THE SURGE — The Wind Surge wrap-up a nine game road trip today, the Wind Surge dropped the first three games of the trip in Tulsa and dropped four of the five in Springfield, Surge are 1-7 on the trip. Wichita is 1-10 this season at Springfield and snapped a eight game losing streak Wednesday night. They have lost 14 of their last 16 at Hammons. The Surge have been swept three times in their history, the six game trip in Springfield in Missouri in April and the recent three-game series in Tulsa. The other was opening weekend 2022 at home vs Tulsa, a three game set. Wichita is in fifth place, six games back of first place.

ON THE ROAD- The Wind Surge are playing their final divisional road games of the season this week. Wichita will play its final 24 road games in Texas vs South opponents. Wichita is 17-27 on the road and have a 5.05 ERA on the road and a 3.50 ERA at home. The Surge are 1-7 on this roadtrip, outscored 54-34, batting .250 with 13 HR and an ERA of 6.55

THE SERIES — The Cardinals have won 15 of the 17 meetings against Wichita this season and 10-1 at Hammons Field. The Wind Surge have won the season series against Springfield in two of the first three seasons and split the series in 2023. The all-time series has Cards leading 43-40. The Surge have been outscored 102-62 in head to head match-ups but the Wind Surge have hit 20 home runs to 14 for Springfield.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT- Springfield led off the game with a solo home run and then added two more long balls scoring three third inning runs, and four fourth inning runs to defeat the Wind Surge 10-2. Three Cardinal hitters had three hit games and a pair had three RBI contests. The Wind Surge were blanked for eight innings and Carson McCusker smashed a two run home run in the ninth in the loss.

ON THE BUMP- Andrew Morris will make his second start against the Cardinals this afternoon and his eighth appearance in a Wichita uniform. Andrew Morris has not allowed a run in his last two starts spanning 12 innings. He has 18 punchouts in that span and allowed seven hits and three walks. Morris has won both games and is second on the team lead with four wins. Morris is 3rd in all of MiLB with a 1.66 ERA and is 7-2 in 14 games, 13 starts. Andrew Morris was named Minnesota Twins Minor League Pitcher of the Month for June. In his one start against the Redbirds he pitched six innings, allowed one run on three hits in a no-decision.

DAY GAMES – Wichita will wrap up the series today in Springfield, The Surge are 6-9 in series finales and 9-9 in day games this season. Even with a .500 day game record the team has been outscored 92-58 in matinee's.

THE TIGHTROPE- Wichita is 7-19 in one run games. The 19 losses leads the league and all of Minor League Baseball. The Surge 5-12 in two run games and the 12 defeats are the most in Class AA. The Surge have lost ten games this season when leading after six innings.

FLUSH THE MOUSE- Wichita has held the lead in nine of the 12 losses in the second half.

HIGH FIVE – The Wind Surge have scored five or more runs in 29 of the 36 wins this season. The Wind Surge are 0-25 when scoring two runs or less and 6-36 when scoring runs or less.

HR DERBY – The Surge are 8-9 in games with two homers or more this season. Wichita has 74 home runs this season, fourth most in the league. The Wind Surge have hit 13 home runs in July in just ten games, second highest in the league.

CARD SHARKS - Noah Cardenas hit two home runs in the first week of the season, he hit his first home run in 42 games Friday night. Cardenas had two multi-hit games in April and May, zero in June and has three multi-hit games in July.

ZEBBY – Zebby Matthews is 7th in all of Minor League Baseball with a 1.85 ERA combined numbers between Wichita and Class A Cedar Rapids. He also leads all of MiLB with WHIP 0.76. Matthews is 5-1 with a 1.85 ERA in 14 games/ 13 games. Matthews is 2-1 with a 1.95 ERA with Wichita in ten games.

THE LEADERBOARD - Jake Rucker is tied for second in the league with 84 hits and fourth with 46 RBI and tied for tenth with a .284 batting average. He is the team leader in hits and RBI. Jefferson Morales is fifth with a .293 batting average and ranks in top ten in OPS and OBP. Carson McCusker leads the Texas League in July with hits (16) and tied with 3 home runs.

SURGE NOTES- The Wind Surge have 157 doubles, second most in the Texas League and fourth in all of Class AA. The Surge pitchers are ninth in the league with 718 strikeouts for the season. Wichita has made 73 errors, ninth most in the league (Tulsa, 76). The team has stranded 631 men this season, second most in the Texas League. The Wind Surge have drawn the second most walks in the Texas League this season, 381 free passes this season and second in all of Class AA.

WHATS NEXT – The Wind Surge wrap-up a series against the first-half North Division Champions and will open a three-game set against the South Division champions on Friday. The team will have a four day All-Star Break beginning on Monday.

SPRINGFIELD SALAMI's – The Wind Surge crushed their third grand slam of the season Friday night, all three have been against Springfield.
