TODAY'S GAME: The Fayetteville Woodpeckers (Low-A Astros) continue a six-game road trip today against the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers (Low-A, White Sox). This is the second time Fayetteville has played a series at Atrium Health Ballpark in 2022, along with being the 13th of the 24-game season series.. The Woodpeckers lead this series 3-0 after a 5-4 win on Wednesday afternoon. Today, RHP Shea Barry will get the start for Fayetteville while Kannapolis will start LHP Brooks Gosswein.

THE OPPONENTS: The Kannapolis Cannon Ballers are in their second season in the Carolina League. Prior to the 2021 season, the Cannon Ballers were known as the Kannapolis Intimidators and played their games at Intimidators Stadium. They have been affiliated with the Chicago White Sox since the 2001 season. The season series with Kannapolis is currently tied at 6-6, with the Woodpeckers having won six of the last nine games. Over the season series, Kannapolis is outscoring Fayetteville 60-50, yet 40 of the Kannapolis runs were scored over the first three games on Opening Weekend. The Kannapolis offense has scored just 20 runs against Fayetteville over the last nine games between the two sides.

PACKING COATS: On Tuesday, RHP Jacob Coats earned promoted from the Woodpeckers and is one the move to the High-A Asheville Tourists. He is the fifth pither promoted to High-A this season along with Ernesto Jaquez, Jose Betances, Franny Cobos and Ryan Gusto. Prior to his promotions, Coats put together a career-best seven strikeout performance vs. CAR on 5/14. He carried a 2-1 record with a 1.84 ERA, struck out 21 hitters over 14.2 IP and allowed just one earned run in May.

**Q THE OFFENSE:** Woodpeckers outfielder Quincy Hamilton continues to be the team leader in a number of categories, including hits (37), batting average (.298), doubles (8), home runs, (6), RBI (19), slugging percentage (.508), and OPS (.901). Hamilton is 2nd in the entire Carolina League in batting average (.375), OPS (1.087) and 1st in OBP (.462) in May and is tied for 3rd in hits (21). Hamilton's on-base success has been amplified on the road this season where he is slashing .328/.434/.500 compared to .267/.348/.517 at home. However on the power front, Hamilton has hit four of his six HR's at Segra Stadium this season.

THE PROSPECTS: The Woodpeckers are currently carrying three of the Astros Top-30 Prospects on their active roster. RHP Alex Santos is the highest rated of the bunch, starting the year at #10. 2021 third-round draft pick outfielder Tyler Whitaker sits right behind Santos at #11. Logan Cerny, who was acquired by the Astros in a trade in November with the Phillies, rounds out the trio at #26 in the system.

**RUNNING WILD:** All season long, the Woodpeckers have been aggressive on the bases. Fayetteville has stolen 66 bags in 2022, the second most in the Carolina League behind only the Charleston RiverDogs (79). It continues a trend from 2021, a season where Fayetteville stole 205 bases (2nd in Carolina League) over 120 games.

FREYLIN'S ON FIRE: Freylin Garcia allowed his first run in May on 5/19 vs KAN, ending a shutout stretch of 10.2 innings. It was the longest shutout streak by a Woodpeckers reliever this year and the third longest shutout stretch by any Fayetteville arm.

**GOOD WITH THE BAD:** The Woodpeckers pitching staff has had issues with control early in the year, issuing a Carolina League-high 217 walks so far in 2022. However, they have made up for it by missing bats as Fayetteville has struck out the most batters in the league with 406. Additionally, in the month of May, the Woodpeckers have allowed the fewest hits (102) in the league and own the fifth-lowest earned run average of the month at 3.92, compared to a 4.99 ERA in April.

CERNY IN KANNAPOLIS: Logan Cerny has enjoyed plenty of his offensive success this season while playing at Atrium Health Ballpark in Kannapolis. The Woodpeckers outfielder has hit three of his five HR's in Kannapolis and is 7-for-22 with 3 HR, 9 R, 6 RBI, 5 BB over four road games with the Cannon Ballers.

