ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers lost 5-0 to the Quad Cities River Bandits at Modern Woodmen Park. The Bandits scored a run in the first, two runs in the third, and two runs in the eighth. All five runs scored after there were two outs. Four Quad Cities pitchers combined to shut out the Rattlers on five hits. Last night was just the second time Wisconsin has been shutout this season. The Rattlers had gone 65 straight games without being shut out before last night.

MISSED IT BY THAT MUCH: The 2005 Timber Rattlers went 66 straight games without being shutout. **DOUBLE TIME:** Cooper Pratt went 3-for-3 with a walk and three doubles for Wisconsin last night. He's the second Rattler with three doubles in a game in 2024.

CHANCES WERE: The Timber Rattlers loaded the bases with one out in the sixth and eighth inning but failed to score. Wisconsin left ten runners on base and went 0-for-8 with runners in scoring position last night.

LOOK OUT: Four Wisconsin batters were hit by pitches last night. Luke Adams was hit twice to run his MiLB-leading total to 33 HBP for the season.

ABOUT QUAD CITIES: The River Bandits are the Midwest League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. The current version of Davenport Professional Baseball club started in 1960 as the Midwest League affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves. Quad Cities has affiliated with several MLB teams: The California Angels (1962-1978 and 1985-1992), the Chicago Cubs (1979-1984), the Houston Astros (1993-1998 and 2013-2019), the Minnesota Twins (1999-2004), and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005-2012). The team became the Quad City River Bandits in 1992. They changed their name to the Swing of the Quad Cities from 2004 through 2007 before changing to Quad Cities River Bandits in 2008. Quad Cities won Midwest League pennants in 1968, 1971, 1979, 1990, 2011, 2013, and 2017. They were the High-A Central League champions in 2021. Notable alumni of Quad Cities: Carlos Correa, Joe Mauer, Josh Hader, Billy Wagner, Shawon Dunston, Justin Morneau, and Brett Phillips.

ABOUT THE ROYALS: The Kansas City Royals have been Quad Cities' parent club since 2021. They left the Midwest league and an affiliation with Kane County at the end of the 2012 season. The Royals had previously been in the Midwest League with Waterloo (1969-1976), Appleton (1987-1992), Rockford (1993-94), Springfield (1995), Lansing (1996-1998), Burlington (2001-2010), and Kane County (2011-2012).

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

LHP MARK MANFREDI: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Manfredi in the 9th round of the 2023 draft out of the University of Dayton.

THE COLLEGE BEFORE COLLEGE: Manfredi pitched two abbreviated seasons at Sinclair Community College in Dayton before moving to the University of Dayton. Manfredi was 2-1 with a 3.38 ERA in seven games – three starts – in his two seasons at Sinclair.

RADIO FLYER: Manfredi pitched two seasons at Dayton. He was 4-6 with a 4.42 ERA in 29 games – 24 starts – with 158 strikeouts over 138-1/3 innings pitched. Manfredi finished third in the Atlantic 10 in strikeouts for his senior season.

SUMMER CATCH: Manfredi made three starts for Wareham in the Cape Cod League prior to the 2023 draft. He had 16 strikeouts over 13 innings with a 2.08 ERA with three no decisions before signing with Milwaukee.

PLAYOFF CALL: Manfredi did not pitch as a professional in the regular season last year. However, he was the starting pitcher for the ACL Brewers in their semifinal playoff game against the ACL Rockies on August 24, 2023. He pitched a scoreless inning with a walk and three strikeouts.

LAST APPEARANCE: Manfredi had a no decision against South Bend at home on [August 2](#). He allowed two runs on no hits and three walks with a strikeout in 2/3 of an inning.

LAST START: Manfredi had a no decision at Beloit on [July 1](#). He allowed no runs on no hits with three walks and two strikeouts over 1-2/3 innings.

VS. QUAD CITIES: Manfredi is 1-0 in two games – one start – against the River Bandits this season. He has allowed eight runs – six earned – on seven hits with five walks and eight strikeouts over 6-2/3 innings.

QUAD CITIES STARTING PITCHER:

RHP HENRY WILLIAMS: The Kansas City Royals acquired Williams and Jesus Rios from the San Diego Padres in exchange for Scott Barlow in a trade on August 1, 2023. MLB Pipeline ranks Williams as the #27 prospect in the Kansas City system. *Baseball America* places him at #29 in the Royals organization.

ORIGIN STORY: The Padres selected Williams in the third round of the 2022 draft out of Duke.

AM I BLUE? Williams was 3-3 with a 3.65 ERA in eight games – six starts – for Duke in 2021. He did not pitch for the Blue Devils in 2022 due to Tommy John Surgery.

GO JUMP IN A LAKE: Williams began his pro career with the Lake Elsinore Storm in the California League in 2023. He was 1-5 with a 5.74 ERA in twelve starts. Williams walked 21 and struck out 40 in 42-1.3 innings.

FIREFLIES: Williams made five starts for Columbia, Kansas City's Carolina League affiliate, after the trade. He was 2-1 with a 3.38 ERA, thirteen walks, and 23 strikeouts over 24 innings pitched.

LAST START: Williams won at Peoria on [August 1](#). He allowed a run on three hits with no walks and five strikeouts over five innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Williams is 0-2 in two starts against the Timber Rattlers this season. He has allowed seven runs – six earned – on seven hits with five walks and eleven strikeouts over ten innings.
