### WEDNESDAY AFTERNOON: [The Lansing Lugnuts beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 3-1 at Neuroscience Group Field.](#)

Wisconsin scored a run in the first inning and carried a 1-0 lead through seven innings. The Lugnuts scored three runs in the top of the eighth to take the lead. They would hold on to go 2-0 in the series as they won their third game in a row. Tommy White went 3-for-4 with a walk for Lansing.

**QUICK START:** The first three Rattlers to bat in the bottom of the first reached base. Tayden Hall and Blake Burke walked to start the game. Jadhre Areinamo drove in Hall with a single for the early 1-0 lead.

**MAN, WELL!** Wisconsin starting pitcher Manuel Rodriguez allowed three hits, walked one, and struck out four over six scoreless innings yesterday. Rodriguez leads the Midwest League in innings pitched (16.0) and strikeouts (19).

**SPARK PLUG:** Hall hit in Wisconsin's lead-off spot for the third game in a row yesterday. He walked three times and scored a run while going 0-for-1. In those three games at the top spot in the order, Hall has reached base eight times and scored four runs.

**SIX PACK:** Areinamo had two hits yesterday to move his hitting streak to six games. He is 7-for-24 (.294) during the streak. Wednesday was his first multi-hit game of the streak and second of the season. Areinamo's double was his fifth and he is tied for the Midwest League lead in doubles with teammate Eduardo Garcia and four other players.

**JAMMED UP:** Wisconsin reliever Zach Peek escaped a first and third no out jam in the seventh. However, the Lugnuts loaded the bases with no outs in the inning against Peek and scored all three runners against Yerlin Rodriguez on two singles and a hit batsman.

**PLAYING IT CLEAN:** Wisconsin's defense played their fifth consecutive errorless game yesterday. The Rattlers have been charged with three errors in their last ten games.

**ABOUT THE LANSING LUGNUTS:** The Lugnuts began their existence as the Lafayette (IN) Chiefs of the Mississippi-Ohio Valley League in 1955. Lafayette became the Red Sox in 1956 and as the Mississippi-Ohio Valley League became the Midwest League. The franchise moved Waterloo, Iowa in 1958 and remained there as the Hawks, Royals, Indians, and Diamonds until the end of the 1993 season. New ownership bought the team and moved them to Springfield, Illinois for two seasons before finally locating the team in Lansing, Michigan in 1996. Since they started in Lansing, the Lugnuts were affiliated with the Kansas City Royals (1996-1998), the Chicago Cubs (1999-2004), the Toronto Blue Jays (2005-2019), and the Athletics. The Lugnuts won Midwest League titles in 1997 and 2003. Notable Lansing alumni include Kevin Appier, Carlos Beltrán, Rich Hill, Mark Prior, Carlos Zambrano, Bo Bichette, Vladimir Guerrero Jr, Danny Janssen, Noah Syndergaard, and Rowdy Tellez.

**ABOUT THE ATHLETICS:** The Athletics have been on and off in the Midwest League since the 1968 season. They were in Burlington from 1968 through 1974 before leaving the league. The A's returned to the Midwest League in 1982 to be the parent club of the Madison Muskies and stayed in Madison through 1993. Their affiliation stayed with the franchise after its move to West Michigan in 1994. The Athletics left the league again after the 1997 season only to return with Kane County as their affiliate from 2003 through 2010. From there, they went to Burlington (2011-2012), Beloit (2013-2019), and now Lansing since 2021.

# PITCHING MATCHUP

## WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

**LHP ANTHONY FLORES:** The Milwaukee Brewers signed Flores as an International Free Agent on June 4, 2022.

**ON AN ISLAND:** Flores pitched the 2022 and 2023 season in the Dominican Summer League. He combined to go 3-8 with a 4.42 ERA and 87 strikeouts over 79-1/3 innings in 22 games – eighteen starts.

**COMING TO AMERICA:** Flores made twelve appearances in the Arizona Complex League and seven appearances with the Carolina Mudcats in 2024. He combined to go 5-4 with a 5.17 ERA and 85 strikeouts and 27 walks over 69-2/3 innings.

**LAST APPEARANCE:** Flores blew a save and took the loss at Quad Cities on [April 11](#). He allowed two runs on four hits with a walk and five strikeouts over three innings as a reliever.

**LAST START:** Flores had a no decision against Delmarva on [September 7, 2024](#) as the starter for Carolina. He allowed three runs on seven hits with two walks and five strikeouts over 3-1/3 innings.

**VS. LANSING:** Flores has never faced the Lugnuts prior to this evening. He made two appearances against the ACL Athletics in 2024 as a member of the ACL Brewers. He allowed three runs on three hits with two walks, six strikeouts, and no record over 4-2/3 innings.

## LANSING SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP KYLE ROBINSON:** The Athletics selected Robinson in the eleventh round of the 2024 draft out of Texas Tech.

**RED RAIDER:** Robinson pitched three seasons at Texas Tech University. He was 6-8 with two saves and a 5.14 ERA in 45 games – twenty starts – in college. Robinson walked 62 and struck out 133 over 133 innings pitched in his Texas Tech career.

**SUMMER BALL:** Robinson pitched for Bethesda of the Cal Ripken Collegiate League in 2022 and Santa Barbara of the California Collegiate League in 2023. He was 3-3 with a 3.00 ERA and 29 strikeouts over 33 innings pitched in summer ball.

**STOCK FOOTAGE:** Robinson made his pro debut with Stockton last season. He made three appearances – two starts - with a 7.71 ERA and nine strikeouts over seven innings in his cameo with the Ports.

**LAST START:** Robinson lost to Great Lakes at home on [April 10](#). He allowed three runs – one earned – on six hits with a walk and four strikeouts over five innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Robinson has never faced Wisconsin prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
