

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Beloit Sky Carp beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 5-1 at Neuroscience Group The Rattlers took a 1-0 lead in the first inning on an RBI single by Eduardo Garcia. Beloit went up 3-1 on a two-out, three-run home run by Johnny Olmstead in the top of the third. Wisconsin loaded the bases in the bottom of the third but did not score. Beloit added two runs on a two-run single by Cameron Barstad in the seventh inning.

AND ONE MAKES EIGHTEEN: Jadher Areinamo doubled with one out in the bottom of the third last night to move his hitting streak to eighteen games. This is the longest streak in the Midwest League this season.

BY THE NUMBERS: The streak started on June 13. Areinamo is 29-for-69 (.420) with six doubles, four homers, ten RBI, and thirteen runs scored with an OPS of 1.168 during the streak.

A PLACE IN HISTORY: Areinamo now holds the longest hitting streak by a Timber Rattler in the High-A Era of the team (starting in 2021). Here are the longest hitting streaks in team history dating back to 1995:

A NOTE ABOUT TINOCO: Tinoco had a hit in the final 22 games of the 1996 regular season. He then had at least one hit in each of the first five Wisconsin playoff games in 1996 for an unofficial 27-game hitting streak. FIRST! Wisconsin has scored 66 runs in the first inning

this season. They have outscored opponents 66-24 in the first inning in 2024. Wisconsin has scored first in 52 games this season. Even with last night's loss after scoring first, The Rattlers are 36-16 when scoring first.

ABOUT BELOIT: The Beloit Sky Carp changed their name from Snappers after the 2021 season. This is Beloit's fourth season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3, 2021. Billy Gardner Jr is in his second season as the manager of the Sky Carp. Prince Fielder, Rickie Weeks, Chris Bosio, Greg Vaughn, Joey Meyer, BJ Surhoff, Tim Dillard, and Mitch Stetter played in Beloit.

ABOUT THE MARLINS: The Florida/Miami Marlins have lots of history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for

## PITCHING MATCHUP

#### WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP JOE ROSS: The Milwaukee Brewers signed Ross as Free Agent on December 12, 2023.

**THE JOURNEY:** Ross was originally selected by the San Diego Padres in the first round with the 25<sup>th</sup> overall pick of the 2011 Draft out of Bishop O'Dowd High School in Oakland, California. The Padres sent Ross and Trea Turner (who was a player to be named later) to the Washington Nationals as part of the three-team trade that also involved the Tampa Bay Rays on December 19, 2014. Ross made his MLB debut on June 6, 2015 in a start against the Chicago Cubs.

**TAKING IT NATIONAL:** Ross pitched with the Nationals from 2015 through 2019 and again in 2021. He was 26-28 with a 4.26 ERA in 98 games – 76 starts for Washington. He also made three appearances – two starts – for the Nationals in the postseason. Ross had a no decision in a start in the 2016 Division Series against the Los Angeles Dodgers and was 0-1 in two games – one start against the Houston Astros in the 2019 World Series.

**THE COMEBACK:** Ross had surgery to remove a bone spur in March of 2022 and made one rehab appearance for Harrisburg before needing Tommy John Surgery in June of that year. Signed with the San Francisco Giants as a free agent on January 20, 2023 and appeared in eight games – seven starts – between the ACL Giants Orange, San Jose, and Sacramento starting in August, 2023.

**SOMETHING'S BREWING:** Ross was 2-4 with a 4.50 ERA in nine starts for the Brewers this season. He had 35 strikeouts in 42 innings pitched.

**NOT A STRANGER:** Ross started Game One of the 2012 Midwest League Championship Game against Wisconsin at Neuroscience Group Field for the Fort Wayne TinCaps on <u>September 12, 2012</u>. Ross allowed two runs over five innings for a no decision.

**LAST START:** Ross worked a scoreless inning at Miami on May 20 before leaving the game with a lower back strain. He was placed on Milwaukee's IL the next day.

#### **BELOIT STARTING PITCHER:**

RHP IKE BUXTON: The Miami Marlins selected Buxton in the fifteenth round of the 2022 draft out of the Lipscomb University. He is rated as the #27 prospect in the Marlins system by MLB Pipeline.

**STARTING OUT IN IDAHO:** Buxton began his collegiate career at Boise State University. He was a redshirt in 2019 and made four relief appearances during the shortened 2020 season before transferring to Lipscomb for 2021.

**NASHVILLE:** Buxton pitched two seasons at Lipscomb. He was 11-8 with a save and a 4.45 ERA in 33 games – 24 starts – in his two seasons for the Bison. In his final season at Lipscomb, Buxton was 7-3 with 66 strikeouts over 74-2/3 innings in fifteen games – fourteen starts.

IT'S COMPLEX: Buxton made three relief appearances with the Marlins affiliate in the FCL after signing with Miami. He walked eight, struck out five, and allowed five runs over 4-2/3 innings as a pro in 2022.

**UNDEFEATED IN FLORIDA:** Buxton was 4-0 with a 1.62 ERA in twelve games – five starts – with the Jupiter Hammerheads to start the 2023 season. He had walked 25 and struck out 46 in 39 innings before his promotion to Beloit on July 25. Buxton was 2-2 with a 3.71 ERA in seven starts for the Sky Carp after the promotion last season. He also pitched four scoreless innings as a starter for Pensacola in one game for the Marlins Southern League affiliate in 2023.

**LAST START:** Buxton lost at Cedar Rapids on <u>June 30</u>. He allowed four runs on five hits with three walks and three strikeouts in four innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN (2024):** Buxton had a no decision at Neuroscience Group Field on May 18. Wisconsin scored five runs – three earned – on four hits in six innings against Buxton. He walked two and struck out two in that game.
