ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Lansing Lugnuts 3-0 in Wisconsin's first home game since June 4.](#) The Rattlers scored three runs in the bottom of the second inning and four pitchers combined on the four-hit shutout.

MISIOROWSKI REPORT: Wisconsin starting pitcher Jacob Misiorowski allowed three hits, walked two, and struck out five in his first start at Neuroscience Group Field. He left with two outs in the top of the fifth inning with 86 pitches – 52 strikes for a no decision. In three starts with Wisconsin, Misiorowski has allowed an unearned run on five hits with five walks and ten strikeouts over thirteen innings.

SHUT DOWN MODE: Karlos Morales, Brannon Jordan, and Luis Amaya followed Misiorowski to the mound to record Wisconsin's second shutout of the season. Morales walked three and struck out three over two innings, Jordan tossed 1-1/3 innings with a strikeout, and Amaya allowed a hit and got a strikeout in the ninth.

BACK-TO-BACK: Amaya has saves in two straight games. He also had a save on Sunday at Great Lakes in the road finale at Great Lakes.

LAST TIME IT HAPPENED: The previous shutout by Wisconsin pitching happened on April 19 at Quad Cities for a 2-0 win.

THERE WAS OFFENSE: The Timber Rattlers scored their first run on an error and their second run on a wild pitch. Je'Von Ward capped the scoring with an RBI single.

GRAY HAVENS: Joe Gray Jr is on an eight-game hitting streak, his longest streak of the season. He is 12-for-33 during the streak.

ERROR FREE: The Timber Rattlers have not been charged with an error in three of their last four games. They have played 28 errorless games in 2023.

FIRST HALF FINISH: The first half of the Midwest League season ends on Thursday, June 22. The second half opener is Friday, June 23.

ABOUT THE LANSING LUGNUTS: The Lugnuts began their existence as the Lafayette (IN) Chiefs of the Mississippi-Ohio Valley League in 1955. Lafayette became the Red Sox in 1956 and as the Mississippi-Ohio Valley League became the Midwest League. The franchise moved Waterloo, Iowa in 1958 and remained there as the Hawks, Royals, Indians, and Diamonds until the end of the 1993 season. New ownership bought the team and moved them to Springfield, Illinois for two seasons before finally locating the team in Lansing, Michigan in 1996. Since they started in Lansing, the Lugnuts were affiliated with the Kansas City Royals (1996-1998), the Chicago Cubs (1999-2004), the Toronto Blue Jays (2005-2019), and the Oakland Athletics. The Lugnuts won Midwest League titles in 1997 and 2003. Notable Lansing alumni include Kevin Appier, Carlos Beltrán, Rich Hill, Mark Prior, Carlos Zambrano, Bo Bichette, Vladimir Guerrero Jr, Danny Janssen, Noah Syndergaard, and Rowdy Tellez.

ABOUT THE ATHLETICS: The Athletics have been on and off in the Midwest League since moving from Kansas City to Oakland for the 1968 season. They were in Burlington from 1968 through 1974. Oakland returned to the Midwest League in 1982 to be the parent club of the Madison Muskies and stayed in Madison through 1993. Oakland's affiliation stayed with the franchise after its move to West Michigan in 1994. Oakland left the league after the 1997 season only to return with Kane County as their affiliate from 2003 through 2010. From there, Oakland went to Burlington (2011-2012), Beloit (2013-2019), and now Lansing since 2021.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: [MLB Pipeline](#) places five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Jacob Misiorowski (#4), Eric Brown Jr (#6), Robert Moore (#8), Eduardo García (#19), and Matthew Wood (#24). Hendry Mendez (#13) and Joseph Hernandez (#25) are currently on Wisconsin's IL. [MLB Pipeline](#) has seven current Lansing players on their Top 30 list of Athletics prospects: Daniel Susac (#4), Max Muncy (#6), Clark Elliott (#15), Brayan Buelvas (#22), Euribiel Angeles (#24), Jacob Watters (#26), and Joelvis Del Rosario (#29).

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP CAMERON WAGONER: Selected by Milwaukee in the eleventh round of the 2022 draft out of Eastern Michigan University.

EASTERN NOTES: Wagoner did not pitch collegiately in 2022. He made six relief appearances during the abbreviated 2020 season and 18 appearances – three starts – in 2021. He was 2-4 with a 4.42 ERA and 67 strikeouts over 57 innings during his two college seasons.

HOW DID YOU SPEND YOUR SUMMERS? Wagoner played for Greeneville in the Appalachian League in 2021 and was with both Wareham and Cotuit in the Cape Cod League in 2022. He was 2-3 with a 4.97 ERA in nineteen games – two starts – and 57 strikeouts over 38 innings pitched in those summer leagues.

AS A PRO: Wagoner made four appearances – two starts – for the ACL Brewers Gold after signing with Milwaukee. He was 1-0 and had eight strikeouts in eight innings in the ACL.

DOWN UNDER: Wagoner pitched for the Brisbane Bandits of the Australian Baseball League during the Winter of 2022-23. He made ten starts during the regular season of the ABL and was 3-1 with a 3.26 ERA and 43 strikeouts in 47 innings pitched.

LAST START: Wagoner lost at Great Lakes on [June 15](#). He allowed three runs on six hits and three walks with three strikeouts over five innings. The Loons broke a 2-2 tie with a two-out RBI double in the bottom of the fifth inning and went on to win the game 3-2.

VS. LANSING: Wagoner has never faced the Lugnuts prior to this afternoon. Wagoner made his pro debut against the ACL Athletics on [August 5, 2022](#) with a one inning start. He did not allow a hit, a walk, or a run and had a strikeout in the no decision in his only other appearance against an affiliate of the Oakland Athletics.

LANSING SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

LHP Brady Basso: The Athletics selected Basso in the sixteenth round of the 2019 draft out of Oklahoma State University.

I WANNA BE A COWBOY: Basso pitched three seasons at Oklahoma State from 2017-2019. He made 44 appearances – seven starts – and was 4-5 with a save, a 5.76ERA, and 73 strikeouts over 65-2/3 innings pitched at OSU.

TO THE COMPLEX: Basso's first pro season was spent with the Athletics Gold in the Arizona League after signing with Oakland. He made fifteen appearances – one start – with no record, a 1.75 ERA, and 38 strikeouts over 25-2/3 innings pitched.

THE FIRST TIME AROUND: Basso spent part of the 2021 season with the Lugnuts and was 2-2 with a 4.71 ERA in seven games – four starts. He made a relief appearance against Great Lakes on June 15, 2021 and was shut down for the rest of the season.

BACK AT IT: Basso didn't get back on the mound in a game until [May 3, 2023](#) for a scoreless, hitless relief appearance against Dayton. He walked one and struck out three over 1-2/3 innings in that appearance.

LAST START: Basso lost at South Bend on [June 7](#). He allowed a run on two hits with a walk and two strikeouts over three innings.

LAST APPEARANCE: Basso beat Peoria at home on [June 15](#). He allowed a run on two hits with a walk and two strikeouts over three innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Basso has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this afternoon. Today is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers since 2019. Basso made a relief appearance against the Brewers Blue on [July 5, 2019](#) and another relief appearance against the Brewers Gold on [August 12, 2019](#). Basso allowed an unearned run on two hits with a walk and six strikeouts over 4-2/3 innings total against Milwaukee affiliates in 2019.
