LAST ACTION: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Peoria Chiefs 8-6 at Neuroscience Group Field on Sunday afternoon.](#) The Rattlers had a 2-0 lead after scoring twice in the bottom of the first. The Chiefs took the lead with a run in the second and three runs in the fourth. Luiyin Alastre tied the game with a two-run double in the sixth inning. Later in the inning Juan Baez and Marco Dinges added RBI singles for a 6-4 lead. Daniel Guilarte hit a two-run home run in the seventh for two insurance runs and an 8-4 lead. Peoria scored single runs in the eighth and ninth.

SERIES VICTORY: Wisconsin won five of six from the Chiefs for their second straight series win and the first home series win of the season for the Rattlers.

GOING DEEP: Guilarte's home run was his first of the season. It was his first home run since May 2, 2024 against the Columbia Fireflies in the Carolina League.

WALKING IN GRAND CHUTE: Blake Burke walked four times on Sunday. He also knocked in a run with a ground out in the first inning. Burke and Guilarte have both walked four times in a game this season.

A DAY OFF: Jadhre Areinamo played in the first 50 games of the season for the Rattlers. Sunday was his first day out of the lineup in 2025.

TURNING TWO: Wisconsin's defense turned three double plays on Sunday to give them 51 on the season. The Rattlers lead the Midwest League in double plays. The Everett AquaSox (58) and Hillsboro Hops (54) are the only teams in the High-A Classification of Minor League Baseball with more double plays in 2025.

ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS: The current franchise began its existence in 1949 as the Cedar Rapids Rockets, an unaffiliated team in the Central Association. They moved to the Three-I League as the Cedar Rapids Indians, an affiliate of Cleveland in 1950. They were affiliated with the Milwaukee Braves from 1954 through 1962. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels made the Midwest League playoffs every year they have been affiliated with the Twins from 2013 through 2023, including a 2023 Midwest League Championship. That streak ended last year when the Kernels missed the playoffs. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, and Milwaukee Brewers Pitching Coach Chris Hook. Hall of Famers John McGraw (1891 Canaries), Lou Boudreau (1938 Raiders), Ted Simmons (1967 Cardinals), and Trevor Hoffman (1991 Reds) played for earlier pro teams in Cedar Rapids.

ABOUT THE TWINS: Minnesota has a long history of in the Midwest League. They started out with Wisconsin Rapids (1964-1983) and moved to Kenosha (1984-1992) and to Fort Wayne (1993-1998) as the franchise moved. Minnesota has also been with Quad Cities (1999-2004) and Beloit (2005-2012) before their current affiliation with Cedar Rapids Kernels started in 2013.

Charlee Soto (#8), Billy Amick (#14), and Khadim Diaw (#29) are currently on the Cedar Rapids IL.

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER GAME ONE:

RHP RYAN BIRCHARD: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Birchard in the 5th round of the 2023 draft out of the Niagara County Community College.

PLAYER OF THE YEAR: Birchard was named the Western New York Athletic Conference Player of the Year in 2023. He was 8-0 in ten games – nine starts – with a 1.08 ERA and 95 strikeouts over fifty innings pitched. Birchard was also named a First Team All-NJCAA Division III All-American in 2023.

QUICK TRIP TO TRENTON: Birchard made four appearances – two starts – for Trenton in the MLB Draft League after the end of his college season. He allowed one run, walked one, and struck out sixteen over nine innings before signing with Milwaukee.

DELAYED START: Birchard did not pitch professionally in 2023. He made a start for the Carolina Mudcats on April 6, 2024 (4.0IP, H, R, 0ER, 2BB, 6K) but was placed on the IL after that game. He next pitched with the ACL Brewers on July 16 and July 22. Birchard rejoined Carolina for appearances on July 28 and August 3 before being sent to Wisconsin on August 13.

AS A RATTLER (2024): Birchard made five regular season starts for Wisconsin last season. He was 0-3 with an 8.71 ERA. He walked fourteen and struck out thirteen in 10-1/3 innings with the Timber Rattlers

LAST START: Birchard won at South Bend on [May 23](#). He allowed a run on five hits with a walk and seven strikeouts over six innings.

LAST APPEARANCE: Birchard lost in relief against Peoria on [May 29](#) at home. He allowed six runs on three hits with three walks and a strikeout over 1-2/3 innings.

VS. CEDAR RAPIDS: Birchard lost at Cedar Rapids on [April 23](#). He allowed a run on three hits with a walk and five strikeouts over five innings.

