DURHAM BULLS [39-18] AT NORFOLK TIDES [24-31]

RHP JOE RYAN [3-3, 4.11] vs. LHP ALEX WELLS [4-3, 5.63]

TODAY'S GAME

After clinching a series win with last night's victory, the Bulls look to finish the series on a high note in this afternoon's finale. Durham RHP Joe Ryan (3-3, 4.11) is expected to toe the rubber, while the Tides are anticipated to send LHP Alex Wells (4-3, 5.63) to the hill.

LAST TIME OUT

The Bulls earned a 5-2 victory over the Tides last night, thanks to a pair of longballs from 1B Mike Ford (2-5, 2 R, 2 HR, 4 RBI), who drove in 4 of Durham's 5 runs & was the only player from either side to record a multi-hit effort. Durham also totaled a season-high 6 steals last night, including 3 from CF Ryan Boldt & 2 from LF Dalton Kelly. The Bulls bullpen was stout once again as 5 relievers, including LHP Ryan Sherriff (1.0 IP), Phoenix Sanders (2.0 IP, 2 K), Brian Moran (0.2 IP, BB), Louis Head (1.1 IP, K) & Brent Honeywell Jr. (1.0 IP, H, R, ER, K) combined for the final 6 frames, yielding a lone run on just one hit in support of starter Luis Patino (3.0 IP, 2 H, R, ER, 5 BB, 5 K), with Sherriff earning his 2nd win. Norfolk reliever Conner Greene (1.0 IP, 2 H, 4 R, 3 ER, 3 BB) suffered the defeat in support of starter Kevin Smith (3.1 IP, 4 H, R, ER, 2 BB, 6 K).

BULLS vs. TIDES

Durham & Norfolk face off for their 3rd overall series this season, including their 2nd at Harbor Park. The 2 clubs last met between 6/15-20 in Norfolk, with the Bulls winning 4 of 6 matchups against the Tides. The 1st time the 2 teams squared off this year was a 5-game set at Durham Bulls Athletic Park from 6/1-6, with Durham winning 3 of 5 tilts. The Bulls entering this series have outscored the Tides 61-50 & outthit them 102-79. OF Nathan Lukes enters the series pacing the club with a .375 mark (9-24) with 4 runs, 1 double, 1 homer & 5 RBI in 7 matchups with Norfolk, while OF Josh Lowe has hit .333 (13-39) with 3 runs, 4 doubles, 1 homer & 6 RBI in 10 matchups. C Deivy Grullon has also bashed 3 homers while batting .300 (6-20) in 8 tilts versus Norfolk.

FIRST PLACE BULLS

The Bulls entering play today have been alone or tied at the top of the divisional standings for 41 of 68 days this season. Durham's 38 victories are the most of any Triple-A squad this season entering play today. The Bulls also have more wins than 6 MLB teams, including Kansas City (36-52), Minnesota (37-50), Texas (35-53), Pittsburgh (32-55), Baltimore (28-59) & Arizona (26-64).

BULL-ET POINTS

- OF Nathan Lukes has hit .439 (18-41) when batting with runners in scoring position this year, while INF Mike Ford has hit .375 (6-16) with 3 homers in those spots.
Bulls pitchers have struck out 10 or more batters in 43 of their 57 games this season, and had fanned 10 or more in each of their prior 12 contests before striking out 9 in last night's contest
Durham owns a 4-9 mark when scoring 3 or fewer runs, compared to a 34-9 clip when scoring 4 or more runs.
The Bulls have homered in 45 of their 57 games this season, including 14 of their last 18 tilts.

OH SNAP...

OF Josh Lowe saw his hit streak snapped at 10 games last night after going hitless. During that stretch from 6/27-7/9 he posted a .293 average (12-41) with 6 runs, 3 doubles & 4 RBI. Overall this year, Lowe has recorded at least 1 hit in 41 of his 50 games with the Bulls, including 26 of his most recent 30 since 6/1. INF Wander Franco's 14-game hit streak is the longest by a Durham batter this season.

TWO FOR THE MONEY

INF Mike Ford's 2-homer game last night marked the 6th time this year a Bulls batter has gone deep twice in a contest. The last time a Durham hitter accomplished that feat was C Deivy Grullon on 6/17 at Norfolk in a 10-6 defeat to the Tides. OF Josh Lowe & INF Kevin Padlo both went deep twice on the road as well on 5/7 at Memphis, while INF/OF Vidal Brujan homered twice the very next day on 5/8 at Memphis. It was also the 6th multi-homer game of Ford's career, with his last coming on 8/26/19 at Seattle while with the New York Yankees.

STEALING HEADLINES

The Bulls' 6 steals last night were a team-high for a game this season. Durham enters play today with 56 stolen bases this season, which ranks 6th among all Triple-A squads. INF/OF Vidal Brujan & OF Josh Lowe have combined for 27 of the team's 56 steals this year.

