ABOUT BELOIT: The Beloit Snappers are in their first season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11 and moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3. Mike Jacobs is in his first season as the manager of the Snappers. Jacobs managed the Clinton LumberKings in 2019, Clinton's last year as an affiliate of the Marlins.

ABOUT THE MARLINS: The Florida/Miami Marlins had a history in the old Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and current Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings and went 78-61 to qualify for the playoffs. They were swept by the South Bend Cubs in the 2019 MWL Championship Series.

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP FREISIS ADAMES: Signed by the Brewers as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic on December 14, 2015.

IN THE GOOD OLD SUMMERTIME: Adames spent 2016 and 2017 in the Dominican Summer League. He was 3-2 with a save in 22 relief appearances in 2016 and 5-6 with a 3.13ERA in 14 games – 13 starts – in 2017.

RUNNER-UP: Adames finished second in the Dominican Summer League in strikeouts in 2017 when he had 80 strikeouts over 74-2/3 innings pitched.

ON TO ARIZONA: Adames made ten appearances – five starts – for Milwaukee's Arizona League affiliate in 2018. He was 2-1 with a 3.89ERA and 31 strikeouts over 37 innings pitched.

WITH WISCONSIN: Adames was 3-2 with two saves and a 3.59 ERA in 18 games – nine starts – as a Timber Rattler in 2019. He walked 30 and struck out 73 over 72-2/3 innings pitched during that season.

LAST APPEARANCE: Adames pitched worked 1-1/3 innings in relief <u>against the Snappers on August 5</u>. He didn't allow a hit, a run, or a walk, and struck out two for a no decision.

LAST START: Adames lost to Cedar Rapids <u>at home on July 27 at home</u>. He allowed four runs on seven his with two walks and eight strikeouts over 5-1/3 innings.

VS. BELOIT (2021): Adames is 1-0 in four games – one start – against the Snappers this season. He has allowed five runs on seven hits with five walks and fifteen strikeouts over 11-1/3 innings against the Snappers in 2021.

RHP GEORGE SORIANO: Signed by the Miami Marlins as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic on August 19, 2015.

2016 to 2018: Soriano started his professional career in the Dominican Summer League in 2016 and was 1-6 with two saves, a 3.56ERA, and 56 strikeouts over 55-2/3 innings over 17 games (nine starts). He missed the 2017 season and returned to the mound in the Gulf Coast League in 2018 to go 2-1 with a save, a 1.91ERA, and 36 strikeouts over 42-1/3 innings over eleven games – three starts.

ON TO IOWA: Soriano pitched for the Clinton LumberKings during the 2019 season. He was 4-7 with a save and a 3.91 ERA in 23 games – 20 starts – for the LumberKings. He walked 50 and struck out 99 in 119-2/3 innings pitched that season.

IN THE PRESENT: Soriano started this season with the Jupiter Hammerheads in the Low-A Southeast. He was 3-0 with a 2.91 ERA and 47 strikeouts over 34 innings in seven starts before his promotion to the Snappers on June 29.

LAST START: Soriano won <u>at Peoria on July 31</u>. He allowed two runs on eight hits with a walk and five strikeouts over six innings.

VS. WISCONSIN (2021): Soriano made his 2021 Snappers debut with a start against the Timber Rattlers on July 3 at Pohlman Field and took the loss. He allowed three runs on five hits with a walk and three strikeouts over 3-2/3 innings.
