**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers swept a doubleheader from the Beloit Sky Carp at Neuroscience Group Field. The Rattlers won [game one 1-0](#) behind a complete-game, two-hit shutout by Tyson Hardin and a two-out, RBI, infield single by Yhoswar Garcia. In game two, Anthony Flores and Bayden Root combined to shutout the Sky Carp on three hits and Eduardo Garcia hit a walkoff homer as the lead-off batter in the bottom of the seventh for [another 1-0 win](#).

**HARD DAY'S NIGHT:** Hardin retired the first seventeen batters he faced before Eric Rataczak singled with two outs in the bottom of the sixth inning. Hardin allowed two hits, walked none, and struck out six as he pitched the first complete-game shutout by a Wisconsin pitcher in the High-A Era, which started in 2021.

**THE LAST TIME IT HAPPENED\*:** Carlos Herrera pitched a seven-inning, two-hit, complete-game shutout at Burlington in the second game of a doubleheader on [July 27, 2017](#).

\*: The last complete-game shutout by a Timber Rattler was by Zach Davies on [August 27, 2018](#) against the Clinton LumberKings at NelsonCorp Field. Davies, who was on an MLB Rehab assignment from the Milwaukee Brewers went nine innings, scattered seven hits, walked none, and struck out six in the game.

**HISTORY REPEATS:** The last three walkoff homers by a Timber Rattler have all happened against Beloit. Joey Wiemer (September 5, 2021), Jesús Chirinos (May 18, 2024), and Garcia last night.

**ONE FOR TWO:** Blake Burke went 1-for-2 with a walk in game one and 0-for-2 with a walk in game two. His hitting streak ended at twelve games, the longest streak on the team this season. However, his on-base streak has reached twenty games (25-for-76, eleven walks, .414 OBP, .935 OPS). He is tied with Kyle DeBarge and Khadim Diaw of Cedar Rapids for the longest on-base streak in the league for 2025.

**ABOUT BELOIT:** The Beloit Sky Carp changed their name from Snappers after the 2021 season. This is Beloit's fourth season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3, 2021. Angel Espada is in his first season as the manager of the Sky Carp. Prince Fielder, Rickie Weeks, Chris Bosio, Greg Vaughn, Joey Meyer, BJ Surhoff, Tim Dillard, Mitch Stetter, and Matt Chapman played in Beloit.

**ABOUT THE MARLINS:** The Florida/Miami Marlins have lots of history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan. The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for 2021.

# PITCHING MATCHUP

## WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP RYAN BIRCHARD:** The Milwaukee Brewers selected Birchard in the 5<sup>th</sup> round of the 2023 draft out of the Niagara County Community College.

**PLAYER OF THE YEAR:** Birchard was named the Western New York Athletic Conference Player of the Year in 2023. He was 8-0 in ten games – nine starts – with a 1.08 ERA and 95 strikeouts over fifty innings pitched. Birchard was also named a First Team All-NJCAA Division III All-American in 2023.

**QUICK TRIP TO TRENTON:** Birchard made four appearances – two starts – for Trenton in the MLB Draft League after the end of his college season. He allowed one run, walked one, and struck out sixteen over nine innings before signing with Milwaukee.

**DELAYED START:** Birchard did not pitch professionally in 2023. He made a start for the Carolina Mudcats on April 6, 2024 (4.0IP, H, R, 0ER, 2BB, 6K) but was placed on the IL after that game. He next pitched with the ACL Brewers on July 16 and July 22. Birchard rejoined Carolina for appearances on July 28 and August 3 before being sent to Wisconsin on August 13.

**AS A RATTLER (2024):** Birchard made five regular season starts for Wisconsin last season. He was 0-3 with an 8.71 ERA. He walked fourteen and struck out thirteen in 10-1/3 innings with the Timber Rattlers

**LAST START:** Birchard had a no decision at Peoria on [May 11](#). He allowed one hit, walked three, and struck out three over 2-2/3 innings.

**VS. БЕЛОIT:** Birchard has never pitched against Beloit prior to this afternoon. Today is also his first appearance against an affiliate of the Miami Marlins.

## BELOIT STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP JAKE BROOKS:** Selected by the Miami Marlins in the 11<sup>th</sup> round of the 2023 draft out of UCLA.

**DAIRYLAND:** Brooks pitched for the Fond du Lac Dock Spiders of the Northwoods League in 2020. He was 1-2 with a 6.04 ERA in nine games – five starts – and struck out 24 in 22-1/3 innings.

**COAST-TO-COAST:** Brooks pitched at UCLA during the 2021 college season and with Cotuit in the Cape Cod League during the summer of 2021. He returned to UCLA for 2022 and 2023.

**SOMETHING'S BRUIN:** Brooks was 13-10 with a 4.92 ERA in 40 games – 27 starts – over his three seasons at UCLA. He walked 35 and struck out 152 in 159 innings pitched in his three collegiate seasons.

**AS A PRO:** Brooks made two brief relief appearances for the FCL Marlins in 2023. He spent most of 2024 in Jupiter, Miami's Florida State League affiliate, going 9-3 with a 2.28 ERA and a save in 23 games – 21 starts. Brooks made his debut with Beloit in a start at Quad Cities on September 6, 2024.

**LAST START:** Brooks beat Cedar Rapids at home on [May 10](#). He allowed three runs on four hits over six innings. Brooks walked one, hit two batters, and struck out three.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Brooks has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this afternoon. Today is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
