CIRCLE CITY ROUNDUP

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Two early home runs from Rafael Flores and Sammy Siani powered the Indianapolis Indians to an 8-3 win over the Iowa Cubs on Wednesday afternoon at Victory Field. The Indians jumped out to an early lead with four runs in the first inning. Alike Williams led off with a single, Sammy Siani walked and Nick Solak ripped a double down the left field line to plate Williams for a 1-0 lead. Rafael Flores then launched a three-run home run 422 feet to the shrubbery in center field. In the bottom of the second inning, Siani hit a solo homer to extend the lead, 5-0. Indy added a sixth run in the fourth inning on an RBI groundout by Solak. Jonathan Long got the I-Cubs in the run column with a solo homer in the fifth inning, his 20th of the campaign. He later cut the deficit, 6-2, with an RBI single in the seventh frame. Caleb Knight was hit by a pitch in the next at-bat to load the bases and Nicky Lopez brought the third lowa run home on a sacrifice fly. Indy got a run back in the bottom half of the seventh when Anthony Prato came around to score on a throwing error by center fielder Owen Caissie. Solak added one more insurance run in the eighth to extend the lead, 8-3, with an RBI single.

WINDIANAPOLIS: The Indians 79 wins are their most in a season since winning 79 games in 2018. Tonight, can reach 80 wins for the first time since winning 83 games in 2015. Indy owns a Triple-A best 47-24 (.662) record at home and it is the club's best home winning percentage to this point in the season since at least 2005, surpassing their 46-24 (.657) record at home through Aug. 30, 2012. 47 wins at Victory Field also surpasses the Indians' home win total in 26 of 28 full seasons in the Victory Field era (since 1996). Indy is two home wins away from matching 1997's total of 49 wins for the most at Victory Field in a single season.

RAFA RAKES: Rafael Flores continued his torrid stretch with Indianapolis on Wednesday afternoon, blasting a 422-foot, three-run home run in the first inning to provide the winning runs in the contest. In eight games this month, Flores has racked up nine RBI and posted one-plus RBI in six of those, including four straight contests from Sept. 2-5. He has hit safely in 13 of his last 19 games since Aug. 20 at Syracuse and reached safely in 16 of those. In this span, he is hitting .347 (25-for-72) with 13 runs, two doubles, one triple, six home runs, 21 RBI and a 1.048 OPS. In 32 games with the Indians since being traded from New York (AL), Flores is hitting .289 (35-for-121) with 16 runs, four doubles, one triple, six home runs, 26 RBI, 13 walks and an .852 OPS.

RICIDULOUS-NICK: Nick Solak got the Indians offense started with an RBI double in the first inning of Wednesday afternoon's contest, finishing 2-for-4 with one run, one double, three RBI and a walk. He extended his hitting streak to six games and has posted multi-hit games in back-to-back contests. His three RBI were his most since also driving in a trio on Aug. 12 at Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. As one of Minor League Baseball's best hitters in 2025, Solak has reached safely in 93 of 103 games this season and has hit safely in 83 of those.

SLAMMIN' SAMMY: Sammy Siani launched his fourth home run of the season with Indianapolis last night, swatting a ball opposite field down the left field line for a solo shot in the second inning. He has one-plus hit in four consecutive games and has hit safely in 10 of 16 games overall since being transferred from Double-A Altoona. Despite batting just .237 (14-for-59) in those 16 games, he owns a .338 on-base percentage and an .813 OPS.

CAPTAIN JACK: Pirates outfielder Jack Suwinski joined the Indians today on an MLB rehab assignment, marking the 13th player to appear on a rehab assignment with the club on the campaign. Suwinski was placed on the 10-day injured list on Aug. 29 with a right groin strain. The outfielder appeared in 53 games earlier this season with Indy from April 25-July 6 and ranked among International League hitters in that span in RBI (T-2nd, 48), home runs (T-7th, 12), runs scored (9th, 41) and OPS (10th, .926). He also led Indians' hitters across that stretch in walks (28), extra-base hits (23) and total bases (99). He has cranked 25 home runs in 132 games with the club, which is the most by an Indians hitter with fewer than 150 games played since at least 2005.

