ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Quad Cities River Bandits defeated the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 8-7.](#)

The Timber Rattlers outhit the River Bandits 13-10, but Quad Cities hit three home runs and never trailed in the game. Darrien Miller went 4-for-5 and Wes Clarke drove in three runs for Wisconsin. Wisconsin's six-game winning streak came to an end with the loss.

BACK AND FORTH: The Timber Rattlers were down 2-0, 4-1, and 6-3 before tying the game 6-6 with three runs in the top of the sixth. The River Bandits scored twice in the bottom of the sixth and held off the Rattlers in the seventh after Wisconsin scored a run and had the bases loaded with one out.

BLACKOUT: Tyler Black went 1-for-4 with a homer and a walk. Black had a sacrifice fly in the seventh and a three-run triple in the eighth. Black has been Wisconsin's lead-off batter in the last six games. He has been on base fourteen times and scored seven runs in his six games as the lead-off hitter. Black is 7-for-16 with nine RBI in the series at Quad Cities.

BLACKJACK: Tristan Peters beat out an infield single in the seventh and scored a run last night. He was 1-for-5 and pushed his current on-base streak to 21 games. He has an OPS of .962 with twelve walks, sixteen runs scored, and twelve RBI during the streak. Colt Keith of West Michigan saw his 27 game on-base streak end yesterday. Davis Bradshaw of Beloit has an active 21-game on-base streak.

ALMOST: The River Bandits were up 7-6 with the bases loaded and no outs in the bottom of the sixth. Kent Hasler was called into the game from the bullpen. He struck out the first two batters and had a 1-2 count on Burle Dixon. Hasler appeared to get the strikeout to end the inning, but a balk was called the Bandits got their insurance run.

FORE! Miller recorded his first four-hit game as a pro last night. He has eight multi-hit games this season, second on the team in that category.

ABOUT QUAD CITIES: The River Bandits are the Midwest League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. The current version of Davenport Professional Baseball club started in 1960 as the Midwest League affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves. Quad Cities has affiliated with several MLB teams: The California Angels (1962-1978 and 1985-1992), the Chicago Cubs (1979-1984), the Houston Astros (1993-1998 and 2013-2019), the Minnesota Twins (1999-2004), and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005-2012). The team became the Quad City River Bandits in 1992. They changed their name to the Swing of the Quad Cities from 2004 through 2007 before changing to Quad Cities River Bandits in 2008. Quad Cities won Midwest League pennants in 1968, 1971, 1979, 1990, 2011, 2013, and 2017. They were the High-A Central League champions in 2021. Notable alumni of Quad Cities: Carlos Correa, Joe Mauer, Josh Hader, Billy Wagner, Shawon Dunston, Justin Morneau, and Brett Phillips.

ABOUT THE ROYALS: The Kansas City Royals have been Quad Cities' parent club since 2021. They left the Midwest league and an affiliation with Kane County at the end of the 2012 season. The Royals had previously been in the Midwest League with Waterloo from 1969-1976, Appleton (1987-1992), Rockford (1993-94), Springfield (1995), Lansing (1996-1998), Burlington (2001-2010), and Kane County (2011-2012).

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP TJ SHOOK: The Brewers signed Shook as a non-drafted free agent out of the University of South Carolina on July 24, 2020.

GAMER: Shook pitched three seasons for the Gamecocks. He was 6-1 with three saves in 41 appearances – nine starts – at South Carolina. He struck out 92 and walked 35 in 74 innings pitched with a 3.04 ERA in his college career.

TEAMMATES: Shook was on the same pitching staff as Adam Hill in 2018. Hill was a Timber Rattler in the 2019 season. Shook was also a college teammate of current Wisconsin catcher Wes Clarke at South Carolina.

TJ AND THE BLOWFISH: Shook pitched for the Lexington County Blowfish in the Coastal Plain League in 2017 and 2018. He was 2-0 with a 1.89 ERA with 28 strikeouts in 33-1/3 innings pitched in 2017. Shook had no record in four games – three starts – for the Blowfish in 2018.

GOLD, TJ...GOLD! Shook started last season with the ACL Brewers Gold. He allowed a run on a hit and struck out ten over 4-2/3 innings in two starts with no record before a quick promotion to the Carolina Mudcats.

COOL CAT: Shook was 4-1 in six starts for Carolina. He walked eleven and struck out 36 in 28 innings before his promotion to Wisconsin.

APRIL AWARD: The Brewers named Shook as one of their Minor League Pitchers of the Month for April. He went 1-1 with a 1.37 ERA and 27 strikeouts over 19-2/3 innings in four games – two starts – during April.

LAST APPEARANCE: Shook had a no decision in [four scoreless innings of relief against Fort Wayne at home on May 8](#). He allowed four hits, walked none, and struck out five.

LAST START: Shook beat Fort Wayne [at home on May 3](#). He pitched six scoreless innings, walked none, and struck out seven.

VS. QUAD CITIES (2022): Shook had a no decision against the [River Bandits at home on April 21](#). He allowed a run on two hits with two walks and seven strikeouts over 5-2/3 innings. The only run he gave up was on a solo home run by Burle Dixon.

QUAD CITIES STARTING PITCHER:

RHP NOAH MURDOCK: The Royals selected Murdock in the 7th round of the 2019 draft out of the University of Virginia.

BEING CAVALIER: Murdock pitched three seasons at Virginia. He was 8-9 with a 5.30 ERA in 30 appearances – 25 starts – with the Cavaliers. Murdock walked 57 and struck out 103 in 125-2/3 innings pitched in his collegiate career.

APPALACHIAN TRAIL: Murdock went to the Burlington Royals in the Appalachian League after signing with Kansas City. He was 3-1 with a 2.89 ERA in eleven games – six starts – during the regular season. He made two appearances – one start – during Burlington's playoff run during the 2019 Appalachian League postseason. Murdock was 0-1 with a save in those two playoff appearances.

NO....IT'S IOWA: Murdock joined the River Bandits on June 15 to start his 2021 season. He was 2-1 with a 3.18 ERA in seven games – six starts – with Quad Cities last season. He walked eleven and struck out nineteen in 22-2/3 innings as a River Bandit in 2021.

LAST START: Murdock had a no decision [at home at Cedar Rapids on May 8](#). He allowed one hit with two walks and six strikeouts over 4-1/3 scoreless innings.

VS. WISCONSIN (2022): Murdock was the starting pitcher against the Rattlers [at Wisconsin on April 21](#). He had a no decision, allowed four runs on five hits with three walks and two strikeouts over 2-1/3 innings.
