ABOUT THE LANSING LUGNUTS: The Lugnuts began their existence as the Lafayette (IN) Chiefs of the Mississippi-Ohio Valley League in 1955. Lafayette became the Red Sox in 1956 and as the Mississippi-Ohio Valley League became the Midwest League. The franchise moved Waterloo, Iowa in 1958 and remained there as the Hawks, Royals, Indians, and Diamonds until the end of the 1993 season. New ownership bought the team and moved them to Springfield, Illinois for two seasons before finally locating the team in Lansing, Michigan in 1996. Since they started in Lansing, the Lugnuts were affiliated with the Kansas City Royals (1996-1998), the Chicago Cubs (1999-2004), the Toronto Blue Jays (2005-2019), and the Oakland Athletics. The Lugnuts won Midwest League titles in 1997 and 2003. Notable Lansing alumni include Kevin Appier, Carlos Beltrán, Rich Hill, Mark Prior, Carlos Zambrano, Bo Bichette, Vladimir Guerrero Jr, Danny Janssen, Noah Syndergaard, and Rowdy Tellez.

ABOUT THE ATHLETICS: The Athletics have been on and off in the Midwest League since moving from Kansas City to Oakland for the 1968 season. They were in Burlington from 1968 through 1974. Oakland returned to the Midwest League in 1982 to be the parent club of the Madison Muskies and stayed in Madison through 1993. Oakland's affiliation stayed with the franchise after its move to West Michigan in 1994. Oakland left the league after the 1997 season only to return with Kane County as their affiliate from 2003 through 2010. From there, Oakland went to Burlington (2011-2012), Beloit (2013-2019), and now Lansing since 2021.

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP STIVEN CRUZ: Signed by Milwaukee as an International Free Agent out of Nicaragua on July 2, 2019.

DELAYED START: Cruz began his pro career with the Brewers-1 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League in 2021. He was 3-3 with a 1.37 ERA and 73 strikeouts over 52-2/3 innings pitched in twelve games – eleven starts.

MUDDY WATERS: Cruz started the 2022 season with the Carolina Mudcats in the Carolina League. He went 3-5 with a 4.60 ERA in fifteen starts for Carolina. Cruz walked 18 and struck out 89 over 72-1/3 innings pitched.

ON TO WISCONSIN: Cruz joined the Timber Rattlers on August 16, 2022.

LAST START: Cruz <u>lost at Cedar Rapids on August 18</u>. He allowed one run on one hit, a solo home run, with two walks and five strikeouts over six innings. The Timber Rattlers lost 1-0.

VS. LANSING: Cruz has never faced the Lugnuts prior to this afternoon. Tonight is also the first time he will face an affiliate of the Oakland Athletics.

LANSING SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP CHRISTIAN FERNANDEZ: Oakland acquired Fernandez from the Tampa Bay Rays in a trade on July 9, 2022. The Athletics sent Christian Bethancourt to Tampa in exchange for Holman and Cal Stevenson

ORIGIN STORY: Fernandez was signed as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela. He debuted with the Rays #2 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League during the 2016 season and was 1-3 with a save in sixteen relief appearances.

ROTATION: Fernandez made fourteen starts for the Rays #1 affiliate in the DSL in 2017 and was 0-5 with a 3.41 ERA. In 2018, Fernandez made four starts with the Rays #2 affiliate in the DSL and moved up to the GCL for ten games – six starts – with a 3-1 record and a 2.61 ERA. Fernandez pitched for Princeton in the Appalachian League in 2019 and was 2-2 with a 6.00 ERA in twelve games – eleven starts. He did not pitch in 2021.

HOW ABOUT THIS YEAR: Fernandez started this season with Charleston in the Carolina League. He was 5-2 with a 2.79 ERA in sixteen games – eight starts. Fernandez walked 25 and struck out 87 over 58 innings pitched prior to the trade.

LAST START: Fernandez had a <u>no decision against Great Lakes at home on August 17</u>. He allowed two runs on three hits with a walk and two strikeouts over 3-1/3 innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Fernandez has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this afternoon. He has never faced a full-season affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers either.
