ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS: The current franchise began its existence as the Cedar Rapids Braves, an affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves in the Three-I League, in 1958. That was the same year and league the current Timber Rattlers franchise joined the Three-I League as the Fox Cities Foxes. Both teams moved to the Midwest League when the Three-I League ended after the 1961 season. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels have made the Midwest League playoffs every year they have been affiliated with the Twins – including 2022. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, Trevor Hoffman, Brewers Pitching Coach Chris Hook, and Ted Simmons.

ABOUT THE TWINS: Minnesota has a long history of in the Midwest League. They started out with Wisconsin Rapids (1964-1983) and moved to Kenosha (1984-1992) and to Fort Wayne (1993-1998) as the franchise moved. Minnesota has also been with Quad Cities (1999-2004) and Beloit (2005-2012) before their current affiliation with

Cedar Rapids Kernels started in 2013.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline puts four active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Jackson Chourio (#1), Jeferson Quero (#7), Carlos F. Rodríguez (#19), and Eduardo García (#21). Tyler Black (#6), Russell Smith (#20), and Carlos D. Rodríguez (#22) are on the Wisconsin injured list. MLB Pipeline has two current Cedar Rapids players on their Top 30 list of Twins prospects: Brooks Lee (#1) and David Festa (#11). Sean Mooney (#20) is on the Kernels IL.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER (GAME TWO):

RHP ISRAEL PUELLO: Acquired by Milwaukee as a player to be named later from in a trade that sent David Phelps to the Philadelphia Phillies on August 31, 2020. Puello, Juan Geraldo, and Brandon Ramey were announced at the PTBNL on September 18, 2020.

ORIGIN STORY: Puello was signed by the Phillies out of the Dominican Republic on July 2, 2017.

FIGHTIN' PHIL: Puello pitched two seasons (2018 and 2019) for the Phillies White affiliate in the Dominican Summer League. He went 4-6 with a 4.52 ERA in fourteen starts in 2018 and 2-1 with a 1.92 ERA in fifteen starts in 2019. Puello had 143 strikeouts over 131-1/3 innings pitched. Puello was named a DSL All-Star in 2019.

WHAT'S BREWING? Puello was 1-4 with a 4.94 ERA in ten starts for the Brewers Gold affiliate in the Arizona Complex League in 2021. He walked nine and struck out 37 over 27-1/3 innings pitched.

SWEET CAROLINA: Puello was 3-7 in thirteen games – six starts – with a 5.51 ERA and 61 strikeouts over 49 innings pitched for the Carolina Mudcats before joining the Timber Rattlers on June 28. Puello was 0-2 in four games – two starts in June...BUT, he had a 3.38 ERA, opponents were hitting just .192 against him, and he had sixteen strikeouts over sixteen innings in June.

LAST START: Puello had a <u>no decision against South Bend at home on August 14</u>. He allowed three runs on two hits, over 3-1/3 innings. Puello walked six, struck out two, and gave up a home run.

VS. CEDAR RAPIDS (2022): Puello is 1-1 in two starts against the Kernels this season. He has allowed six runs on eight hits, including two home runs, with seven walks and twelve strikeouts over 9-1/3 innings. Both of Puello's starts against Cedar Rapids have been at Neuroscience Group Field.

CEDAR RAPIDS SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER (GAME TWO):

RHP DAVID FESTA: The Twins selected Festa in the 13th round of the 2021 draft out of Seton Hall University. Festa is the #11 prospect in Minnesota's system in the latest MLB Pipeline update.

I'M A PIRATE: Festa was 10-11 with a 3.49 ERA with 138 strikeouts over 139-1/3 innings pitched during his three seasons at Seton Hall. Festa was 6-4 with a 2.00 ERA in fifteen games – eleven starts – and earned First Team All-Big East honors in his final season with Seton Hall.

THE BEGINNING: Festa made four relief appearances in the Twins system after signing with Minnesota last season. He was 1-0 in two games in the Florida Complex League and had no record in two games with Fort Myers in the Florida State League. Festa had twelve strikeouts over 8-1/3 innings pitched as a pro last season.

BACK ON THE BEACH: Festa started this season the Fort Myers and went 2-1 with a 1.50 ERA in five starts. He walked six and struck out 33 over 24 innings. Festa pitched the first six innings of a combined no-hitter for the Mighty Mussels on May 10 against Palm Beach. He was transferred to Cedar Rapids on May 16.

IN THE CORN: Festa made six appearances – five starts – for the Gulf Complex League affiliate of the Twins this season. He had no record with an ERA of 1.20, three walks, and eighteen strikeouts over fifteen innings before getting called up to Cedar Rapids.

LAST START: Festa had a <u>no decision at Quad Cities on August 12</u>. He allowed three hits over three scoreless innings with three walks and three strikeouts.

VS. WISCONSIN: Festa is 2-0 in two relief appearances against the Timber Rattlers this season. He has allowed three runs on seven hits with three walks and ten strikeouts over 9-2/3 innings.
