ABOUT THE LANSING LUGNUTS: The Lugnuts began their existence as the Lafayette (IN) Chiefs of the Mississippi-Ohio Valley League in 1955. Lafayette became the Red Sox in 1956 and as the Mississippi-Ohio Valley League became the Midwest League. The franchise moved Waterloo, Iowa in 1958 and remained there as the Hawks, Royals, Indians, and Diamonds until the end of the 1993 season. New ownership bought the team and moved them to Springfield, Illinois for two seasons before finally locating the team in Lansing, Michigan in 1996. Since they started in Lansing, the Lugnuts were affiliated with the Kansas City Royals (1996-1998), the Chicago Cubs (1999-2004), the Toronto Blue Jays (2005-2019), and the Oakland Athletics. The Lugnuts won Midwest League titles in 1997 and 2003. Notable Lansing alumni include Kevin Appier, Carlos Beltrán, Rich Hill, Mark Prior, Carlos Zambrano, Bo Bichette, Vladimir Guerrero Jr, Danny Janssen, Noah Syndergaard, and Rowdy Tellez.

ABOUT THE ATHLETICS: The Athletics have been on and off in the Midwest League since moving from Kansas City to Oakland for the 1968 season. They were in Burlington from 1968 through 1974. Oakland returned to the Midwest League in 1982 to be the parent club of the Madison Muskies and stayed in Madison through 1993. Oakland's affiliation stayed with the franchise after its move to West Michigan in 1994. Oakland left the league after the 1997 season only to return with Kane County as their affiliate from 2003 through 2010. From there, Oakland went to Burlington (2011-2012), Beloit (2013-2019), and now Lansing since 2021.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP ALEXANDER CORNIELLE: Milwaukee signed Cornielle as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic on June 15, 2019.

FAST DEBUT: Cornielle made his professional debut with one inning of relief against the Cubs #2 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League on August 2, 2019. He allowed one run on no hits with two walks in one inning. Cornielle made three appearances in the DSL in 2019 with no record and one run allowed over four innings.

HIT PLAY: Cornielle started the 2021 season with the Brewers Blue affiliate in the Arizona Complex League and was 4-2 in nine games – four starts – with a 4.64 ERA and 50 strikeouts over 33 innings pitched. He was called up to Carolina at the end of the season and was 0-1 in two starts with ten strikeouts in eight innings.

WEEKLY AWARD: Cornielle was named the ACL's Pitcher of the Week on September 6, 2021 after his performance against the White Sox on August 31, 2021. He allowed one run on one hit and two walks with six strikeouts over five innings in the game.

FEELING 2022: Cornielle was 9-7 in 22 games – 19 starts – with a 3.19 ERA and 124 strikeouts over 101-2/3 innings pitched for the Carolina Mudcats this season before joining the Timber Rattlers on August 23. He was second in the Carolina League in strikeouts and third in the Carolina League in ERA before his promotion to Wisconsin.

LAST START: Cornielle beat Fayetteville at home on August 20. He allowed a run on four hits with five walks and four strikeouts over five innings.

VS. LANSING: Cornielle has never faced the Lugnuts prior to this evening. He pitched against Oakland's ACL affiliate on <u>July 13, 2021</u> and had a no decision with three scoreless innings of relief. Cornielle walked one, allowed two hits, and struck out seven in that ACL game.

LANSING SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP KYLE VIRBITSKY: Oakland selected Virbitsky in the 17th round of the 2021 draft out of Penn State.

LIKE A LION: Virbitsky pitched four seasons at Penn State. He was 9-14 with a 4.45 ERA in 52 games – 19 starts – with 161 strikeouts over 153-2/3 innings during his college career. Virbitsky was 5-4 with a 4.17 ERA and 88 strikeouts over 77-2/3 innings pitched in thirteen starts during his senior year.

INTO THE WOODS: Virbitsky pitched for Kalamazoo in the Northwoods League during the 2018 season. He was 4-1 with a 2.48 ERA over twelve starts with Kalamazoo.

CAPITAL IDEA: Virbitsky started his professional career with Lansing after signing with Oakland. He was 1-2 in seven games – three starts – with 22 strikeouts and a 3.38 ERA over sixteen innings pitched last

HARD TO PORT: Virbitsky started this season with Stockton in the California League. He was 5-4 with a 4.78 ERA in sixteen games – fifteen starts – with 99 strikeouts over 86-2/3 innings before his promotion to Lansing on July 26.

LAST START: Virbitsky took the <u>loss to Great Lakes at home on</u> <u>August 20</u>. He allowed six runs – five earned – on six hits, two walks, a hit batsman, and five strikeouts over five innings pitched.

VS. WISCONSIN: Virbitsky has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
