THAT'S GOOD WORK, CLARKE: Wes Clarke got the Timber Rattlers on the scoreboard and tied the game with a solo home run in the bottom of the second inning. Clarke added a single in the bottom of the ninth inning to help set up Wisconsin's second run.

MULTI-BALL: Clarke, Tristan Peters, and Carlos Rodríguez each had two hits on Friday night. Peters singled in the ninth and went to third on the single by Clarke. Rodríguez drove in Peters with an infield single in the ninth

RUNNING WILD: South Bend was 3-for-4 in stolen base attempts on Friday. The Cubs have nine steals and have been caught twice in the first four games of the series. The Timber Rattlers had two stolen bases without being caught on Friday. Wisconsin is 6-for-6 in steals during this series.

GOPHER BALLS: The Timber Rattlers have allowed 41 home runs this season. The Quad Cities River Bandits have given up 46 homers and the Lansing Lugnuts have allowed 42 home runs in 2022.

ABOUT SOUTH BEND: The South Bend Cubs started as the South Bend White Sox when the Midwest League added them as an expansion team in 1988. They changed their name to the Silver Hawks for the 1994 season and became an affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks in 1997. South Bend became an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs. South Bend won Midwest League pennants in 1989, 1993, 2005, and 2019. Notable alumni for the South Bend franchise include Mike Cameron, Jose Valverde, Chris Capuano, Mark Reynolds, Justin Upton, Wade Miley, Chase Anderson, Keon Broxton, Gleyber Torres, Ian Happ, and Carlos Gonzalez. Terry Francona was the manager of the South Bend White Sox in 1982.

ABOUT THE CUBS: The Chicago Cubs had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in South Bend in 2015. They were affiliated with Quincy from 1965 through 1973 before leaving the Midwest League. The Cubs returned to the MWL with an affiliation with Quad Cities from 1979 through 1984, Peoria from 1985 through 1994 and again from 2005 through 2012, Rockford from 1995 through 1998, Lansing from 1999 through 2004, Kane County in 2013 and 2014.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

LHP BRANDON KNARR: The Brewers signed Knarr as a non-drafted free agent out of the University of Tampa on July 17, 2020.

GOLDEN DOME: Knarr pitched at Notre Dame as a freshman and appeared in twelve games.

TO FLORIDA: Knarr spent his sophomore season at the College of Central Florida. He was 6-1 with 86 strikeouts and an ERA of 4.66 over 65-2/3 innings in sixteen games – thirteen starts.

TAMPA, TOO: Knarr transferred to the University of Tampa for the 2019-2020 season and was 4-1 with 64 strikeouts and a 2.55 ERA over 35-1/3 innings pitched in six starts before the shutdown.

IN THE MUD: Knarr started the 2021 season with the Carolina Mudcats. He was 7-2 with 103 strikeouts over 75 innings and an ERA of 3.84 in sixteen games – thirteen starts – before his promotion to Wisconsin on August 17.

AS A RATTLER LAST YEAR: Knarr made five starts with Wisconsin at the end of the 2021 season. He went 1-1 with fourteen walks, 25 strikeouts, and fifteen earned runs allowed over 22-1/3 innings.

LAST START: Knarr was the <u>winning pitcher at Quad Cities on May 15</u>. He allowed three hits, walked one, and struck out ten over seven scoreless innings.

VS. SOUTH BEND: Knarr has never faced South Bend prior to this afternoon. This is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs.

SOUTH BEND STARTING PITCHER:

RHP JOE NAHAS: The Chicago Cubs signed Nahas as a non-drafted free agent in 2019 before he returned to Georgia Southern for his senior season.

ON THE CAPE: Nahas was pitching for Cotuit in the Cape Cod League after he was not drafted in 2019. He was 1-1 with a 1.50 ERA in five games – two starts – with Cotuit. He walked six and struck out 27 in 18 innings pitched there.

STATE OF GEORIGIA: Nahas went 2-0 with a 4.78 ERA in fourteen games – six starts – in his lone season at Georgia Southern. He walked fourteen and struck out 42 over 43-1/3 innings pitched.

IN MARYLAND: Nahas pitched as a freshman at the University of Maryland-Baltimore County and went to Chesapeake College for his sophomore season before transferring to Georgia Southern.

2019: Nahas was 0-2 with a 5.74 ERA in eleven games – two starts - for the AZL Cubs-1 and Eugene after signing with Chicago. He walked eleven and struck out 20 in 15-2/3 innings pitched as a pro in 2019.

2021: Nahas pitched for Myrtle Beach, South Bend, and Tennessee in the Cubs system last season. He was 6-7 with a 4.27 ERA in 25 games – twelve starts – in 2021. Nahas had 89 strikeouts and 32 walks in 92-2/3 innings pitched.

LAST START: Nahas had the win at home against Fort Wayne on May 15. He allowed a run on three hits with two walks and four strikeouts over six innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Nahas made <u>a start</u> and <u>a relief appearance</u> against the Rattlers last season. He had a no decision and allowed three runs on three solo home runs with a walk and five strikeouts over seven innings at Wisconsin in 2021.
