ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers swept a doubleheader from the Beloit Sky Carp at ABC Supply Stadium. Wisconsin won game one 1-0 and game two 7-4.

GAME ONE RECAP: Darrien Miller cracked a one-out home run in the top of the seventh to break a scoreless tie and give Wisconsin the only run of the game. Russell Smith (4IP), Zach Mort (2IP), and James Meeker (IP) combined to shut out the Sky Carp on two hits.

GAME TWO RECAP: Wisconsin took a 4-0 lead with four runs in the top of the third inning on an RBI single by Sal Frelick, a two-run double by Joe Gray Jr., and an error that allowed Gray to score. Beloit tied the game with two runs in the fourth and a two-run home run by Davis Bradshaw in the fifth. The Rattlers took the lead for good in the top of the seventh on a run-scoring error with two outs. Gray added a two-run homer for some insurance and Cam Robinson pitched a 1-2-3 seventh for the save and the sweep.

A MAN CALLED SMITH: Russell Smith made his professional debut last night. The Wisconsin starter in game one allowed two hits, walked two, and struck out four over four innings. He escaped a bases-loaded, one-out jam in the first inning with back-to-back strikeouts.

MILLER TIME: Miller had a double and a home run on Tuesday and added a double and a homer in game one of last night's doubleheader.

GRAY AREA: Last night was Gray's second 4RBI game at Beloit in his career. He also drove in four runs at ABC Supply Stadium on August 3, 2021.

A HISTORY LESSON: Wisconsin is off to a 5-1 start for only the third time in team history. The Rattlers began the year 5-1 in both 1998 and 2005 prior to this year. Also, the Rattlers have won four games in a row to match their longest winning streak of 2021.

ABOUT BELOIT: The Beloit Sky Carp are in their first season as the Sky Carp and their second season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3. Jorge Hernandez is in his first season as the manager of the Sky Carp.

ABOUT THE MARLINS: The Florida/Miami Marlins have a history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan. The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for 2021.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline puts eight Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Sal Frelick (#1), Tyler Black (#6), Joe Gray Jr. (#13), Antoine Kelly (#14), Russell Smith (#16), Xavier Warren (#17), Carlos Rodríguez (#21), and Cam Robinson (#26). MLB Pipeline has six current Sky Carp on their Top 30 list of Miami Marlins prospects: Dax Fulton (#9), Victor Mesa Jr. (#14), Cody Morissette (#16), Nasim Nunez (#18), Justin Evans (#19), and Tanner Allen (#23).

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP MAX LAZAR: Selected by Milwaukee in the 11th round of the 2017 draft out of Coral Springs (FL) High School.

THE OWLS ARE NOT WHAT THEY SEEM: Lazar signed with the Brewers over a commitment to Florida Atlantic University.

AS A RATTLER IN THE PAST: Lazar was 7-3 with a 2.39 ERA in nineteen games – ten starts – for Wisconsin in 2019. He had 109 strikeouts and just fifteen walks in 79 innings pitched that season.

GET BACK TO WHERE YOU ONCE BELONGED: Lazar missed the 2020 season due to the pandemic and the 2021 season due to injury. He allowed one run on seven hits with no walks and ten strikeouts over seven innings at Peoria on August 20 to pick up the win. Lazar set a new professional single-game for strikeouts and innings pitched in that start.

LAST APPEARANCE: Lazar was the winning pitcher as a reliever in [game two of a doubleheader with the Peoria Chiefs on April 10 at home](#). Lazar gave up a run on three hits with a walk and a strikeout over two innings. He gave up a solo home run in the top of the seventh. Then, Wisconsin scored twice in the bottom of the seventh to rally for a 3-2 win.

LAST START: Lazar lost [at Clinton on August 26, 2019](#). He allowed six runs on five hits with no walks and five strikeouts over 3-2/3 innings. The LumberKings were the Marlins affiliate that season.

VS. MARLINS: Lazar went 1-1 in three games – two starts – against the LumberKings in 2019. He allowed eight runs on ten hits with two walks and 21 strikeouts over 13-1/3 innings pitched against Clinton. Those are his only appearances against an affiliate of the Miami Marlins prior to tonight.

BELOIT SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

LHP DAX FULTON: The Marlins selected Fulton in the 2nd round of the 2020 draft out of Mustang High School in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma.

SOONER GO PRO: Fulton signed with the Marlins over a commitment to the University of Oklahoma. MLB Pipeline rates Fulton as the #9 prospect in the Marlins organization.

KING OF PLANETS: Fulton was 2-4 in fifteen games – fourteen starts – with the Jupiter Hammerheads, the Low-A Southeast affiliate of the Marlins before his promotion to Beloit. Fulton had 66 strikeouts and 30 walks in 58-2/3 innings with a 4.30 ERA with Jupiter.

WELCOME TO WISCONSIN: Fulton made his Beloit debut on August 18 with [a loss in a start against Peoria at home](#). He allowed four runs – three earned – on six hits with a walk and a strikeout over five innings.

LAST START: Fulton lost [at Cedar Rapids on April 8](#). He allowed six runs on four hits with four walks and four strikeouts over 3-2/3 innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Fulton had a no decision [against the Timber Rattlers at Neuroscience Group Field on September 1, 2021](#). He allowed two runs on four hits with a walk and five strikeouts in the game. The Timber Rattlers rallied from a 5-2 deficit and won the game 6-5 after Fulton left the game.
