**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** [The Beloit Snappers beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 5-4](#). Beloit broke a 1-1 tie with four runs in the bottom of the seventh inning. Wisconsin scored twice in the eighth and once in the ninth to get close, but they could not close the gap. The Snappers have won the last three games in this series by one run.

**AFTER THE STRETCH:** Beloit's rally to take the lead started when Griffin Conine drew a lead-off walk in the bottom of the seventh and he moved to second on a passed ball. Thomas Jones made it 2-1 with an RBI double. Marcos Rivera provided the winning margin with a three-run home run later in the inning.

**DIDN'T GO DOWN WITHOUT A FIGHT:** Thomas Dillard cracked a two-run home run with two outs in the top of the eighth inning and LG Castillo hit a lead-off home run in the top of the ninth to get Wisconsin close.

**LET'S GO, CASTILLO:** LG Castillo had two hits, a single in the seventh and the home run in the ninth, to extend his hitting streak to eight games. Castillo is 12-for-33 (.364) during the streak. Last night was also his tenth multi-hit game of the season.

**DYNAMIC DUO:** Garrett Mitchell and Thomas Dillard accounted for three of Wisconsin's four runs last night with a pair of two-out rallies. Mitchell tripled with two outs in the top of the sixth and Dillard drove him home. Mitchell drew a two-out walk in the eighth before Dillard's home run.

**DILLY DILLY:** Dillard's three-RBI game on Friday was his eleventh multi-RBI game of the season. He has 42 RBI this season and is second in the league.

**PHASES OF THE MOON:** Carlos Luna was the Wisconsin starting pitcher last night. He allowed one run on four hits with no walks and five strikeouts over six innings for a no decision. Luna has allowed one run in ten innings over two starts this season.

**ABOUT BELOIT:** The Beloit Snappers are in their first season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers will say "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field and [move into ABC Supply Stadium when they host the Timber Rattlers on August 3](#). Mike Jacobs is in his first season as the manager of the Snappers. Jacobs managed the Clinton LumberKings in 2019, Clinton's last year as an affiliate of the Marlins.

**ABOUT THE MARLINS:** The Florida/Miami Marlins had a history in the old Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and current Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan. The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings and went 78-61 to qualify for the playoffs. They were beaten by the Cedar Rapidsernels in the Best-of-three Western Division Finals two games to one.

## WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP JUSTIN BULLOCK:** Selected by the Brewers in the 16<sup>th</sup> round of the 2017 draft out of South Granville (NC) High School.

**HE'S A PLAYER:** Bullock was named the North Carolina Baseball Coaches Association 2A Player of the Year in 2017. He was 11-1 with a 0.55ERA and 124 strikeouts in 63-2/3 innings pitched on the mound. Bullock also hit .476 with eleven homers and 46RBI.

**LET'S GO PRO:** Bullock signed with the Brewers over a commitment to North Carolina State University.

**IN ARIZONA:** Bullock went 1-0 with a 3.09ERA in six games – one start – for the AZL Brewers after signing with Milwaukee in 2017. He walked three and struck out eleven in 11-2/3 innings pitched in his debut season.

**A SEASON IN MONTANA:** Bullock made 13 starts for Helena in 2018. He was 2-5 with 66 strikeouts in 58-2/3 innings pitched. Bullock finished fourth in the Pioneer League in strikeouts.

**TIME WITH THE TIMBER RATTLERS:** Bullock was 2-2 with a 7.78 ERA, 14 walks and 20 strikeouts over 19-2/3 innings in seven games – three starts – for Wisconsin in 2019.

**CAROLINA ON MY MIND:** Bullock started this season with the Carolina Mudcats in the Low-A East. He was 1-1 in four starts with a 1.42 ERA. He walked five and struck out 27 over 19 innings pitched with the Mudcats this season. He finished on a 15-2/3 inning scoreless streak.

**AWARD WINNING:** Bullock was the High-A Central League's pitcher of the month for June. He was 3-1 with a 3.00 ERA in four starts with Wisconsin. Bullock walked one and struck out 23 over 24 innings during the month. One of his wins was the first five innings of a combined no-hitter [at South Bend on June 10](#).

**LAST START:** Bullock pitched a seven-inning complete game and picked up the win in a 6-2 win over the [Peoria Chiefs at Neuroscience Group Field on June 27](#) in the first game of a doubleheader. Bullock allowed five hits and struck out two with no walks in the start.

**VS. MARLINS (2019):** Bullock pitched a scoreless inning of relief against [the Clinton LumberKings on April 19, 2019](#). The LumberKings were affiliated with the Miami Marlins at the time. He allowed one hit and struck out three in the game. Bullock did not pitch against the Beloit Snappers in 2019.

## BELOIT STARTING PITCHER:

**LHP ANTONIO VELEZ:** Signed with the Miami Marlins as a non-drafted free agent on July 9, 2020.

**THE HILLS OF FLORIDA:** Velez pitched for Hillsborough Community College before attending Florida State. He was 4-4 with 80 strikeouts in 14 appearances for Hillsborough.

**FSU:** Velez pitched two seasons with the Seminoles. He was 5-2 with a save and a 4.17 ERA as a junior in 2019. Velez was 1-0 with three walks and 21 strikeouts in 17-1/3 innings pitched during his shortened 2020 season.

**AWARD (COLLEGE):** Velez was named the Collegiate Baseball National Pitcher of the Week for his performance in a win over Florida on March 10, 2020. Velez allowed one hit, walked two, and struck out seven over six scoreless innings in a 2-0 victory over the #1 Gators. That would be his final game with Florida State.

**ON TO PUERTO RICO:** Velez made two starts for Mayaguez in Puerto Rico during December, 2020. He was 1-0 with a 6.00 ERA, one walk, and four strikeouts over nine innings in those two starts during winter ball.

**TIME IN THE MIDWEST:** Velez is 2-0 in twelve games – four starts – with the Beloit Snappers this season. He has walked six and struck out 34 over 34-1/3 innings pitched this season.

**LAST START:** Velez pitched five perfect innings against [Quad Cities at home on June 27](#). He struck out two River Bandits and had a no decision in the game.

**AWARD (PRO):** Velez was named the High-A Central League Pitcher of the Week on June 28 for his two starts against Quad Cities in the prior week. He was 1-0 as he pitched ten innings, allowed no runs on two hits, walked one and struck out seven. Velez faced one batter over the minimum in those two starts.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Velez made two relief appearances against the Timber Rattlers at Neuroscience Group Field during the first series of the 2021 season. He allowed three runs on five hits and struck out five over 6-2/3 innings. Velez was the winning pitcher [on May 9 over Wisconsin](#).