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER GAME TWO:

RHP STIVEN CRUZ: Signed by Milwaukee as an International Free Agent out of Nicaragua on July 2, 2019.

DELAYED START: Cruz began his pro career with the Brewers-1 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League in 2021. He was 3-3 with a 1.37 ERA and 73 strikeouts over 52-2/3 innings pitched in twelve games – eleven starts.

MUDDY WATERS: Cruz started the 2022 season with the Carolina Mudcats in the Carolina League. He went 3-5 with a 4.60 ERA in fifteen starts for Carolina. Cruz walked 18 and struck out 89 over 72-1/3 innings pitched.

ON TO WISCONSIN: Cruz joined the Timber Rattlers on August 16, 2022. He made four starts with the Rattlers and allowed one run on six hits with six walks and twenty strikeouts over nineteen innings pitched for a 1-1 record with a 0.47ERA. In 2023, Cruz spent the entire season with the Rattlers and was 7-6 with a 6.90 ERA in 24 games – 19 starts. Cruz was also a Rattler for the entire 2024 season and was 2-3 with a save in 33 games – six starts. He began the 2025 season with Biloxi before coming back to the Rattlers on June 3.

IT'S A MAJOR AWARD: Cruz beat Lansing at home on August 24, 2022. He allowed a hit with a walk and seven strikeouts over six scoreless innings in the game. Cruz was named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week for that game.

LAST APPEARANCE: Cruz pitched 2/3 of an inning as a reliever against Rocket City on [May 29](#). He allowed three runs on three hits.

LAST START: Cruz had a no decision in a one-inning start at Cedar Rapids on [September 8, 2024](#), the final day of the 2024 season. He allowed an unearned run on five hits with two walks and two strikeouts over six innings.

VS. CEDAR RAPIDS (2024): Cruz had no record in five games – three starts – against the Kernels last season. He gave up one run on eleven hits with four walks and six strikeouts in 12-2/3 innings.

CEDAR RAPIDS STARTING PITCHER GAME ONE:

RHP JOSE OLIVARES: The Twins signed Olivares as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela on January 15, 2021.

SHORT SEASONS: Olivares pitched in the Dominican Summer League in 2021 and the Florida Complex League in 2022. He pitched fifteen innings in ten appearances in the DSL and 33-2/3 innings in ten appearances in Florida. Olivares was 5-4 with a save, 55 strikeouts, and 27 walks in those first two seasons.

HOLDING DOWN THE FORT: Olivares made 21 appearance – twenty starts – with Fort Myers in the Florida State League in 2023. He was 3-4 with a 6.22 ERA with 83 strikeouts in 85-1/3 innings. Olivares only made thirteen appearances – ten starts – with the Mighty Mussels in an injury-plagued 2024. He was 2-3 with 47 strikeouts in 46 innings last year in the Florida State League.

PLAYER RATING: MLB Pipeline ranks Olivares as the #28 prospect in the Minnesota system.

LAST START: Olivares beat Lake County at home on [May 28](#). He allowed one hit, walked one, and struck out seven over five scoreless innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Olivares made two three-inning starts – [April 22](#) and [April 27](#) – against the Rattlers in Cedar Rapids. He allowed two hits, walked one, and struck out eight without allowing a run in six innings.

CEDAR RAPIDS STARTING PITCHER GAME TWO:

RHP COLE PESCHL: The Twins selected Peschl in the 15th round of the 2024 draft out of Campbell University.

CAMEL IN CAROLINA: Peschl pitched the 2024 collegiate season at Campbell University. He had pitched 2022 and 2023 with the University of Charleston, an NCAA Division II school. In 2024, Peschl was 3-3 with a 5.48 ERA and 83 strikeouts over 69 innings pitched.

ROCKING OUT: Peschl pitched for the Green Bay Rockers of the Northwoods League in the summer of 2023. He made five starts and was 1-0 with a 3.00 ERA and 32 strikeouts over 24 innings pitched. Peschl also made seven relief appearances for the West Virginia Miners of the Prospect League in 2022.

PRO DEBUT: Peschl did not pitch professionally after the 2024 draft. He started the 2025 season with the Ft. Myers Mighty Mussels and was 1-1 with a save and a 1.49 ERA in six games – two starts – before earning a promotion to Cedar Rapids on May 21.

LAST START: Peschl beat Lake County at home on [May 29](#). He allowed two runs on three hits, walked none, and struck out seven over six innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Peschl has never pitched against the Timber Rattlers prior to this afternoon. Today is also the first time he will face an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