NOT YOUR AVERAGE JOE

RHP Joe Ryan enters play today leading all Triple-A pitchers in WHIP (0.87) & batting average against (.189), in addition to ranking T-5th in strikeouts (61). He also ranks 9th in earned-run average (4.11) among Triple-A East hurlers. Over his last 3 starts dating back to 6/23, Ryan has struck out 21 of 56 batters faced while yielding just 1 walk & 9 hits. Last week he has selected to Team USA's Olympic Roster alongside RHP Shane Baz.

THROWING A FIT

Durham pitchers enter play today tied for 1st among all full-season MiLB clubs in WHIP (1.13), in addition to pacing all Triple-A clubs with 615 strikeouts. The Bulls' 3.28 team ERA also ranks 2nd among full-season MiLB squads, trailing only Double-A Somerset (2.96). Durham pitchers have allowed 206 runs this year, which ranks 2nd-fewest among all MiLB clubs behind Somerset (189).

WHAT A DIFFERENCE

Durham enters play today with a +129 run differential, which ranks 4th-highest overall among MiLB squads this year. Only High-A Everett (+174), Low-A Tampa (+167) & Low-A Delmarva (+135), & have a larger run differential than the Bulls. Durham has finished with a run differential of more than 100 in 2 of their last 3 seasons in 2018 (+108) & 2017 (+119).

WHAT A RELIEF

Durham relief pitchers this year have combined for a 1.11 WHIP, which ranks best among all Triple-A teams & 2nd-best among all full-season MiLB clubs behind Double-A Harrisburg (1.07). The Bulls bullpen's 2.95 ERA is also 4th-lowest among all full-season MiLB squads & 2nd in Triple-A behind only Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (2.85).

LAST TIME OUT: Ryan did not factor in the final decisions on 7/4 versus Gwinnett after yielding 4 earned runs on 5 hits in 5.0 innings pitched, adding no walks while striking out 7 batters. The right-hander matched a season-high by throwing 83 pitches (57 strikes) in the Bulls' 5-4 walk-off victory over Gwinnett.

USA! USA! Ryan last week was named to the U.S. Olympic Team roster as announced by USA Baseball, joining fellow Bulls RHP Shane Baz for the 2020 Olympic Games in Tokyo. Ryan also pitched for Team USA in the Olympic Qualifier Round in June. Team USA will also play a tune up game at the DBAP versus the Collegiate National Team on Monday, July 19 at 6:35pm. The U.S. Olympic Team begins the Olympic Games baseball tournament on Friday, July 30 versus Israel.

2021 SEASON: Earned the win in Triple-A debut on 5/5 at Memphis. Placed on Temporary Inactive List on 5/30 to pitch for Team USA Olympic Qualifying Team. Activated from Temporary Inactive List on 6/11.

2020 SEASON: Was part of the Rays 60-man player pool, spending the summer at the alternate training site in Port Charlotte. Ranked by Baseball America as the No. 12 prospect in the Rays system following the season.

2019 SEASON: Named Rays Minor League Pitcher of the Year by the Rays Baseball Operations department after combining for a 9-4 record and 1.96 ERA (123.2 IP) with 183 strikeouts in 24 appearances (22 starts) between Bowling Green (A), Charlotte (A+) and Montgomery (AA). Yielded 3 runs or fewer in all but 1 of his 24 appearances, 2 runs or fewer 19 times and 1 run or fewer 14 times. Finished 5th among Rays minor leaguers in ERA (min. 50 IP).

K-TIME: Ryan finished the 2019 season ranked 2nd among all minor league pitchers with 183 strikeouts. Only Royals prospect Kris Bubic (185) fanned more hitters than Ryan. Those 183 punchouts also ranked 3rd all-time for a Rays minor leaguer behind Matt Moore in 2011 (210) and 2010 (208). Ryan also finished T-6th in the Florida State League in strikeouts despite only throwing 82.2 innings.

YOU'RE THE BEST! AROUND! Ryan earned Rays Minor League Pitcher of the Year honors following the 2019 campaign. He also was named the organization's Pitcher of the Month for both July and August, going 2-0 with a 1.49 ERA (48.1 IP) and 75 strikeouts in 9 starts in that stretch. Ryan was also named an Organizational All-Star by MLB.com following the 2019 season, in addition to being tabbed the No. 10 prospect in the Florida State League by Baseball America.

2018 SEASON: Began his pro career with Hudson Valley (SS), posting a 2-1 record and 3.72 ERA (36.1 IP) in 12 outings (7 starts). Combined for 23 strikeouts in 13 innings over his final 3 starts of the year.

COLLEGE: Went 8-1 with a 1.65 ERA (98.1 IP) in 14 starts as a senior at California State University Stanislaus and led all of collegiate baseball with 127 strikeouts. Pitched 3 seasons at Cal State Northridge before transferring to Cal State Stanislaus.

MISCELLANEOUS: Previously selected by San Francisco in the 39th round of the 2014 MLB Draft out of Sir Francis Drake High School (CA) but did not sign.
