ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Beloit Snappers beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 5-4 in eleven innings.](#) The Timber Rattlers had a 2-1 lead after 7-1/2 innings. Griffin Conine hit a two-out, three-run home run in the bottom of the eighth inning to put the Snappers ahead. Wisconsin tied the game with consecutive, [two-out RBI singles by Carlos Rodríguez and Nick Kahle in the top of the ninth.](#) Reliever Arman Sabouri left the bases loaded in the ninth and tenth innings, but Beloit pushed the winning run across the plate in the bottom of the eleventh on an RBI single by Connor Scott.

IT GOES TO ELEVEN: Hayden Cantrelle drew a walk in his last three plate appearances last night. He has drawn at least one walk in eleven straight games and has 50 walks in 45 games. There are only three streaks longer than his in all classifications of baseball, including MLB, this season. Anthony Servideo of Delmarva in the Low-A East had a walk in 15 straight games. Kyle Stowers (Aberdeen, High-A East) and Logan Wyatt (Eugene, High-A West) each had 12-game streaks. None of those streaks are active.

OTHER STREAKS: LG Castillo and Korry Howell each had two hits last night. Castillo's hitting streak has reached seven games. Howell's hitting streak has reached eight games, season highs for both players.

IT'S A HEARTACHE: Wisconsin is 0-4 in four extra-inning games this season. All four extra-innings decisions have ended on walkoff, RBI singles

NOTHING BUT A HEARTACHE: Last night was the sixth time the Rattlers have lost a game that they led going into the eighth inning this season.

HITS YOU WHEN IT'S TOO LATE: Last night was also Wisconsin's 15th blown save of the season.

HITS YOU WHEN YOU'RE DOWN: Last night was the 22nd time the Timber Rattlers have suffered a walkoff loss to the Snappers since 1995.

ABOUT BELOIT: The Beloit Snappers are in their first season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers will say "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field and [move into ABC Supply Stadium when they host the Timber Rattlers on August 3.](#) Mike Jacobs is in his first season as the manager of the Snappers. Jacobs managed the Clinton LumberKings in 2019, Clinton's last year as an affiliate of the Marlins.

ABOUT THE MARLINS: The Florida/Miami Marlins had a history in the old Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and current Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan. The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings and went 78-61 to qualify for the playoffs. They were beaten by the Cedar Rapids Kernels in the Best-of-three Western Division Finals two games to one.

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP CARLOS LUNA: The Milwaukee Brewers signed Luna as a Minor League Free Agent on May 18, 2021.

WELCOME BACK: Luna originally signed with Milwaukee as an international Free Agent out of Panama on July 11, 2013. The Brewers released him on May 31, 2020.

HEY, NOW! YOU'RE AN ALL-STAR: Luna pitched in the Dominican Summer League for the Brewers in 2014 and 2015. He was 4-2 with a 1.46 ERA and was named a DSL All-Star in 2015.

MISSING TIME: Luna missed the 2016 and 2017 seasons due to Tommy John Surgery.

ON THE COMEBACK: Luna made eleven appearances – four starts – for the AZL Brewers in 2018. He was 2-2 with a 3.38 ERA, seven walks, and 22 strikeouts over 20-1/3 innings pitched.

FROM THE MOUNTAINS TO TRIPLE-A: Luna was 3-4 with a 3.58 ERA in 14 starts for the Rocky Mountain Vibes in 2019. He also made a start for San Antonio, Milwaukee's Pacific Coast League affiliate, on [September 2, 2019](#). In his Triple-A start, Luna allowed one run on four hits with a walk and five strikeouts over five innings for a no decision.

LAST APPEARANCE: Luna allowed one run on three hits over 3-2/2 innings as a reliever against the Peoria Chiefs in [game two of a doubleheader at Neuroscience Group Field at Fox Cities Stadium on June 27](#). He walked none and struck out four to pick up the win in the 6-5 Wisconsin victory.

LAST START: Luna had a no decision as the starter [at Quad Cities on June 15](#). He allowed two hits, walked two, and struck out four over four scoreless innings. The River Bandits beat Wisconsin 5-3.

VS. БЕЛОIT: Luna has never faced the Snappers prior to this evening. This is also the first time he will face an affiliate of the Miami Marlins.

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED RELIEVER:

RHP ZACH MORT: Signed with Milwaukee as a Minor League Free Agent on January 14, 2021.

ORIGIN STORY: Mort was drafted by the Chicago Cubs in the 8th round of the 2018 draft out of George Mason University.

PATRIOTIC DUTY: Mort appeared in 57 games – 28 starts – over three seasons at George Mason. He went 12-12 with nine saves and a 3.72 ERA and 205 strikeouts over 227-1/3 innings pitched during his collegiate career.

IN THE CUBS DEN: Mort spent two seasons (2018 and 2019) in the Cubs organization after signing with them. He made ten relief appearances (0-4, 5.79) with the Eugene Emeralds in 2018. In 2019, Mort started the season with the South Bend Cubs in the Midwest League, was sent back to Eugene in the middle of June, and returned to South Bend in early August. Mort was 3-3 with a 3.72 ERA in Eugene and 6-2 with a 3.13 ERA for South Bend.

POSTSEASON: Mort was the winning pitcher in Game One of the Midwest League Championship Series against the [Clinton LumberKings on September 11, 2019](#). Mort went three scoreless innings, allowed one hit and two walks with four strikeouts as a reliever. The South Bend Cubs went on to sweep the best-of-five series from Clinton.

IT DIDN'T HAPPEN: Mort was in Eugene when the Timber Rattlers swept a three-game series from South Bend at Neuroscience Group Field July 17-19. So, he never pitched against Wisconsin in 2019.

LAST APPEARANCE: Mort made the start in the second game of the doubleheader against the Peoria Chiefs [on June 27 at Neuroscience Group Field](#). He allowed four runs on six hits – including two home runs – with no walks and three strikeouts over 1-2/3 innings. Mort was not involved in the decision. The Timber Rattlers would win the game 6-5.

VS. БЕЛОIT (2021): Mort was the starter against the Snappers [on May 8 at Neuroscience Group Field](#). He allowed one run on three hits with two walks and five strikeouts but was not involved in the decision. The Timber Rattlers would win the game 4-3.

LHP ZACH KING: Selected by the Miami Marlins in the 13th round of the 2019 draft out of Vanderbilt.

AS A PRO: King was 2-0 in six games – three starts – with the Gulf Coast League Marlins after he signed his professional contract. King walked seven and struck out 17 over 16-1/3 innings in the GCL in 2019.

THE COMMODORE: King was 3-7 and six saves with a 4.02 ERA in 70 games – six starts – over three seasons at Vanderbilt. He walked 60 and struck out 129 in 130 innings pitched during his college career.

LAST START: King had a no decision in a start against [Quad Cities at Pohlman Field on June 26](#). He allowed five runs on six hits, including three homers, with two walks and six strikeouts over four innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: King lost to the Timber Rattlers [at Neuroscience Group Field on May 7](#). He allowed four runs on five hits with three walks and four strikeouts over 4-2/3 innings.
