ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Great Lakes Loons beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 3-0 at Dow Diamond.](#)

Jose Ramos hit a two-out, two-run home run in the first inning for the Loons. Kyle Hurt and Lael Lockhart combined to shutout the Rattlers on two hits. Last night was the third win in a row for Great Lakes.

JUSTIN TIME: Wisconsin starting pitcher Justin Jarvis allowed two runs on two hits with three walks and eleven strikeouts over six innings. Jarvis set a new single-game high as a professional in strikeouts. He has 26 strikeouts over nineteen innings in three starts this month. Jarvis is 2-1 with a 1.89 ERA in June.

NICK OF TIME: Wisconsin didn't have a hit until Wes Clarke came to start the top of the seventh inning. Wisconsin's other hit was a one-out single by Tristan Peters in the ninth inning.

IT HAPPENED AGAIN: Wisconsin has been shut out twice in this series and five times in fourteen games during the month of June. The Rattlers were shutout just twice in the first two months of the season.

TOUGH SLEDDING: The Rattlers are hitting .139 (17-for-122) in the first four games of the series with the Loons. In the three losses, Wisconsin has scored four runs, has struck out 47 times, and is 11-for-90 (.122).

A NOTE: The Rattlers have not lost four games in a row this season. They are currently on their fourth three-game losing streak.

ABOUT GREAT LAKES: The Great Lakes Loons came into existence in 2007 after the Midwest League team left Battle Creek at the end of the 2006 season. The team in Battle Creek had been known as the Michigan Battle Cats, Battle Creek Yankees, and the Southwest Michigan Devil Rays. The Loons have been affiliated with the Los Angeles Dodgers since 2007. They made the Midwest League playoffs seven times between 2007 and 2019. The Loons won the Midwest League title in 2016. Notable Great Lakes alumni include Clayton Kershaw, Kenley Jansen, Nathan Eovaldi, Joc Peterson, Julio Urias, Walker Buehler, and Gavin Lux.

ABOUT THE DODGERS: The Los Angeles Dodgers were only in the Midwest League for a few seasons prior to affiliating with the Loons. They were in Dubuque in 1967 and in Clinton from 1977 to 1979. Orel Hershiser and Steve Sax were notable Dodgers to play in Clinton.

GREAT LAKES IN 2021: The Loons went 63-57 and missed the playoffs. Great Lakes had an opportunity to make the playoffs in the final week of the season, but the Timber Rattlers won five of six games from the Loons at Dow Diamond to knock Great Lakes out of the playoff picture.

GREAT LAKES IN 2022: The Loons are in second place in the Eastern Division. They won the final five games in a series at first place Dayton prior to starting this series with Wisconsin to cut the deficit from 8-1/2 games to 3-1/2 games. They are now 2-1/2 games out of first.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: [MLB Pipeline](#) puts six active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Tyler Black (#6), Joe Gray Jr. (#13), Antoine Kelly (#14), Russell Smith (#16), Xavier Warren (#17), and Cam Robinson (#26). Carlos Rodriguez (#21) is on the Wisconsin injured list. [MLB Pipeline](#) has seven current Loons on their list of Dodgers prospects: Diego Cartaya (#1), Eddys Leonard (#8), Jorbit Vivas (#9), Nick Nastrini (#13), Jose Ramos (#14), Carlos Duran (#16), and Alex De Jesus (#20). Hyun-il Choi (#28) is on the Great Lakes Injured List.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP JAMES MEEKER: Signed by Milwaukee as a Minor League Free Agent off the Washington Wild Things of the Frontier League on August 13, 2021.

WHAT A LONG STRANGE TRIP IT'S BEEN: Meeker began his college career at the University of Akron and transferred to the University of Delaware after Akron dropped its baseball program. He signed with the Washington Wild Things in 2018 and pitched for them in 2018, 2019, and 2021. In 2020, Meeker pitched for the Steel City Slammin' Sammys, also based in Washington, Pennsylvania.

WHAT IN THE BLUE HEN? Meeker went 4-2 with six saves in 26 games – one start – at Delaware in 2018. He had 45 strikeouts over 53 innings pitched in his final season of college baseball.

TO THE FRONTIER: Meeker made 89 relief appearances with the Wild Things over 2-1/2 seasons in the Frontier League. He was 5-4 with a save and 126 strikeouts over 115-1/3 innings.

ON TO CAROLINA: Meeker was assigned to the Carolina Mudcats after signing with Milwaukee. He was 1-2 with five saves in twelve appearances with 22 strikeouts over eighteen innings.

LAST START: Meeker made the [start for Delaware against Bryant on March 18, 2018 and had a no decision](#). He allowed five runs on twelve hits with no walks and four strikeouts over five innings. Meeker has made 125 relief appearances as a professional without a start prior to this evening.

VS. GREAT LAKES: Meeker pitched [three innings in relief against the Loons on June 14 and picked up the win](#). He allowed no runs on two hits with no walks and four strikeouts.

GREAT LAKES SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP KENDALL WILLIAMS: Acquired by the Los Angeles Dodgers in a trade with the Toronto Blue Jays on September 1, 2020. The Blue Jays received Ross Stripling in exchange for Ryan Noda and Williams.

ORIGIN STORY: Toronto selected Williams in the second round of the 2019 draft out of the IMG Academy. The Blue Jays used the 52nd overall pick in that draft to take Williams.

ON THE COAST: Williams appeared in six games – five starts – for Toronto's Gulf Coast League affiliate after signing with the Blue Jays in 2019. He had no record, allowed two earned runs, and struck out nineteen over sixteen innings in the GCL.

FEEL THE EARTH MOVE: Williams was 3-3 with a save and a 4.53 ERA in 23 games – nineteen starts – for the Rancho Cucamonga Quakes last season. He had 87 strikeouts and 22 walks in 93-1/3 innings pitched.

BACK AT IT: Williams started this season back with Rancho Cucamonga and was 0-1 in four starts before joining the Loons on April 27, 2022.

LAST START: Williams had [a no decision at Dayton on June 12](#). He allowed one hit and struck out eight in three scoreless innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Williams has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. This is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
