ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the South Bend Cubs 6-4 at Four Winds Field Manuel Rodriguez had eight strikeouts and allowed two runs over 6-1/3 innings for the win. Wisconsin rallied from a 2-1 deficit with five runs in the top of the sixth to take a 6-2 lead. The Cubs rallied with a run in the eighth and a run in the ninth to make it close. South Bend had the tying run at the plate in both innings, but Stiven Cruz got the final out each time to finish the

QUALITY IS JOB ONE: Rodriguez worked his second consecutive quality start last night for his fourth quality start of the season. He had six strikeouts in a row from the second out of the first inning through the first out of the third. In his final two starts of the season, Rodriguez allowed three runs on nine hits with one walk and fourteen strikeouts over 12-1/3 innings. He finished the year with 15 walks and 84 Ks in 83-2/3 innings.

WHAT COULD HAVE BEEN: The only two runs the Cubs scored against Rodriguez came in the third inning. South Bend had two on with two out when Edgar Alvarez hit a routine fly ball to center. However, the ball was lost in the twilight and dropped for a tworun double that gave the Cubs a 2-1 lead.

MARCO DINGERS: Marco Dinges tied the game 2-2 with a one-out, solo home run to right field in the top of the sixth for his tenth home run as a Rattler. Dinges had to leave the game with an injury. He homered twice in this series and has three homers in eleven games against the Cubs this season.

ANATOMY OF A RALLY: Luis Peña followed the Dinges home run with a single and Josh Adamczewski walked. They pulled a double steal, and both scored on an error later to make it 4-2. Luke Adams and Jesús Made capped the inning with consecutive two-out, RBI singles for the 6-2 lead.

MADE FOR THIS: Made went 2-for-5 last night for his twelfth multi-hit game in 27 games as a Rattler. He is hitting .343 with twelve RBI and an OPS of .915.

ABOUT SOUTH BEND: The South Bend Cubs started as the South Bend White Sox when the Midwest League added them as an expansion team in 1988. They changed their name to the Silver Hawks for the 1994 season and became an affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks in 1997. South Bend became an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs in 2015. South Bend has won Midwest League titles in 1989, 1993, 2005, 2019, and 2022. Notable alumni for the South Bend franchise include Mike Cameron, Jose Valverde, Chris Capuano, Mark Reynolds, Justin Upton, Wade Miley, Chase Anderson, Keon Broxton, Gleyber Torres, Ian Happ, Carlos Gonzalez, Pete Crow-Armstrong, and current Timber Rattlers manager Victor Estevez. Terry Francona was the manager of the South Bend White Sox in 1992. Nick Lovullo, the son of Arizona Diamondbacks manager Torey Lovullo, is in his second year as South Bend's

ABOUT THE CUBS: The Chicago Cubs had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in South Bend in 2015. They were affiliated with Quincy from 1965 through 1973 before leaving the Midwest League. The Cubs returned to the MWL for an affiliation with Quad Cities from 1979 through 1984, Peoria from 1985 through 1994 and again from 2005 through 2012, Rockford from 1995 through 1998, Lansing from 1999 through 2004, and Kane County in 2013 and 2014.

■ PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP TANNER GILLIS: The Milwaukee Brewers signed Gillis as a non-drafted free agent on September 3, 2024.

ON THE HORIZON: Gillis was a First Team All-Horizon League selection in his one season at Northern Kentucky in 2024. He was 8-3 with a 5.00 ERA in fourteen starts. Gillis had pitched four seasons for Cedarville University, an NCAA Division II school from 2019-2023.

HOW GREEN WAS THE VALLEY? Gillis made five appearances – four starts – for Mahoning Valley in the MLB Draft League in 2024. He was 2-1 with a 1.80 ERA, struck out 24, and walked seven over 25 innings.

CAROLINA ON MY MIND: Gillis started the 2025 season with the Carolina Mudcats. He was 1-1 with a save in seven relief appearances. Gillis had a 1.32 ERA and 28 strikeouts in 27-1/3 innings for the Mudcats before he was assigned to Wisconsin on May 15.

IT'S A MAJOR AWARD: Gillis was named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week on August 11. He set a new professional single-game high for strikeouts with seven over 6-1/3 scoreless innings at Peoria on August 7.

LAST START: Gillis had a no decision in game one of the series against the Cubs on <u>September 2</u>. He allowed a run on four hits with two walks and four strikeouts over five innings.

VS. SOUTH BEND: Gillis is 0-1 in three starts – $\underline{\text{May 24}}$, $\underline{\text{July 12}}$, and September 2 – against the Cubs. He has allowed four runs on thirteen hits with three walks and twelve strikeouts over fourteen innings in those starts.

SOUTH BEND STARTING PITCHER:

RHP KENTEN EGBERT: The Chicago Cubs signed Egbert as a non-drafted free agent out of the University of Miami (OH) on July 21, 2023.

THE OTHER MIAMI: Egbert pitched four seasons at the MAC school. He was 8-11 with a 4.66 ERA and two saves in 45 games – 21 starts in college. Egbert had 181 strikeouts and 63 walks in 162.1IP in his collegiate career.

GETTING STARTED: Egbert made his professional debut with the Myrtle Beach Pelicans of the Carolina League in 2024. He was 7-2 with a 3.04 ERA in 23 games – 16 starts. Egbert had 104 strikeouts over 97-2/3 innings with 32 walks.

LAST START: Egbert had a no decision at Peoria on August 30. He allowed four runs on six hits with a walk and a strikeout over five innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Egbert is 1-0 in two games – one start against the Timber Rattlers this season. He won a start at Four Winds Field on May 25 when he allowed a run on five hits with a walk and four strikeouts over five innings. Egbert had a no decision as a reliever on July 10 at Wisconsin with one run allowed on two hits with two walks and three strikeouts over three innings.