THE STREAK: The Woodpeckers enter tonight on a season-long three-game winning streak. They need just one more victory over the Cannon Ballers to secure their first series win of the 2022 season

15 Joe Thon Manager Vincent Blue

Thon makes his return to Fayetteville and begins his first season as Woodpeckers manager after serving as a development coach in 2021.

As the development coach, Thon helped coach Woodpeckers hitters and fielders, as well as assist with lineup planning and creating reports on individual athletes on the team.

Prior to joining the Astros as a full-time coach, Thon served as a summer intern with the organization during the 2019 summer. He helped analyze and balance revenue summaries, verified accounts for reconciling payments and processed and organized invoices for the Astros and Astros Foundation.

Following his intership, Thon broke into the coaching ranks by joining the University of Houston Baseball program in August 2019 as a student assistant coach before becoming the volunteer assistant prior to the 2020 season. After one season with UofH, Thon returned to the Astros in a full-time coaching role.

The former Minor League infielder enjoyed a seven-year minor league playing career. Thon was drafted in the 5th round (pick 156) by the Toronto Blue Jays in 2010 out of Academia Perpetuo Socorro in San Juan, Puerto Rico. He played in the Blue Jays organizationuntil 2016 when he signed to join the St. Louis Cardinals. Thon played in the Cardinals farm system through 2017, reaching as Double-A with the Springfield Cardinals. His playing career concluded in 2017 in the Independent Atlanta League with the Sugar Land Skeeters, now the Triple-A Affiliate of the Astros. In total, Thon appeared in over 500 games across his MiLB career, posting a .243/.356/.318 slash line with 79 doubles, 17 triples, 27 home-runs and 178 RBI. Thon also played for Liga de Beisbol Professional Roberto Clemente in Puerto Rico from 2010 through December 2016.

Thon comes from a deep baseball background. He is the son of former Astros shortstop Dickie Thon, a 1983 All-Star with Houston who enjoyed a 15-year MLB career with the California Angels, Astros, Padres, Phillies, Rangers and Brewers.

Joe and his fiance Erika spend their offseason living in Houston with their dogs.

## 23 Jose Puentes Hitting Coach

Joining the Woodpeckers for his first season with the franchise and third season in the Astros organization is hitting coach Jose Puentes.

Puentes started his career with the Astros as a hitting coach in the Dominican Summer League and most recently served as hitting coach with the Florida Complex League Astros in 2021.

He has coached at the high school level at MacArthur High School, Johnson High School, Steele High School and Wagner High School. From 2006-2007, he was the head baseball coach at St. Anthony Catholic High School. Puentes has owned and operated two hitting academies, Gap to Gap Academy and Cardinals Select Baseball Academy.

He earned his bachelor's degree in Spanish and Master's degree in teaching from University of Incarnate Word along with a Master's degree in education from the University of Texas at San Antonio.

### 16 John Kovalik Pitching Coach

John Kovalik takes over as the third pitching coach in Woodpeckers history, bringing three years of coaching experience to the Woodpeckers staff. The 30-year-old enters his fourth season in the Astros organization after serving as the pitching coach for the Tri-City Valley Cats in 2019, along with the pitching coach for the Florida Complex League Astros in 2021. While with the Valley Cats, Kovalik coached Astros farmhands and future big leaguers Luis Garcia, Jose Urquidy and Shawn Dubin along with other high-level pitching prospects.

Prior to his time with the Astros, Kovalik spent three seasons as pitching coach (2016-2018) at Slippery Rock University, where he oversaw all aspects of the team's pitching program.

Kovalik earned his bachelor's degree from Slippery Rock, where he also pitched for the baseball team. Following his college career he played four seasons in the Independent leagues for the Frontier Greys and the Gary-Southshore Railcats. Kovalik trained at Driveline Baseball during the 2016 and 2017 offseasons.

New to the Woodpeckers and the Astros organization is development coach Vincent Blue. Blue begins his first season as a coach in the Astros organization and first with the Woodpeckers.
