LAST ACTION: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Beloit Sky Carp 4-3 in ten innings Saturday afternoon at Neuroscience Group Field at Fox Cities Stadium. Joe Gray Jr. drove in the winning run with a sacrifice fly in the bottom of the tenth inning. Wisconsin rallied from deficits of 1-0, 2-1, and 3-2 to snap a fivegame losing streak. Saturday was Wisconsin's first win in a game decided by one run in 2023. It was also the first time Beloit lost a game decided by one run this

**THIS IS THE WAY:** The Timber Rattlers won for the first time this season when trailing after seven innings. Gray had a two-out, RBI single in the eighth to tie the game 2-2.

TALKING ABOUT THE TENTH: Beloit took a 3-2 lead in the top of the tenth on an RBI grounder by Yiddi Cappe. Wisconsin rallied in the bottom of the tenth on an RBI double by Micah Bello to score Je'Von Ward. Gray stepped in with the bases loaded and one out after Beloit elected to walk Alex Hall intentionally. Gray hit the first pitch he saw in the tenth deep enough to left to score Bello for the Rattlers first walkoff win of 2023. CROSSING THE PLATE: Ward scored three runs on game this season.

MISSED IT BY THAT MUCH: Sunday's game was rained out at Neuroscience Group Field at Fox Cities Stadium. It was the first rainout of the season for the Timber Rattlers. If Wisconsin had been able to play on Sunday, this season would have marked just the third time since 1995 Wisconsin would have made it through April without a home rainout. The other two seasons were 2005 and 2015.

ABOUT PEORIA: The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1958 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1957 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved to Peoria after the 1983 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels in 1984. They changed their name to the Chiefs and their affiliation to the Chicago Cubs for the 1985 season. They became a Cardinals affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. They made the Midwest League Championship Series in 2018 but lost to Bowling Green. Patrick Anderson is in his first year as Peoria's manager. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, and Yadier Molina.

ABOUT THE CARDINALS: St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling back in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to the league to affiliate with the Springfield, Illinois team from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first affiliation with Peoria from 1995 through 2004. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places five Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Eric Brown Jr (#8), Robert Moore (#10), Hendry Mendez (#15), Eduardo García (#21), and Joseph Hernandez (#28). MLB Pipeline has five active Peoria players on their list of Cardinals prospects: Cooper Hjerpe (#6), Jimmy Crooks (#15), Ian Bedell (#24), Dionys Rodriguez (#26), Victor Scott II (#27), and Zane Mills (#30). Tink Hence (#3), Austin Love (#19), and Inohan Paniagua (#17) are on Peoria's IL.

# PITCHING MATCHUP

#### WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP JOSEPH HERNANDEZ: Acquired by Milwaukee in a trade with the Seattle Mariners on January 7, 2023 in exchange for Justin Topa.

**FROM THE REPUBLIC:** The Mariners originally signed Hernandez as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic on July 2, 2017.

**TWO YEARS ON THE ISLAND:** Hernandez spent his 2018 and 2019 seasons with the Mariners affiliate in the Dominican Summer League. He was 3-2 with a save and a 4.62 ERA in fifteen games – six starts – in 2018 and went 0-1 in four relief appearances in 2019. He had 28 walks and 47 strikeouts over 45 innings pitched in the DSL.

BACK AT IT: Hernandez spent most of his 201 season with the Mariners affiliate in the Arizona Complex League. He was 4-0 with a 4.35 ERA in ten games – four starts – with 49 strikeouts over 31 innings. He also made one start for Arkansas, Seattle's Double-A affiliate in the Texas League that season.

**AWARD WINNING:** Hernandez was 9-5 with a 3.39 ERA in 24 games – 22 starts – for the Modesto Nuts, Seattle's affiliate in the California League in 2022. He had 143 strikeouts over 116-2/3 innings pitched and was named the California League Pitcher of the Year.

LAST START: Hernandez had a no decision on April 25 at home against Beloit in game one of this series. He allowed two runs on four hits with a walk and four strikeouts over six innings. Hernandez left with a 3-2 lead, but the Sky Carp rallied for a 4-3 win after he left the game.

VS. PEORIA: Hernandez lost to the <u>Chiefs at home on April 13</u>. He allowed three runs on four hits over four innings. Hernandez hit two batters, walked three, and struck out four.

### PEORIA SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP DIONYS RODRÍGUEZ: The Cardinals signed Rodríguez as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic in 2018.

**AND TO THE REPUBLIC:** Rodríguez pitched of the Dominican Summer League affiliate of the Cardinals in 2018 and 2019.

WILD PALMS: Rodríguez pitched for Palm Beach in 2021 and made 22 appearances – twelve starts – for the Cardinals that season. He was 4-5 with 22 walks, 88 strikeouts, and a 3.36 ERA in 69-2/3 innings pitched.

**LAST YEAR IN PEORIA:** Rodríguez was 3-11 with a 4.59 ERA in 27 games – 25 starts – for the Chiefs in 2022. He had 119 strikeouts over 121-2/3 innings last season.

**HOW DOES HE RATE?** MLB Pipeline has listed Rodríguez as the #26 prospect in the St. Louis system.

**LAST START:** Rodríguez had a <u>no decision at South Bend on April 26</u>. He allowed two hits, walked two, and struck out one in three scoreless innings.

VS. WISCONSIN (2022): Rodríguez went 1-1 in four starts against the Timber Rattlers last season. He had a no decision at Wisconsin in game two of a doubleheader on April 10, lost to the Rattlers at home on April 28, beat the Rattlers at Wisconsin on June 2, and had a no decision in Peoria on August 31 despite pitching five no-hit innings. Rodríguez allowed one run on twelve hits with nine walks and twenty strikeouts over 19 innings against Wisconsin in 2022.

VS. WISCONSIN (2023): Rodríguez made two relief appearances – <u>April 7</u> and <u>April 11</u> – at Wisconsin in the first series between the teams. He allowed one run on four hits with three walks and four strikeouts over six innings without a decision.
