5 in ten innings.

**HOW DOES HE RATE?** MLB Pipeline rates Aquino as the #28 prospect in the Brewers organization.

**LAST START:** Aquino lost to Great Lakes at home on [May 1](#). He allowed five runs on five hits, including two homers, hit a batter, walked two, and struck out one over 3-2/3 innings.

**VS. QUAD CITIES:** Aquino has never faced the River Bandits prior to this evening. Aquino was 1-0 in two starts – [July 27](#) and [August 25](#) – against the Columbia Fireflies, the Carolina League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals in 2023. Aquino allowed three runs on fifteen hits with three walks and six strikeouts over ten innings in the those two starts against Columbia.

## QUAD CITIES STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP BEN KUDRNA:** The Kansas City Royals selected Kudrna out of Blue Valley Southwest High School in Overland Park, Kansas in the second round of the 2021 draft. Kudrna was taken with the 43<sup>rd</sup> overall pick in the draft. MLB Pipeline rates Kudrna as the #3 prospect in Kansas City's system.

**BYE-BYE TO THE BAYOU:** Kudrna signed with the Royals over a commitment to Louisiana State University. made his professional debut in the Dominican Summer League in 2018. He was 2-4 with three saves and a 4.18 ERA. Noriega walked eight and struck out thirty over 32-1/3 innings.

**GETTING STARTED:** Kudrna did not pitch professionally in 2021. He made his professional debut with the Columbia Fireflies in the Carolina League in 2022. Kudrna was 2-5 with a 3.48 ERA in seventeen starts with 61 strikeouts over 72-1/3 innings pitched. Kudrna returned to Columbia to start the 2023 season and was 4-3 with a 3.56 ERA in fourteen games – thirteen starts. He walked 30 and struck out 70 in 68-1/3 innings with Columbia before his promotion to Quad Cities on July 12, 2023.

**DOWN BY THE RIVER:** Kudrna went 1-4 with a 5.36 ERA in eight starts for the River Bandits after his promotion. He walked fifteen and struck out 34 over 40-1/3 innings pitched in the Midwest League last season.

**LAST START:** Kudrna lost at Beloit on [May 1](#). He allowed four runs on four hits with two walks and seven strikeouts over six innings in the game.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Kudrna picked up his lone Midwest League win of 2023 against the Timber Rattlers at Neuroscience Group Field on [August 25](#). He allowed two runs on six hits with two walks and a strikeout over five innings. Kudrna also made two starts against the Carolina Mudcats, Milwaukee's Carolina League affiliate, in 2022. He had no record, allowed three runs – two earned – on seven hits with four walks and nine strikeouts over 9-1/3 innings against the Mudcats on [June 15](#) and [September 1](#).