BRANDAN BLANKS: Brandon Bidiois tossed 2.0 scoreless and hitless innings in Tuesday's series opener and has now faced 64 consecutive batters without allowing a hit since July 29 with Double-A Altoona at Portland. Bidiois is yet to allow a hit or run in six games and 9.2 innings with Indy, walking five and striking out 13. Among all minor leaguers with at least 50.0 innings pitched, he has the lowest batting average against (.111, 21-for-190), lowest OPS against (.349), second-lowest ERA (0.78) and hits per nine (3.28). In addition to these stats, he has an 8-0 record across 37 total appearances in 2025.

EDDY YEAN STRIKEOUT MACHINE: Eddy Yean opened the game for the Indians on Tuesday night, tossing 3.0 scoreless innings. He struck out seven batters, his most since a career-high nine on June 25 (2) with Low-A Bradenton vs. Jupiter. Prior to tonight, he had not struck out more than two batters in an outing since Aug. 7, 2024, with Double-A Altoona at Portland.

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP: The Indianapolis Indians continue the 2025 season's final homestand against the Iowa Cubs from Victory Field tonight at 6:35 PM. LHP Hunter Barco is set to take the mound for the Indians, making his 20th appearance and 17th start of the season. Barco worked out of the bullpen in his last outing on Sept. 5, allowing one earned run across 1.2 innings at Columbus. Barco made one previous start against the I-Cubs this season on Aug. 1 at Iowa. He allowed three earned runs across 2.2 innings with five hits, one walk and four strikeouts. On the mound for Iowa is LHP Jordan Wicks. Wicks has allowed one earned run or fewer in 10 of his last 11 outings. He made two appearances against Indy this season, last tossing 4.1 shutout innings on July 30 at Iowa en route to the win. In five career games (4 starts) against Indianapolis, Wicks is 2-0 with a 3.10 ERA (7er/20.1ip) and 18 strikeouts.

ON THIS DATE IN 2005: With a 6-4 victory at Buffalo in the Governors' Cup semifinals, the Indians became the first International League team since 1984 to win a best-of-five series by winning three straight road games after falling behind, 2-0. José Bautista hit a three-run home run in the second inning to put Indy up early, and a clutch three-run shot by Ronny Paulino in the top of the eighth turned a 4-3 deficit into a two-run advantage. Mark Corey, who led the IL with 28 saves in the regular season, converted his third consecutive save of the series with two strikeouts in the ninth.

TONIGHT'S PITCHER

Hunter Barco: The southpaw ranks as Pittsburgh's No. 4 prospect and Minor League Baseball's No. 83 overall prospect according to MLB Pipeline.

Historic Zeroes: Barco did not allow a run in his six starts with Double-A Altoona, totaling 25.2 consecutive scoreless innings to begin the season, marking the longest scoreless streak in Curve history.

Last Outing: Barco worked out of the bullpen in his last outing on Sept. 5, allowing one earned run across 1.2 innings at Columbus.

Against the I-Cubs: Barco made one previous start against the I-Cubs this season on Aug. 1 at Iowa. He allowed three earned runs across 2.2 innings with five hits, one walk and four strikeouts.

EAS Pitcher of the Month: Barco was awarded the 2025 Eastern League April Pitcher of the Month Award after leading the league (min. 20ip) in ERA (0.00, 20.2ip) and batting average against (.132, 9-for-68), while ranking second in WHIP (0.63) and tied for fourth in strikeouts (30).

Mowing Them Down: Barco finished his award-winning April with back-to-back eight-strikeout starts, the last of which came in just 3.0 innings of work on April 27 at Double-A Chesapeake. He became the first Pirates full-season farmhand to strike out eight or more batters in 3.0 innings or less since Osvaldo Bido also struck out eight in 3.0 innings vs. Triple-A Louisville on Aug. 4th, 2022.

Miscellaneous: Barco was selected by the Pirates in the second round (44th overall) of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Florida (Gainesville).
