ABOUT LAST NIGHT: A pair of solo shots from Jase Bowen and Alika Williams provided the offense for the Indianapolis Indians as they took down he Omaha Storm Chasers, 4-2, on Thursday night at Victory Field. Bowen homered in his first career at-bat to open the scoring after being promoted from Double-A Altoona prior to Wednesday's contest. He sparked Indy's offense again in the fifth, doubling with one out. He came in to score one batter later via a Brett Sullivan single to extend the Indians' lead. They tacked on another run in the sixth, courtesy of a Cam Devanney double to drive in Ronny Simon, who reached on a lead-off walk and stole second to set up the opportunity. The Storm Chasers strung together three singles to scratch across their first run in the seventh. Williams responded in the bottom half, pushing the Indians' advantage back to three with his fourth home run of the season. Isan Díaz drove in Drew Waters from second base to score Omaha's final run in the ninth before Colin Holderman shut the door for his first save of the campaign.

BARCO ZEROES: LHP Hunter Barco, MLB Pipeline's No. 71 overall prospect, tossed 4.0 scoreless frames last night with one hit, one walk and four strikeouts. It was his fourth scoreless appearance with Indy this season, and first since July 5 vs. Lousiville (6.0ip). The Indians improved to 8-2 in home games started by Barco on the campaign. He ranks among Triple-A pitchers at home this season (min 35.0ip) in opponent average (4th, .147, 21-for-143), ERA (6th, 1.93, 9er/42.0ip) and opponent OPS (6th, .539). His home ERA is the lowest by an Indians pitcher with at least nine starts at Victory Field in a season since Clay Holmes' 2.10 ERA (12er/51.1ip) in 11 appearances (nine starts) in 2018. Additionally, the southpaw has held right-handed hitters to a .154 batting average (20-for-130) on the campaign, which is the third lowest by a Triple-A left hander (min 100 ABs against righties) hander (min. 100 ABs against righties).

JASE JACKS: Jase Bowen made a splash in his Triple-A debut last night, going 2-for-3 with two runs and a home run. In his first Triple-A at-bat, he launched the third pitch from Chandler Champlain 394 feet to opposite field for a solo homer. In the fifth inning, he smacked another extrabase hit to opposite field, this time a double, off Champlain. He later scored on Brett Sullivan's RBI single to give Indy a 2-0 advantage.

SOLAK'S HISTORIC STREAK: Nick Solak's 39-game on-base streak ended last night as he went 0-for-4 with three strikeouts. It marked just the second time in 75 games Solak struck out three times. His 39-game run was the longest by a Triple-A player since Buddy Kennedy's 45-game run from May 28-Aug. 1, 2024, between Lehigh Valley and Toledo. Solak's streak was also the longest by an Indians player since Chris Richard's 46-game streak from May 13-July 6, 2006. It was the fourth Indianapolis on-base streak of 39-plus games since at least 2005, joining Ty Wigginton (41G, 6/24-8/8, 2005), Ronny Paulino (42G, 6/6-7/27, 2005) and Richard. During his streak, Solak ranked among qualified International League hitters in on-base percentage (2nd, .444), batting average (3rd, .351, 53-for-151) and hits (T-4th, 53), while racking up nine doubles, four homers, 25 RBI, 21 walks to 16 strikeouts and a .934 OPS. On the season, he has reached safely in 70 of his 75 games and has hit safely in 64 of those

SUPER SIMON: Ronny Simon (0-for-3, R, BB, SB) extended his on-base streak to 11 games with a walk last night. His 10-game hitting streak ended which was his longest since an 11-game run from July 17-30, 2021, with Low-A Visalia. In these 11 games, he is hitting .375 (18-for-48) with a .913 OPS. Across the hitting streak, he was tied for the most hits in Triple-A (18) and ranked 10th in batting average (18-for-45) while recording five runs, two doubles, a homer, nine RBI, four stolen bases and a .960 OPS. Since joining the club on June 6, he has reached safely in 44 of 48 games and hit safely in 37 of those. His 24 stolen bases in this span are the most in Triple-A. Additionally, Simon has the most stolen bases by an Indian in a season since Ji Hwan Bae swiped 30 bags in 2022.

BAM BAM CAM: Cam Devanney has reached base safely in all 16 games with the Indians since joining the team on July 18 and has reached safely in 21 straight overall between Omaha and Indy. In these 16 games with Indianapolis, he is hitting .273 (15-for-55) with seven runs, four doubles, one home run, five RBI, nine walks, three HBP and an .803 OPS.

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP: The Indianapolis Indians continue this week's six-game series against the Omaha Storm Chasers tonight at 7:05 PM. The Indians can even the series at two games apiece with a win, and pull within one game of the head-to-head record since 1988. RHP Thomas Harrington takes the mound for Indy, set to make his 20th appearance and 19th start of the season. He will face off with Omaha for the fourth time on the campaign. In his most recent start against the club on June 26 at Victory Field, Harrington allowed seven earned runs on a career-high tying 10 hits. In these three starts, he is 1-2 with an 8.40 ERA (14er/15.0ip). Opposite Harrington is RHP Luinder Avila. He faces the Indians for the third time this season, last tossing 6.0 innings of one-run ball at Omaha on May 4. In these two starts, he is 1-1 with a 5.40 ERA (6er/10.0ip).

HARRINGTON HEATING UP: Thomas Harrington posted his best single-month performance of the season in July, going 3-0 in five starts with a 3.75 ERA (10er/24.0ip) with 20 strikeouts. He had a 1.17 WHIP and held opponents to a .231 average (21-for-91).

ON THIS DATE IN 1997: In front of a then-record 15,674 fans at Victory Field, the Indians swept Nashville in a doubleheader to pull within two games of Buffalo in the American Association East with a 70-49 record on the season. Indianapolis won Game 1, 7-2, behind a complete-game effort by Scott Klingenbeck (7.0ip, 4h, 2r, 2er, 0bb, 4k) in the first of five complete games for Indy that August. With two outs in the bottom of the eighth inning in Game 2, Tim Belk clubbed a three-run home run to give the Indians a 6-3 walk-off win and twin bill sweep.

TONIGHT'S PITCHER

Thomas Harrington: The Campbell University alum is currently the Pirates No. 5 prospect according to MLB Pipeline.

Major League Debut: Harrington had his contract first selected by Pittsburgh on April 1, 2025 and debuted with a 4.0 inning start the same night at Tampa Bay. Picked up his first career save in his next appearance on April 7 vs. St. Louis.

Last Outing: Harrington tossed 4.1 innings on July 27 vs. Toledo, allowing five runs (4er) with three hits, two walks and four strikeouts. Two of the three hits were home runs.

Quality in Quantity: Harrington strung together three straight quality starts from June 3-14, and pitched to a 2-1 record with a 2.50 ERA (5er/18.0ip), 18 strikeouts and a 1.00 WHIP in that stretch. He is the first Indians pitcher to record three straight quality starts since Cam Alldred did so from June 16-29, 2023.

Against the Storm Chasers: Harrington will face off with Omaha for the fourth time on the campaign. In his most recent start against the club on June 26 at Victory Field, Harrington allowed seven earned runs on a career-high tying 10 hits. In these three starts, he is 1-2 with an 8.40 ERA (14er/15.0ip).

Miscellaneous: Harrington was selected by Pittsburgh in the first round (36th overall) of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft.
