### SATURDAY IN THE PARK: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Beloit Sky Carp 8-7 at Neuroscience Group Field.](#)

Wisconsin had a 5-0 lead after Gregory Barrios hit a two-run double in the bottom of the fifth inning and Alexander Cornielle pitched five scoreless innings. The Sky Carp rallied for a run in the sixth, three runs in the eighth, and three runs in the ninth to take a 7-5 lead. Jesús Chirinos won the game with a three-run, walkoff homer in the bottom of the ninth.

**A PRESENCE I HAVE NOT FELT SINCE...** The walkoff homer by Chirinos was the first by a Timber Rattlers since Joey Wiemer hit a three-run, walkoff home run to beat Beloit on [September 5, 2021](#).

**HE JUST KEEPS HITTING:** Barrios was 2-for-3 with a double and three RBI for the Rattlers yesterday. Barrios has fourteen multi-hit games and seven multi-RBI games this season. He leads the Midwest League in doubles (14). Barrios leads Wisconsin with 26 RBI.

**HE JUST KEEPS PITCHING:** Cornielle pitched five scoreless innings, allowed two hits, walked two, and struck out four on Saturday. In three starts this month, Cornielle has pitched eighteen scoreless innings with seventeen strikeouts.

**ONE HIT REQUIRED:** Wisconsin took a 3-0 lead with three runs in the bottom of the first inning on one hit. Luis Lara reached on an error and Dylan O'Rae was hit by a pitch to start the frame. Barrios had an RBI single. Luke Adams added an RBI grounder and Matt Wood made it 3-0 with a sacrifice fly.

**ANATOMY OF A RALLY:** The Sky Carp went to Josh Ekness in the bottom of the ninth inning. Tayden Hall started the rally for Wisconsin when he drew a walk with one out. It was just the fourth walk issued by Ekness in 17-1/3 innings this season. Terence Doston followed with a single to center on a two-strike pitch. Chirinos cracked his walkoff homer on an 0-2 pitch. The homer was the first that Ekness gave up in his 26-1/3 innings as a professional.

**ABOUT BELOIT:** The Beloit Sky Carp changed their name from Snappers after the 2021 season. This is Beloit's third season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3, 2021. Billy Gardner Jr is in his second season as the manager of the Sky Carp. Prince Fielder, Rickie Weeks, Chris Bosio, Greg Vaughn, Joey Meyer, BJ Surhoff, Tim Dillard, and Mitch Stetter played in Beloit.

**ABOUT THE MARLINS:** The Florida/Miami Marlins have lots of history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan. The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for 2021.

# PITCHING MATCHUP

## WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

**LHP DL HALL:** Milwaukee acquired Hall in a trade with the Baltimore Orioles on February 1, 2024. The Brewers traded former Timber Rattler Corbin Burnes to the Orioles in exchange for Hall, Joey Ortiz, and a 2024 Competitive Balance Round A selection.

**ORIGIN STORY:** Hall was selected in the first round of the 2017 draft out of Valdosta (GA) High School by the Orioles.

**CLIMBING THE LADDER:** Hall started his professional career in the Gulf Coast League in 2017 and moved to Delmarva (2018), Frederick (2019), and the Orioles Alternate Training Site in 2020. He made seven starts for Bowie, Baltimore's Double-A team in 2021 and 22 appearances (18 starts) for Norfolk, the Orioles Triple-A team in 2022.

**IN THE SHOW:** Hall made his MLB debut on August 13, 2022 as the starting pitcher for Baltimore against Tampa Bay. He allowed five runs on five hits and three walks with six strikeouts over 3-2/3 innings to take the loss. In parts of two seasons with Baltimore, Hall was 4-1 in 29 games – one start – with a 4.36 ERA and 42 strikeouts in 33 innings pitched.

**BREW CITY:** Hall was 0-1 in four starts for Milwaukee this season. He has walked ten and struck out thirteen in 16-1/3 innings pitched.

**LAST START:** Hall had a no decision at St. Louis on [April 20](#). He allowed four runs on five hits and five walks over 3-2/3 innings in Milwaukee's 12-5 win over the Cardinals. Hall struck out three in the game. He was placed on Milwaukee's 15-Day IL with a left knee sprain on April 21.

**VS. БЕЛОИТ:** Hall has never faced the Beloit Sky Carp prior to this afternoon's game.

## BELOIT SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP ALEX WILLIAMS:** The Marlins selected Williams in the eleventh round of the 2022 draft out of Stanford.

**THE CARDINAL:** Williams pitched four seasons at Stanford and was 23-8 with a 2.88 ERA in 47 games – 42 starts. He had 211 strikeouts in 237-2/3 innings pitched during his college career.

**TROPHY CASE:** Williams was the Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year and a First Team All-American for Collegiate Baseball and College Baseball Foundation after he went 8-4 with a 3.20 ERA in eighteen starts in helping Stanford win the Pac-12 regular season and tournament championships. Williams had 96 strikeouts over 101-1/3 innings pitched as a senior at Stanford.

**AT THE COMPLEX:** Williams signed with Miami and made two brief starts in for the Florida Complex Marlins without a decision in 2022. In five innings, he didn't allow a hit, a walk, or a run while striking out five.

**LAST SEASON:** Williams made 21 starts for the Sky Carp in 2023. He was 2-8 with a 5.06 ERA. He walked 35 and struck out 107 over 99-2/3 innings pitched.

**LAST START:** Williams lost to Peoria at home on [May 12](#). He allowed nine runs – six earned – on nine hits and two walks with six strikeouts over four innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN (2023):** Williams was 1-2 in three starts – [April 8](#) at Beloit, [July 4](#) at Wisconsin, and [September 10](#) at Beloit – against the Rattlers last season. In his first two starts, Williams pitched eleven innings, allowed two runs on nine hits, walked two, and struck out eleven. In his final start against the Rattlers last season, Williams allowed three runs on seven hits with a walk and three strikeouts over five innings. Wisconsin beat him on July 4 and September 10 last year.
