### ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Beloit Sky Carp 14-5 at Neuroscience Group Field.](https://www.wisconsinradio.com/)

Alex Hall had two homers – including a grand slam, two doubles, and drove in nine runs to lead the Wisconsin offense. Hall set a Timber Rattlers record for RBI in a game last night. The switch hitter also homered and doubled from both sides of the plate. Last night was Hall's third two-homer game of the season.

**STEP-BY-STEP:** Hall started his onslaught with an RBI double in the bottom of the second inning. He hit his grand slam in the bottom of the third. Hall hit a two-run homer in the fifth and added a two-run double in the seventh. Only two other players in baseball have had nine RBI in a game this season. Ryan Mountcastle of the Baltimore Orioles and Jhon Imbert of the Yankees team in the Dominican Summer League.

**WELCOME TO SLAMTOWN:** Hall's grand slam was Wisconsin's first of the season. The last Rattler to hit a grand slam was Darien Miller on July 1, 2022 against Cedar Rapids at home. Hall's slam was the ninth by a Timber Rattlers since the High-A Era started in 2021.

**IT GOES TO ELEVEN:** Ernesto Martinez Jr went 3-for-4 last night to extend his hitting streak to eleven games. Martinez is 16-for-38 (.421) during the streak, which is tied for the longest on the team in 2023.

**THE NUMBER 23:** Robert Moore singled in the eighth inning to extend his current on-base streak to 23 games. Moore is 24-for-85 (.282) with an OPS of .843 with fifteen walks, fifteen RBI, and fourteen runs scored during the streak that started on June 8. Moore's streak is tied for the fourth-longest in the Midwest League this season. Dalton Rushing of Great Lakes has the longest on-base streak in the league this season at 29 games from April 7 through May 14.

**CRUZ CONTROL:** Stiven Cruz gave up three runs on a pair of homers in the first inning last night. He didn't allow another run and worked six innings to pick up his second straight win and earn his first quality start of the season. Cruz walked one and struck out three.

**ABOUT BELOIT:** The Beloit Sky Carp changed their name from Snappers after the 2021 season. This is Beloit's third season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3, 2021. Billy Gardner Jr is in his first season as the manager of the Sky Carp.

**ABOUT THE MARLINS:** The Florida/Miami Marlins have lots of history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan. The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for 2021.

Joseph Hernandez (#25) is currently on Wisconsin's IL. ## WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP TYLER WOESSNER:** Drafted by the Milwaukee Brewers in the sixth round of the 2022 draft out of Central Arizona College.

**WHAT A SEASON:** Woessner went 11-2 with a 3.55 ERA in nineteen games – eighteen starts – during his final season at CAC. He walked 34 and struck out 122 in 96-1/3 innings pitched for the Vaqueros.

**PITCHING INTO THE FINALS:** Central Arizona College advanced to the 2022 NJCAA College World Series in Grand Junction, Colorado. Woessner was the winning pitcher in the game that got CAC into the Championship game as he allowed three runs and struck out eight over seven innings in the Vaqueros' 7-4 win over Walters State Community College on [June 3, 2022](#). Central Arizona College won the National Title the next day with a 4-2 win over Cowley County Community College.

**NORTH TO ALASKA:** Woessner pitched in three games – one start – for the Mat-Su Miners of the Alaska Baseball League in 2021. He had no record, walked three, and struck out four over seven innings.

**FIRST YEAR AS A BREWER:** Woessner started his pro career with the Brewers Gold affiliate in the Arizona Complex League and made three appearances – two starts – with eleven strikeouts over six scoreless innings. Woessner also made one start for the Carolina Mudcats at the end of the 2022 Carolina League season.

**LAST START:** Woessner lost at Quad Cities on [June 30](#). He allowed ten runs on nine hits with a walk and three strikeouts over four innings. Woessner also gave up three homers in the game.

**VS. БЕЛОИТ:** Woessner lost to Beloit at home on [April 28](#). He allowed three runs on eight hits with two walks and a strikeout over six innings.

## БЕЛОИТ SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP JARED POLAND:** Selected by the Miami Marlins in the sixth round of the 2022 draft out of the University of Louisville.

**AS A CARDINAL:** Poland pitched four seasons at Louisville and was 7-8 with a 4.04 ERA and 73 strikeouts over 801/3 innings in 43 games – seventeen starts – from 2019 through 2022. In his final season with the Cardinals, Poland was 5-5 with a 3.46 ERA in seventeen games – fifteen starts.

**FAMILIAR FACE:** Poland was teammates with Wisconsin infielder Ben Metzinger at Louisville. Milwaukee selected Metzinger in the seventh round of the 2022 draft.

**GETTING STARTED:** Poland made five appearances – four starts – in the Marlins system after signing in 2022. He made two brief appearances in the Florida Complex League and three brief starts for Jupiter in the Florida State League for no record and a 1.42 ERA with eleven strikeouts over 12-2/3 innings before the season ended.

**FROM JUPITER TO WISCONSIN:** Poland started the 2023 season with Jupiter and was 1-0 in three starts before earning a promotion to join the Sky Carp on April 29.

**LAST START:** Poland beat South Bend on [June 30](#) at Beloit. He allowed one run on five hits with no walks and four strikeouts over seven innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Poland has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
