ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The West Michigan Whitecaps beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 3-1 at LMCU Ballpark. West Michigan scored three runs in the

bottom of the first inning on a two-run home run by Corey Joyce and an RBI double by Bryant Packard. Five West Michigan pitchers combined to hold the Rattlers to one run. Brant Hurter, the starter, allowed four hits over six scoreless innings with no walks and seven strikeouts for the win.

JARVIS SHOWS HIS QUALITY: Justin Jarvis was the starting pitcher for the Timber Rattlers. He allowed three runs on three hits in the first inning. Jarvis pitched six more innings without allowing another hit or another run for his seventh quality start of the season. He walked four and struck out five in seven innings. Jarvis leads the Midwest League in innings pitched with 94 He is tied with Robert Gasser of Fort Wayne for the league lead in strikeouts with 109.

GOING DEEP: Zavier Warren hit a lead-off home run in the eighth inning against West Michigan reliever Jared Tobey. The homer was Warren's fifth of the season and first since June 29. The home run also broke Wisconsin's scoreless streak at 19-2/3 innings. RUNNING INTO A HOT TEAM: The Whitecaps were 8-17 after a home loss to Lansing on May 6. They are 38-23 since May 7, including 9-2 in their last eleven dames

RUNNING INTO HOT STARTERS: In the first five games of this series, the Timber Rattlers have only scored against one of the starting pitchers for the Whitecaps. West Michigan starters have pitched a total of 25-2/3 innings in the series. Ty Madden allowed four runs over 4-2/3 innings on Thursday.

PLAYING FROM BEHIND: West Michigan has scored first in all five games of this series.

ERROR-FREE: Wisconsin did not commit an error last night. It was their 42<sup>nd</sup> game without an error this season

ABOUT WEST MICHIGAN: The West Michigan Whitecaps joined the Midwest League in 1994 when the Madison Muskies moved to Grand Rapids, Michigan following the 1993 season. The Whitecaps started play in the league as an affiliate of the Oakland Athletics. They became Low-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers for the 1997 season. The Whitecaps won six Midwest League Pennants (1996, 1998, 2004, 2006, 2007, and 2015) before getting the bump up to the High-A Affiliate of the Tigers going into the 2021 season. Notable former Whitecaps include Nick Castellanos, Joel Zumaya, Fernando Rodney, Brandon Inge, and Cameron Maybin.

ABOUT THE TIGERS: Detroit has been affiliated with the Whitecaps since 1997. The Tigers had just one other stint in the Midwest League prior to their current partnership. They were with the Clinton Pilots from 1971 through 1975.

THE SEASON SO FAR: West Michigan finished the first half 31-35 in fourth place in the Eastern Division. They are coming into this series with Wisconsin after going 5-1 in a six-game series at Dayton. The Whitecaps are the firstplace team in the Eastern Division and have a two-game lead over Great Lakes the first half champions in the Fastern Division

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline puts five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Tyler Black (#7), Joe Gray Jr. (#13), Antoine Kelly (#14), Russell Smith (#16), and Zavier Warren (#17). Carlos Rodríguez (#21) is on the Wisconsin injured list. MLB Pipeline has three members of the Whitecaps roster on their list of Top 30 Prospects in the Detroit system: Ty Madden (#5), Keider Montero (#25), and Brant Hurter (#29). Dylan Smith (#8) and Colt Keith (#12) are on the IL.

# **PITCHING MATCHUP**

### WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP JAMES MEEKER:** Signed by Milwaukee as a Minor League Free Agent off the Washington Wild Things of the Frontier League on August 13, 2021.

WHAT A LONG STRANGE TRIP IT'S BEEN: Meeker began his college career at the University of Akron and transferred to the University of Delaware after Akron dropped its baseball program. He signed with the Washington Wild Things in 2018 and pitched for them in 2018, 2019, and 2021. In 2020, Meeker pitched for the Steel City Slammin' Sammies, also based in Washington, Pennsylvania.

WHAT IN THE BLUE HEN? Meeker went 4-2 with six saves in 26 games – one start – at Delaware in 2018. He had 45 strikeouts over 53 innings pitched in his final season of college baseball.

**TO THE FRONTIER:** Meeker made 89 relief appearances with the Wild Things over 2-1/2 seasons in the Frontier League. He was 5-4 with a save and 126 strikeouts over 115-1/3 innings.

**ON TO CAROLINA:** Meeker was assigned to the Carolina Mudcats after signing with Milwaukee. He was 1-2 with five saves in twelve appearances with 22 strikeouts over eighteen innings.

LAST START: Meeker made his first professional start <u>on June 18, 2022 at</u> <u>Great Lakes</u>. He allowed two runs on three hits with no walks and four strikeouts over three innings for a no decision.

LAST APPEARANCE: Meeker took the loss in a relief appearance against West Michigan on July 12. He allowed a run on three hits with no walks and a strikeout over 2-2/3 innings.

VS. WEST MICHIGAN: Meeker's relief outing on July 12 is the only time he has faced the Whitecaps in his career.

### WEST MICHIGAN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP CARLOS GUZMÁN:** The Tigers signed Guzmán as an International Free Agent on March 4, 2015 out of Venezuela.

**STARTING POINT:** Guzmán was originally signed as an infielder. He hit .156 in 34 games with Detroit's affiliate in the Venezuelan Summer League in 2015 and .107 for the Tigers East affiliate in the Gulf Coast League in 2016.

**MAKING THE MOVE:** Guzmán made his professional pitching debut in 2017 in the Gulf Coast League as he pitched for both Tigers East and Tigers West that season. He was 1-1 with four saves in fourteen relief appearances and 25 strikeouts over 25-2/3 innings.

**PRE-2020:** Guzmán went 3-4 with a 3.78 ERA in 2018 in thirteen appearances – twelve starts for Connecticut in the New York-Penn League and one relief appearance with Lakeland in the Florida State League. In 2019, Guzmán was 2-2 in seven starts with a 2.73 ERA for West Michigan in the Midwest League.

SHOW US LAST YEAR: Guzmán was 7-9 with a 4.65 ERA in 23 games – 22 starts – for Lakeland in the Low-A Southeast in 2021. He walked 46 and struck out 102 in 98-2/3 innings pitched for the Flying Tigers.

**LAST START:** Guzmán had a <u>no decision against the Timber Rattlers on</u> <u>July 12</u>. He allowed three hits with no walks and five strikeouts over five shutout innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: The game on July 12 is the only time Guzmán has ever faced the Timber Rattlers in his career.
