WEDNESDAY AFTERNOON: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Cedar Rapids Kernels 4-2 in ten innings.](#)

Joe Gray Jr hit a two-out, three-run home run in the top of the tenth to break a 1-1 tie. Brandon Jordan got the final two outs in the bottom of the tenth for his first save of the season.

REDEMPTION ARC: Gray made the last out of the first, third, and fifth innings and stranded five runners over his first three at bats on Wednesday. He also grounded out to third to start the eighth inning. Gray hit a 1-1 pitch with runners at the corners with two outs in the top of the tenth to give the Rattlers their first lead of the game.

DID YOU KNOW? Wisconsin has scored five runs in extra innings this season. Gray has knocked in four of those five runs.

HOW DID WE GET THERE? The Kernels took a 1-0 lead on a solo homer by Misael Urbina in the bottom of the second. Eduarqui Fernández tied the game with an RBI double in the top of the fourth.

SHUTDOWN MODE: Noah Miller singled after Urbina's home run in the second. The Kernels wouldn't get another hit until an RBI single by Jeferson Morales in the tenth inning. Alexander Cornielle worked 5-1/3 innings as the Wisconsin starting pitcher and turned the game over to Ryan Brady after a one-out walk in the bottom of the sixth. Brady tossed 2-2/3 scoreless, hitless innings. Karlos Morales worked around a two-out walk in the bottom of the ninth and got the first out in the bottom of the tenth. Jordan gave up the single to Morales before getting the final two outs.

LET'S GO! Yesterday was the first road game this season the Rattlers won after their opponents scored first.

MAKING MOVES: The Milwaukee Brewers made roster moves prior to Tuesday and Wednesday. Pitcher Russell Smith was transferred to Biloxi on Tuesday. Pitcher Caleb Bowman was transferred to Biloxi on Wednesday.

ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS: The current franchise began its existence as the Cedar Rapids Braves, an affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves in the Three-I League, in 1958. That was the same year and league the current Timber Rattlers franchise joined the Three-I League as the Fox Cities Foxes. Both teams moved to the Midwest League when the Three-I League ended after the 1961 season. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels have made the Midwest League playoffs every year they have been affiliated with the Twins. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, Trevor Hoffman, Brewers Pitching Coach Chris Hook, and Ted Simmons.

ABOUT THE TWINS: Minnesota has a long history of in the Midwest League. They started out with Wisconsin Rapids (1964-1983) and moved to Kenosha (1984-1992) and to Fort Wayne (1993-1998) as the franchise moved. Minnesota has also been with Quad Cities (1999-2004) and Beloit (2005-2012) before their current affiliation with Cedar Rapids Kernels started in 2013.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: [MLB Pipeline](#) places five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Eric Brown Jr (#6), Robert Moore (#8), Eduardo García (#19), Matthew Wood (#24), and Joseph Hernandez (#25). Hendry Mendez (#13) is currently on Wisconsin's IL. [MLB Pipeline](#) has nine active Kernels on their list of Minnesota prospects: Emmanuel Rodriguez (#3), Marco Raya (#6), Jose Salas (#9), Noah Miller (#13), Tanner Schobel (#16), Misael Urbina (#21), Alejandro Hidalgo (#22), Ben Ross (#28), and Jaylin Nowlin (#29). Connor Prellipp (#5) is currently on the IL.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP EDWIN JIMENEZ: Milwaukee signed Jimenez as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela on October 11, 2018.

HEADING TO THE CO-OP: Jimenez was assigned to the Dominican Summer League Co-op team shared between Milwaukee and Cleveland for the 2019 season. Jimenez was 1-5 with a 3.05 ERA in twelve games – eight starts. He walked 26 and struck out 32 over 41-1/3 innings in his first professional season.

FROM THE ISLAND TO THE DESERT: Jimenez started the 2021 season with Milwaukee's number two affiliate in the Dominican Summer League. He was assigned to the Brewers Blue affiliate in the Arizona Complex League on August 7, 2021. Jimenez went 1-1 with a 1.72 ERA in five games – four starts – in the DSL and 0-4 with a save and a 5.25 ERA in the ACL. He walked twelve and struck out 48 over 39-2/3 innings combined between his two stops in the system that season.

CAROLINA ON MY MIND: Jimenez was 4-7 in 25 games – seventeen starts – with the Carolina Mudcats in 2022. He had a 4.75 ERA, walked 41, and struck out 104 over 113-2/3 innings pitched in the Carolina League last season. Jimenez started the 2023 season with Carolina and went 2-0 in four games – one start – with five walks and 23 strikeouts over eighteen innings before his promotion to Wisconsin on May 2.

LAST APPEARANCE: Jimenez pitched 4-1/3 shutout innings as a reliever against [Quad Cities at home on May 19](#). He gave up two hits with three walks and nine strikeouts. One of the walks was intentional. Jimenez had a no decision in the game.

LAST START: Jimenez was the Opening Night starter for Carolina at Fayetteville on [April 7, 2023 and had a no decision](#). He allowed a run on three hits with two walks and five strikeouts over four innings. The game was halted by rain after four innings and resumed on April 9.

VS. CEDAR RAPIDS: Jimenez has never pitched against the Kernels. Tonight is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Minnesota Twins.

CEDAR RAPIDS SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP KYLE JONES: The Twins selected Jones in the seventh round of the 2022 draft out of Toledo.

UPS AND DOWNS: Jones was 3-0 with a 4.50 ERA in sixteen games as a freshman. In his sophomore season, he went 0-3 with an 11.70 ERA in six appearances. Jones junior season saw him go 1-10 in fourteen games – twelve starts – with a 5.53 ERA. In his senior year, Jones went 7-3 with a save and a 4.24 ERA. He was selected as First-Team All-MAC and was a three-time MAC Pitcher of the Week in his final season.

A ROCKET FOR AN ARM: Jones has 229 strikeouts over 220-2/3 innings pitched during his career at Toledo. Jones had 114 strikeouts in 91-1/3 innings pitched as a senior to set the school record.

GOING PRO: Jones made his professional debut on August 19, 2022 with a scoreless, hitless inning with no walks and no strikeouts for the FCL Twins against the Red Sox. He was not involved in the decision.

MOVING UP: Jones only other appearance as a pro in 2022 was three innings of scoreless relief for Fort Myers on September 9 against St. Lucie. He allowed two hits, walked none, struck out five, and picked up the win.

LAST APPEARANCE: Jones was the [winner in relief against Peoria at home on May 19](#). He allowed four runs – two earned – on six hits with a walk and a strikeout over four innings.

LAST START: Jones had a [no decision at Quad Cities on May 13](#).

He allowed a run on three hits with two walks and five strikeouts over four innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Jones has never pitched against the Timber Rattlers. Tonight is the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
