**LAST ACTION:** [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers were shutout 3-0 by the Cedar Rapids Kernels at Neuroscience Group Field at Fox Cities Stadium on Sunday.](#) Wisconsin was held to four hits in the game.

The Kernels had eleven hits, but only managed single runs in the first, second, and fifth innings. Cedar Rapids won four of the six games in the series between the teams. The team that scored first in a game during this series between Wisconsin and Cedar Rapids won that game. The Rattlers and the Kernels have twelve games remaining in their season series. The teams have split the first twelve games.

**SHUTOUT SUNDAYS:** The last three Timber Rattlers games played on a Sunday have been shutouts with the Rattlers being shut out twice (July 18 at Peoria and August 3 versus Cedar Rapids) Wisconsin has been held scoreless twice at home this season – August 3 and Sunday, May 23 versus West Michigan.

**STOP, THIEF!** Wisconsin catcher Kekai Rios threw out a pair of would-be base stealers on Sunday. Rios has thrown out 16 of 36 opposing runners trying to steal on him this season (44.4%).

**STILL WALTERS:** Reliever Nash Walters pitched a scoreless top of the ninth inning on Sunday. Walters has not allowed a run in his last seven appearances. His scoreless streak stretches back to the appearance before that and has reached 10-1/3 innings.

**ABOUT BELOIT:** The Beloit Snappers are in their first season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11 and [move into ABC Supply Stadium tonight.](#) Mike Jacobs is in his first season as the manager of the Snappers. Jacobs managed the Clinton LumberKings in 2019, Clinton's last year as an affiliate of the Marlins.

**ABOUT THE MARLINS:** The Florida/Miami Marlins had a history in the old Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and current Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan. The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings and went 78-61 to qualify for the playoffs. They were beaten by the Cedar Rapids Kernels in the Best-of-three Western Division Finals two games to one.

# PITCHING MATCHUP

## WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP ZACH MORT:** Signed with Milwaukee as a Minor League Free Agent on January 14, 2021.

**ORIGIN STORY:** Mort was drafted by the Chicago Cubs in the 8<sup>th</sup> round of the 2018 draft out of George Mason University.

**PATRIOTIC DUTY:** Mort appeared in 57 games – 28 starts – over three seasons at George Mason. He went 12-12 with nine saves and a 3.72 ERA and 205 strikeouts over 227-1/3 innings pitched during his collegiate career.

**IN THE CUBS DEN:** Mort spent two seasons (2018 and 2019) in the Cubs organization after signing with them. He made ten relief appearances (0-4, 5.79) with the Eugene Emeralds in 2018. In 2019, Mort started the season with the South Bend Cubs in the Midwest League, was sent back to Eugene in the middle of June, and returned to South Bend in early August. Mort was 3-3 with a 3.72 ERA in Eugene and 6-2 with a 3.13 ERA for South Bend.

**POSTSEASON:** Mort was the winning pitcher in Game One of the Midwest League Championship Series against the [Clinton LumberKings on September 11, 2019](#). Mort went three scoreless innings, allowed one hit and two walks with four strikeouts as a reliever. The South Bend Cubs went on to sweep the best-of-five series from Clinton.

**LAST START:** Mort had a no decision against [the Cedar Rapids Kernels at home on July 28](#). He allowed four runs on seven hits with no walks and four strikeouts over 4-1/3 innings.

**VS. BELOIT (2021):** Mort had a no decision against the Snappers [at home on May 8](#). He allowed a run on three hits with two walks and five strikeouts over five innings. Mort took the loss in relief [at Beloit on July 2](#) when he allowed four runs on two hits with a walk and two strikeouts over two innings.

**THE COMMODORE:** King was 3-7 and six saves with a 4.02 ERA in 70 games – six starts – over three seasons at Vanderbilt. He walked 60 and struck out 129 in 130 innings pitched during his college career.

**LAST START:** King had a no decision [at Peoria on July 27](#). He allowed a run on nine hits with a walk and seven strikeouts over 4-1/3 innings pitched.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** King lost to the Timber Rattlers [at Neuroscience Group Field on May 7](#). He allowed four runs on five hits with three walks and four strikeouts over 4-2/3 innings. King beat [Wisconsin at Pohlman Field on July 2](#) when he allowed one run on four hits with two walks and eight strikeouts.
