ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Cedar Rapids Kernels beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 9-8 at Perfect Game Field. Wisconsin had an 8-3 lead after the top of the fourth inning, but the Kernels rallied with a run in the bottom of the fourth, three runs in the bottom of the seventh, and two runs in the bottom of the ninth. Yunior Severino's RBI double tied the game and Wander Javier's RBI single won the game for the second walkoff win of the series for the Kernels.

EARLY AND OFTEN: The Timber Rattlers scored two runs in each of the first four innings. Joe Gray Jr. and Je'Von Ward each had an RBI in the first and fourth innings. Felix Valerio hit a two-run homer in the second and LG Castillo hit a two-run homer in the third.

THREE IS A MAGIC NUMBER: Gray, Zavier Warren, and Antonio Piñero each had three hits in the game for Wisconsin last night.

SUDDENLY CLOSE: Wisconsin had an 8-4 lead with two on and two out in the bottom of the sixth inning when Seth Gray hit a three-run homer to make it a one-

A STREAK: Wisconsin pitchers have allowed at least one home run in eleven straight games. The Timber Rattlers have allowed 23 homers in the streak.

ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS: The Cedar Rapids Kernels are charter members of the High-A Central League. The current franchise began its existence as the Cedar Rapids Braves, an affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves in the Three-I League in 1958. That was the same year and league the current Timber Rattlers franchise joined the Three-I League as the Fox Cities Foxes. Both teams moved to the Midwest League when the Three-I League ended after the 1961 season. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels made the Midwest League playoffs every year they were affiliated with the Twins. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, Trevor Hoffman, and Ted Simmons

ABOUT THE TWINS: Minnesota's former High-A Affiliate was the Fort Myers Miracle in the Florida State League. From 1995 through 2019, the Twins were affiliated with four teams in the Midwest League. They were with the Fort Wayne Wizards (1995-1998), Quad City River Bandits (1999-2005), Beloit Snappers (2006-2012), and Cedar Rapids Kernels (2013-2019)

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline puts five Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Joe Gray Jr (#9), Zavier Warren (#14), Carlos Rodríguez (#22), Joey Wiemer (#23), and Victor Castañeda (#30). MLB Pipeline has five Kernels on their list of Twins prospects: Matt Canterino (#10), Matt Wallner (#14), Wander Javier (#21), Yunior Severino (#27), and Louie Varland (#29). Blayne Enlow (#15) is currently on the Kernels injured list.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

LHP NICK BENNETT: Selected by the Brewers in the 6th round of the 2019 draft out of the University of Louisville.

LOUISVILLE: Bennett was 7-3 with a 4.40ERA in sixteen starts during his final season with the Cardinals. He went 20-6 in 45 games – 40 starts – during his career at Louisville with 209 strikeouts over 215-2/3 innings pitched.

DREAMS OF OMAHA: Bennett made two starts for the Cardinals in the College World Series. He was the starter against TCU as a freshman on June 22, 2017 and took the loss. Bennett started against Mississippi State on June 20, 2019 for a no decision in a game that Louisville rallied from a 3-0 deficit to win 4-3.

TO THE SPRINGS: Bennett made his pro debut with the Rocky Mountain Vibes, the Pioneer League affiliate of the Brewers. He appeared in six games – three starts – for the Vibes and allowed two earned runs with 19K in 12-2/3 innings.

ON WISCONSIN: Bennett appeared in five games – three starts – for the Timber Rattlers in 2019. He walked four and struck out 24 in 20-1/3 innings pitched with Wisconsin. Bennet was 1-0 with a 2.21 ERA. One of his starts with the Rattlers was at Clinton, the Miami Marlins affiliate at the time, and he matched his professional high for strikeouts in a single game with seven and set a single-game high as a pro for innings pitched with 5-2/3

THIS YEAR: Bennett started this season with the Timber Rattlers and was 1-0 with a 4.96 ERA in four games – three starts – before a move to Biloxi in the Double-A South in early June. He was 1-4 with a 4.66 ERA in ten games – six starts – for the Shuckers before coming back to Wisconsin.

LAST START: Bennett beat <u>Great Lakes at home on August 13</u>. He allowed four runs – three earned – on three hits and four walks with six strikeouts over five innings in the game.

VS. CEDAR RAPIDS: Bennett took the loss in a start against the Kernels at home on August 1. He allowed two runs on five hits with no walks and six strikeouts over four innings.

CEDAR RAPIDS SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP SAWYER GIPSON-LONG: The Twins selected Gipson-Long in the sixth round of the 2019 draft out of Mercer University.

SO CAL UNCENSORED: Gipson-Long was the Southern California Collegiate Baseball League's Pitcher of the Year in 2017. He was 7-0 with a 1.10 ERA and 52 strikeouts over 41 innings pitched for the Palm Springs Power. Perfect Game/Rawlings also placed Gipson-Long on their Summer Collegiate All-America Third Team that season.

BIG BEAR: Gipson-Long was 13-5 with 165 strikeouts over 140 innings pitched in three seasons at Mercer. In his final season of college baseball, Gipson-Long was 8-4 in 23 games – 14 starts – with 99 strikeouts, eighteen walks, and an ERA of 5.20 over 83 innings pitched.

E-TON: Gipson-Long was assigned to Elizabethton in the Appalachian League after signing with the Twins in 2019. He was 0-1 with four walks and 23 strikeouts over 18-1/3 innings in six starts.

MUSSEL BEACH: Gipson-Long was 5-5 with 95 strikeouts and eighteen walks over 72-13 innings for Fort Myers in the Low-A Southeast to start the 2021 season. He was named the Low-A Southeast Pitcher of the Week on August 1 and was promoted to Cedar Rapids on August 9.

LAST START: Gipson-Long lost his Kernels debut on August 14. In that game, he allowed four runs on eight hits with a walk and nine strikeouts over five innings at Peoria.

VS. WISCONSIN (2021): Gipson-Long has never faced the Timber Rattlers. This is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers
