ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The South Bend Cubs beat the nsin Timber Rattlers 7-1 at Four Winds Field. Pedro Ramirez broke a scoreless tie with a three-run triple in the bottom of the third. The Cubs added three runs in the fourth inning when the Rattlers committed two errors to let in one run and Casey Opitz followed with a two-run homer.

UNCHARACTERISTIC: Wisconsin committed two errors on Tuesday night. This marks the second straight game the Rattlers were charged with two errors. Wisconsin had been charged with four errors in the first sixteen games in May.

LOADED QUESTION: After Ramirez hit his basesloaded triple, opponents are now 13-for-25 with three doubles, two triples, and three home runs against Wisconsin pitchers this season.

FACING A BIG LEAGUER: Chicago Cubs pitcher Drew Smyly made a rehab start for South Bend on Tuesday. He pitched three perfect innings with five strikeouts on 40 pitches - 27 strikes.

DOUBLE TIME: Eduarqui Fernández doubled in the sixth inning for Wisconsin's only extra-base hit out of their six hits last night. Fernández, who now has nine doubles this season, also scored Wisconsin's only run when Jadher Areinamo drove him home with a sacrifice

DANG GOPHERS: Opitz and Felix Stevens both homered for South Bend last night. Wisconsin has allowed six homers in seven games against the Cubs this season. Stevens has three of those homers and Opitz has two. The Timber Rattlers have allowed a total of 34 homers this season. Only Lansing (43) and Dayton (39) have allowed more homers in the Midwest League so far this season.

DAYBREAK: The Timber Rattlers are 13-4 in day games this season. In May, the Rattlers are 6-1 in day games with the only loss to Great Lakes at home on May 5.

ABOUT SOUTH BEND: The South Bend Cubs started as the South Bend White Sox when the Midwest League added them as an expansion team in 1988. They changed their name to the Silver Hawks for the 1994 season and became an affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks in 1997. South Bend became an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs in 2015. South Bend has won Midwest League titles in 1989, 1993, 2005, 2019, and 2022. Notable alumni for the South Bend franchise include Mike Cameron, Jose Valverde, Chris Capuano, Mark Reynolds, Justin Upton, Wade Miley, Chase Anderson, Keon Broxton, Gleyber Torres, Ian Happ, Carlos Gonzalez, and current Timber Rattlers manager Victor Estevez. Terry Francona was the manager of the South Bend White Sox in 1982. Nick Lovullo, the son of Arizona Diamondbacks manager Torev Lovullo, is in his first year as South Bend's manager

ABOUT THE CUBS: The Chicago Cubs had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in South Bend in 2015. They were affiliated with Quincy from 1965 through 1973 before leaving the Midwest League. The Cubs returned to the MWL with an affiliation with Quad Cities from 1979 through 1984, Peoria from 1985 through 1994 and again from 2005 through 2012, Rockford from 1995 through 1998, Lansing from 1999 through 2004, and Kane County in 2013 and 2014.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

LHP TATE KUEHNER: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Kuehner in the seventh round of the 2023 draft out of the University of Louisville.

MARSHALLING THE PAST: Kuehner played high school baseball in Marshalltown, Iowa. Former Timber Rattlers catcher Jeff Clement, the #3 pick in the 2005 draft, also played his high school baseball at Marshalltown.

CARDINAL RULE: Kuehner pitched four seasons with Louisville. He was 15-13 with nine saves and a 3.69 ERA over 70 appearances – fourteen starts – for the Cardinals. Kuehner had 193 strikeouts over 165-2/3 innings. During the 2022 NCAA Regionals in Louisville, Kuehner earned two saves and a win over seven innings in three scoreless appearances for the Cardinals.

COLLEGE SUMMER LEAGUES: Kuehner made five appearances for Waterloo in the Northwoods League in 2020 and four appearances for Danbury in the New England Collegiate Baseball League in 2021.

DOWN IN THE DESERT: Kuehner made two appearances – one start – for the ACL Brewers in the regular season after signing with Milwaukee in 2023. He had no record with a walk and two strikeouts over three scoreless innings.

PLAYOFF CALL: Kuehner was the winning pitcher for the ACL Brewers in the ACL Semifinal Game against the ACL Rockies on <u>August 24, 2023</u>. He allowed a hit over two scoreless innings with no walks and two strikeouts. The Brewers won the game to advance to the ACL Championship Series.

LAST APPEARANCE: Kuehner earned the win with four scoreless innings of relief against Beloit at home on May 15. He allowed three hits, walked two, and struck out three.

LAST START: Kuehner had a no decision at Quad Cities on May 7. He allowed a run on a hit, a lead-off homer in the bottom of the first, walked three, and struck out six over four innings.

VS. SOUTH BEND: Kuehner had a no decision at South Bend on April 10 as a reliever. He allowed three runs on four hits with three walks and five strikeouts over two innings.

SOUTH BEND STARTING PITCHER:

RHP NICK HULL: The Chicago Cubs selected Hull in the seventh round of the 2022 draft out of Grand Canyon University.

WHERE THE DEER AND THE ANTELOPE PLAY: Hull pitched five seasons at Grand Canyon University. He was 15-5 with a save and a 4.04 ERA in 79 games – 25 starts – at GCU. Hull had 214 strikeouts over 220-2/3 innings in college.

IN THE SUMMER TIME: Hull pitched in three different Summer Collegiate Leagues during his time with GCU. He was at Bellingham of the West Coast League in 2018, Mankato of the Northwoods League in 2019, and Orleans of the Cape Cod League in 2021.

GETTING TO WORK: Hull made four appearances – three starts – in the Cubs system after signing his professional contract in 2022. He had one relief appearance in the Arizona Complex League and three starts for the Myrtle Beach Pelicans.

LAST SEASON: Hull started 2023 with Myrtle Beach and was 6-3 with a 4.30 ERA in eighteen games – fifteen starts – before getting bumped up to South Bend. Hull was 2-0 with a 3.24 ERA in five games – one start – with the Cubs.

LAST APPEARANCE: Hull had a no decision at Fort Wayne on May 17 as a reliever. He gave up two runs on three hits with two walks and four strikeouts over 4-1/3 innings.

LAST START: Hull beat Cedar Rapids at home on May 11. He allowed a run on five hits with two walks and three strikeouts over five innings

VS. WISCONSIN: Hull pitched five scoreless innings, allowed two hits, walked two, and struck out five against the Rattlers in South Bend on April 9. Hull was not involved in the decision.

THIS DATE IN TIMBER RATTLERS HISTORY

May 22, 1999: The Rattlers beat Cedar Rapids 5-4 at home. Wisconsin trailed 4-3 heading into the bottom of the ninth inning. There were two outs and none on base when Wisconsin rallied with Bo Robinson's two-run single sending the tying and winning runs home for the walkoff win. Juan Silvestre homered twice and drove in three runs for the other Wisconsin runs. The crowd of 5,804 was the second largest in Timber Rattlers history to that point of franchise history.

May 22, 2013: The Rattlers won 12-5 in eleven innings at Quad Cities. Wisconsin had a 5-0 lead after 5-1/2 innings, but the River Bandits scored twice in the sixth and twice in the eighth to get close. May 22, 2019: The Rattlers beat Peoria 7-2 at home. The Rattlers scored four runs in the fifth inning to take a 6-1 lead. Aaron Ashby allowed one run on five hits and struck out seven over 6-2/3 innings for the win.
