ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Dayton Dragons 6-4](#) in the first game of this six-game series at Neuroscience Group Field. Darrien Miller had a two-run single and Eduardo Garcia had a two-run double to help the Rattlers take a 6-0 lead. Tanner Shears entered the game with the lead run at the plate and two outs in the top of the eighth inning and got a strikeout to end the threat and pitched a scoreless ninth for the Rattlers.

SIX PACK TO START: Wisconsin grabbed the early lead with six runs in the first inning to knock Dayton starting pitcher Kevin Abel out of the game. Abel got the first out of the inning before the next seven Rattlers reached base. Hendry Mendez had a bases-loaded walk for the first run. Then, Alex Hall had an RBI single before Miller and Garcia followed with their two-run hits.

HOW ABOUT THAT 1-5? Four Wisconsin pitchers combined for fifteen strikeouts last night. Starting pitcher Nate Peterson had five strikeouts in four innings. Nick Merkel struck out four Dragons over two innings. Sam Gardner and Shears each had three strikeouts over the final three innings.

ALL GOOD THINGS: Dayton lead-off batter Tyler Callihan reached on an error with two outs in the top of the sixth inning. That Wisconsin error snapped a streak of seven consecutive errorless games by the Rattlers.

HOME DEBUT: Brock Wilken, Milwaukee's #1 pick in the 2023 draft, went 2-for-3 with a walk in his home debut for the Rattlers last night. Wilken has walked eight times in five games with Wisconsin.

ABOUT DAYTON: The Dayton Dragons entered the Midwest League when the Rockford Reds moved to Ohio for the 2000 season. Dayton has been an affiliate of the Cincinnati Reds since 2000. Joey Votto, Johnny Cueto, Adam Dunn, Homer Bailey, Didi Gregorius, Nick Senzel, and Ely De La Cruz are just a few MLB players to play for the Dragons. The Dragons finished the first half 33-33 and missed the playoffs. Bryan LaHair is in his second season as the manager of the Dragons. LaHair appeared in 67 games with the Timber Rattlers during the 2004 season. He hit .279 with 24 doubles, five homers, and 28 RBI.

ABOUT THE REDS: The Cincinnati Reds have been the Major League parent club for the Dragons since 2000. The Reds had two MWL affiliates in 1999 (Rockford and Clinton) and 2000 (Dayton and Clinton). Cincinnati's first Midwest League affiliate was the Cedar Rapids Red Raiders in 1963 and 1964. The Reds left the Midwest League in 1964 before returning to Cedar Rapids in 1980 where they stayed until the end of the 1992 season. The Reds left the MWL for four seasons before returning to partner with the Burlington Bees in 1997 for two seasons before the partnership with Clinton and Rockford started.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: [MLB Pipeline](#) places five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Robert Moore (#8), Hendry Mendez (#13), Bradley Blalock (#15), Eduardo Garcia (#20), and Matthew Wood (#25). Eric Brown Jr (#6) is currently on Wisconsin's IL. [MLB Pipeline](#) has five Dayton players on their list of Top 30 Reds prospects: Edwin Arroyo (#2), Chase Petty (#6), Sal Stewart (#7), Austin Hendrick (#17), and Tyler Callihan (#26). Jay Allen II (#8) is on the Dayton IL.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER GAME TWO:

RHP STIVEN CRUZ: Signed by Milwaukee as an International Free Agent out of Nicaragua on July 2, 2019.

DELAYED START: Cruz began his pro career with the Brewers-1 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League in 2021. He was 3-3 with a 1.37 ERA and 73 strikeouts over 52-2/3 innings pitched in twelve games – eleven starts.

MUDDY WATERS: Cruz started the 2022 season with the Carolina Mudcats in the Carolina League. He went 3-5 with a 4.60 ERA in fifteen starts for Carolina. Cruz walked 18 and struck out 89 over 72-1/3 innings pitched.

ON TO WISCONSIN: Cruz joined the Timber Rattlers on August 16, 2022. He made four starts with the Rattlers and allowed one run on six hits with six walks and twenty strikeouts over nineteen innings pitched for a 1-1 record with a 0.47ERA.

IT'S A MAJOR AWARD: Cruz beat Lansing at home on August 24, 2022. He allowed a hit with a walk and seven strikeouts over six scoreless innings in the game. Cruz was named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week on August 29 for this game.

LAST START: Cruz lost to Cedar Rapids at home on [July 29](#). He allowed six runs on six hits with four walks and a strikeout over 1-1/3 innings.

LAST APPEARANCE: Cruz made a relief outing at South Bend on [August 4](#). He allowed two runs on three hits with a walk and two strikeouts.

VS. DAYTON: Cruz made two starts at Dayton – [July 18](#) and [July 23](#) – during Wisconsin's trip to Ohio in July. Cruz allowed eight runs on ten hits with two walks, three hit batsmen, and four strikeouts over seven innings in those two starts. He was not involved in the decision in either game.

DAYTON SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP CHRIS MCELVAIN: The Cincinnati Reds selected McElvain in the eighth round of the 2022 draft out of Vanderbilt.

VANDY: McElvain pitched three seasons at Vanderbilt, including the shortened 2020 season. He was 11-6 with two saves and a 4.33ERA in 44 games – seventeen starts – and recorded 165 strikeouts over 141-1/3 innings pitched during his college career. In his final season at Vanderbilt, McElvain was 6-5 in sixteen starts with 100 strikeouts and 44 walks in 86-1/3 innings and an ERA of 4.27.

TAKE SOME TIME: McElvain did not pitch professionally in 2022 after signing with the Reds.

FLORIDA MAN: McElvain started the 2023 season with the Daytona Tortugas in the Florida State League. He was 3-3 with a 3.04ERA in twelve games – eight starts. McElvain had 53 strikeouts and nineteen walks over 50-1/3 innings before his promotion to Dayton on June 20.

STRONG DEBUT: McElvain made his Dayton debut on [June 23](#) and allowed a run over four innings against Lake County. He followed that up with a game at West Michigan on [June 30](#) where he allowed one hit over five scoreless innings.

LAST START: McElvain beat Beloit at home on [August 2](#). He allowed a run on three hits with a walk and four strikeouts over five innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: McElvain lost to the Timber Rattlers at home on [July 19](#). He allowed four runs on nine hits with a hit batsman, three walks, and four strikeouts over four innings. Hendry Mendez homered off McElvain in the third inning of the game.
