ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Beloit Sky Carp 9-3 at ABC Supply Stadium.](#)

Wande Torres pitched seven innings, struck out eight, and picked up the win. Wisconsin rallied from a 3-2 deficit with a game-tying RBI triple by Luis Peña in the fifth, a go-ahead RBI single by Luiyin Alastre in the sixth, and a five-run ninth inning. Braylon Payne went 2-for-4 with a homer and three runs scored, Daniel Dickinson stole four bases, and Luis Castillo hit a grand slam in the ninth inning for the Timber Rattlers. Daniel Corniel pitched two scoreless innings for the save.

SEVENTH HEAVEN: Torres pitched seven innings in a game for the third time this season with his performance last night. Torres is tied with Samuel Dutton of the Lansing Lugnuts for the Midwest League lead in innings (96.1). Torres has 101 strikeouts this season and is fourth in the league in that category.

A RUN AT HISTORY: Payne tied the single season record for homers with his first inning blast last night. He has 22 home runs this season and has joined Khris Davis (2010), Victor Roache (2013), and Clint Coulter (2014) in a four-way tie for the franchise record.

STAY HOT: Castillo went 1-for-4 last night. His ninth inning grand slam extended his current hitting streak to nine games (14-for-37; .378) during the streak. Castillo has also driven in at least one run in five straight games with a total of thirteen.

SLAMTOWN: Castillo's grand slam was his second of the season. It was the Rattlers sixth slam of the season. The team record for grand slams in a season is seven and was set by the 2014 Rattlers. The individual record for grand slams is three and was set by Taylor Brennan during the 2014 season.

MULTI-BALL: Peña, Payne, Dickinson, and Yannic Walther all had multi-hit games for the Rattlers last night. Walther went 3-for-5 for his first three-hit game as a Rattler. Payne leads the team with 26 multi-hit games in 2026.

ABOUT BELOIT: The Beloit Sky Carp changed their name from Snappers after the 2021 season. This is Beloit's fifth season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019). The Snappers played their final game at Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3, 2021. Angel Espada is in his second season as the manager of the Sky Carp. Bill Hall, Prince Fielder, Rickie Weeks, Chris Bosio, Greg Vaughn, Joey Meyer, BJ Surhoff, Tim Lillard, Mitch Stetter, Matt Chapman, and Matt Olson played in Beloit.

ABOUT THE MARLINS: The Florida/Miami Marlins have lots of history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan. The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for 2021.

STARTING PITCHERS

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

LHP J.D. THOMPSON: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Thompson in the second round of the 2025 draft out of Vanderbilt University.

SAIL AWAY: Thompson pitched three seasons for the Commodores. He was 13-7 with a 4.28 ERA in 43 games – 29 starts – and struck out 219 over 164 innings. Thompson made sixteen starts in his final season at Vanderbilt with a 6-5 record, a 4.00 ERA, and 122 strikeouts in 90 innings with just thirty walks.

SUMMERS IN NEW ENGLAND: Thompson pitched for Newport in the New England Collegiate Baseball League in 2023 and for Bourne in the Cape Cod League in 2024.

HOW DOES HE RATE? Thompson is currently rated at #25 in the Brewers system by MLB Pipeline. *Baseball America* has him at #21 after its latest update.

LET'S GO! Thompson did not pitch professionally in the Brewers system after signing with Milwaukee. His final collegiate appearance was a win against Wright State on [May 30, 2025](#) in the Nashville Regional of the 2025 NCAA Baseball Tournament. He struck out twelve, walked one, and gave up three runs on five hits over eight innings. Thompson made his pro debut as a starter for the Timber Rattlers on [May 2, 2026](#).

LAST START: Thompson was not involved in the decision against Lansing at home on [July 29](#). He walked one and struck out five over four hitless, scoreless innings.

VS. БЕЛОИТ: Thompson has never pitched against the Sky Carp before this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will face an affiliate of the Miami Marlins.

БЕЛОИТ STARTING PITCHER:

LHP BRAYAN MENDOZA: The Miami Marlins acquired Mendoza in a trade with the Texas Rangers on December 11, 2024. The Marlins sent Jake Burger to the Rangers for Echedry Vargas, Max Acosta, and Mendoza.

ORIGIN STORY: Mendoza signed with the Rangers as an International Draft out of Venezuela on January 18, 2021. He pitched in the Dominican Summer League, Arizona Complex League, Carolina League (Down East), and South Atlantic League (Hickory) in the Rangers system.

LAST YEAR: Mendoza spent his first year in the Marlins system with the Beloit Sky Carp. He appeared in 22 games – four starts – with a 6-5 record, a save, and an ERA of 5.18. He walked 42 and struck out 73 over 80 innings with Beloit last season.

LAST START: Mendoza was the winning pitcher at West Michigan on [July 29](#). He allowed a run on three hits with no walks and five strikeouts over six innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Mendoza is 0-2 in two games – one start – against the Timber Rattlers this season. He took the loss in game two of a doubleheader on [April 4](#) as a reliever and on [July 12](#) as a starter. Both games were at Neuroscience Group Field. Mendoza has allowed seven runs – six earned – on two hits and eight walks with ten strikeouts over five innings against the Rattlers this season. He was also was 1-1 in three relief appearances against Wisconsin in 2025.
