ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the South Bend Cubs 11-3. Russell Smith allowed two runs - one earned - and struck out nine over five innings for the win. Tristan Peters had three hits, drove in three runs, scored a run, and stole a base for the Timber Rattlers. Wisconsin was charged with two errors last night and their errorless streak ended at 39-

NUMBER NINE: Smith set a new single-game high as a pro for strikeouts last night. In his last two starts, Smith has 15 Ks and zero walks in eleven innings.

POWER WALKING: Wisconsin hitters drew eight walks last night. There were two walks in the fifth, three walks in the seventh, and three walks in the ninth. The Timber Rattlers scored three times in the fifth, five times in the seventh, and twice in the ninth. Tyler Black walked three times in the game.

PETERS PRINCIPLE: Peters collected his fourth threehit game of the season last night. He has sixteen multihit games this season.

DOUBLE STEAL: Peters and Joe Gray Jr pulled a double steal to score Wisconsin's third run of the fifth inning. Peters stole second to draw a throw and Gray raced for the plate to beat a wild throw back home. Both Gray and Peters have thirteen stolen bases this season. Gray is 13-for-13 in stolen base attempts in

TWO-OUT BINGO: The Rattlers had a 5-3 lead in the top of the seventh inning with the bases loaded and two outs. Then, Antonio Piñero delivered a two-run single, and Alex Hall smacked a two-run double to give Wisconsin a comfortable 9-3 lead.

WE'RE GOIN' STREAKIN': Ashton McGee had two hits and two walks last night to extend his current hitting streak to seven games. McGee is 11-for-26 during the streak to raise his batting average from .187 to .231. He has also moved his OPS from .567 to .708 in his last seven games.

ABOUT SOUTH BEND: The South Bend Cubs started as the South Bend White Sox when the Midwest League added them as an expansion team in 1988. They changed their name to the Silver Hawks for the 1994 season and became an affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks in 1997. South Bend became an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs in 2015. South Bend won Midwest League pennants in 1989, 1993, 2005, and 2019. Notable alumni for the South Bend franchise include Mike Cameron, Jose Valverde, Chris Capuano, Mark Reynolds, Justin Upton, Wade Miley, Chase Anderson, Keon Broxton, Gleyber Torres, Ian Happ, and Carlos Gonzalez. Terry Francona was the manager of the South Bend White Sox in 1982.

ABOUT THE CUBS: The Chicago Cubs had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in South Bend in 2015. They were affiliated with Quincy from 1965 through 1973 before leaving the Midwest League. The Cubs returned to the MWL with an affiliation with Quad Cities from 1979 through 1984, Peoria from 1985 through 1994 and again from 2005 through 2012, Rockford from 1995 through 1998, Lansing from 1999 through 2004, Kane County in 2013 and 2014.

FIRST HALF: South Bend finished the first half 34-32. They stumbled to the line as they dropped nine out of twelve games to start June. The Cubs put together a tengame winning streak as they won the final two games of the first half and the first eight games of the second half. That streak was snapped with a 9-3 loss at Beloit on July

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline puts five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Tyler Black (#7), Joe Gray Jr. (#13), Antoine Kelly (#14), Russell Smith (#16), and Zavier Warren (#17). Carlos Rodríguez (#21) is on the Wisconsin injured list. MLB Pipeline has nine current South Bend players on their Top 30 list of Chicago Cubs prospects: Peter Crow-Armstrong (#3), Jordan Wicks (#6), Owen Cassie (#8), DJ Herz (#9), Kohl Franklin (#12), Yohendrick Pinango (#20), Pablo Aliendo (#21), Jordan Nwogu (#23), and Daniel Palencia (#25).

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP JUSTIN BULLOCK: Selected by the Brewers in the 16th round of the 2017 draft out of South Granville (NC) High School.

HE'S A PLAYER: Bullock was named the North Carolina Baseball Coaches Association 2A Player of the Year in 2017. He was 11-1 with a 0.55ERA and 124 strikeouts in 63-2/3 innings pitched on the mound. Bullock also hit .476 with eleven homers and 46RBI. Bullock signed with the Brewers over a commitment to North Carolina State University.

EARLY PRO CAREER: Bullock went 1-0 with a 3.09ERA in six games – one start – for the AZL Brewers after signing with Milwaukee in 2017. Then, Bullock made 13 starts for Helena in 2018 and finished fourth in the Pioneer League in strikeouts with 66.

CAROLINA ON MY MIND: Bullock started the 2021 season with the Carolina Mudcats in the Low-A East. He was 1-1 in four starts with a 1.42 ERA. He walked five and struck out 27 over 19 innings pitched with the Mudcats this season. He finished on a 15-2/3 inning scoreless streak.

TIME WITH THE TIMBER RATTLERS: Bullock was 2-2 with a 7.78 ERA, 14 walks and 20 strikeouts over 19-2/3 innings in seven games – three starts – for Wisconsin in 2019 before he left a game on May 9 with a season-ending injury. Bullock returned to the Rattlers in 2021 and was 5-2 in eight starts before he was bumped up to Biloxi.

SOUTHERN MAN: Bullock went 2-5 in eight starts at Biloxi to end the 2021 season. He was 0-2 in nine starts with the Shuckers in 2022 before returning to the Timber Rattlers on July 4.

AWARD WINNING: Bullock was the High-A Central League's pitcher of the month for June. He was 3-1 with a 3.00 ERA in four starts with Wisconsin. Bullock walked one and struck out 23 over 24 innings during the month.

LAST START: Bullock lost to Mississippi in a start at Biloxi on July 3. He allowed five runs on eight hits – including two homers – over five innings.

VS. SOUTH BEND (2021): Bullock beat the Cubs at South Bend on June 10. He pitched five scoreless, hitless innings with no walks, a hit batsman, and ten strikeouts in his debut with the Timber Rattlers this season. His final start as a Rattler in 2021 was a home game against the Cubs on July 23 and he had a no decision when he allowed five runs on six hits over four innings.

SOUTH BEND STARTING PITCHER:

RHP MANUEL ESPINOZA: The Cubs signed Espinoza as an International Free Agent on July 31, 2017 out of Mexico.

STARTING OUT: Espinoza made his professional debut with the Cubs #2 affiliate in the Arizona League in 2019. He was 5-2 in eleven games – seven starts – with nine walks, 37 strikeouts, and a 2.49 ERA in 47 innings pitched in the AZL.

TIME ON THE BEACH: Espinoza pitched for the Myrtle Beach Pelicans in the Low-A East in 2021. He was 4-9 with a 5.11 ERA in 22 starts. Espinoza walked 26 and struck out 92 over 98-2/3 innings pitched as a Pelican last season.

SOUTH OF THE BORDER: Espinoza has pitched for Tomateros de Culicán of the Mexican Pacific Winter League during the offseason between 2020 and 2021 and the offseason between 2021 and 2022. He has made six appearances – four starts – with a 2-1 record and a 3.63 ERA over 22-1/3 innings pitched for his hometown team.

LAST START: Espinoza <u>lost at Beloit on July 3</u>. He allowed eight runs on ten hits with a walk and two strikeouts over 3-2/3 innings. Espinoza allowed two homers in that game.

VS. WISCONSIN: Espinoza made two appearances – one start – against the Timber Rattlers in Wisconsin earlier this season. He allowed one run on four hits and two walks with three strikeouts over four innings in a start on May 17 and pitched 2-2/3 scoreless, hitless innings of relief with two strikeouts on May 22. Espinoza was not involved in the decision in either appearance.
