He allowed three runs on five hits in the first inning, retired nine in a row after Peoria's final hit of the first, and struck out three. Brandon Woodruff is set to make his third rehab start of the season for the Rattlers today.

Hedbert Pérez also extended his current hitting streak to nine games (13-for-33, .394) with a single in the eighth inning.

ANTHONY! Rattlers reliever Anthony Flores earned his first Midwest League win last night. He pitched four innings in relief, allowed one run on two hits and four walks with a strikeout. Flores has pitched four innings as a reliever twice this season.

BRIDGING THE GAP: Jesús Broca took the ball to pitch the top of the fifth inning for the Rattlers. He pitched a perfect inning for his second consecutive scoreless outing.

ABOUT PEORIA: The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1958 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1957 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved to Peoria after the 1982 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels for 1983 and 1984 with a change to the Chiefs nickname for 1984 followed by an affiliation switch to the Chicago Cubs for the 1985 season. Peoria became the Cardinals Midwest League affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. They made the Midwest League Championship Series in 2018 but lost to Bowling Green. Patrick Anderson is in his third year as Peoria's manager. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, Yadier Molina, Nolan Gorman, and Victor Scott II.

ABOUT THE CARDINALS: St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling back in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to the league to affiliate with the Springfield, Illinois team from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first affiliation with Peoria from 1995 through 2004. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP BRANDON WOODRUFF: Selected by Milwaukee in the eleventh round of the 2014 draft out of Mississippi State.

ON ASSIGNMENT: Woodruff is making his third rehab start for the Timber Rattlers this season. He made starts against Lansing on [April 18](#) and West Michigan [April 30](#). Woodruff also made two starts for Wisconsin in 2023 – [July 22 at Dayton](#) and [July 27 against Cedar Rapids](#) at Neuroscience Group Field.

THREE YEARS AT STATE: Woodruff pitched three seasons with Mississippi State and was 3-6 with a 4.70 ERA and 81 strikeouts over 90 innings pitched in 34 games – eighteen starts – in college.

SKIPPED US: Woodruff started his professional career in the Pioneer League with the Helena Brewers in 2014 and moved to Brevard County in the Florida State League in 2015 without playing for the Timber Rattlers.

MAKING MOVES: Woodruff went 4-1 with a 1.83 ERA in Brevard County before a promotion to Biloxi in the Southern League where he went 10-8 with 124 strikeouts and a 3.01 ERA in 113-2/3 innings during the 2016 season.

MLB DEBUT: Woodruff started the 2017 season with Colorado Springs in Triple-A before making his Major League debut with the [Brewers on August 4, against the Tampa Bay Rays](#). Woodruff was the winning pitcher in that debut with six strikeouts over 6-1/3 scoreless innings.

LAST BREWERS START: Woodruff had a no decision at Miami on [September 23, 2023](#). He allowed four runs on six hit with two walks and six strikeouts over five innings.

LAST START: Woodruff had a no decision for Nashville against Scranton/Wilkes-Barre in the first game of a doubleheader on [May 21](#). He allowed three hits with two walks and two strikeouts over four scoreless innings.

PEORIA STARTING PITCHER:

RHP HANCEL RINCON: The St. Louis Cardinals signed Rincon as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic on January 26, 2019.

CLIMBING THE LADDER: Rincon spent 2019 and 2021 with the Cardinals Dominican Summer League affiliate. He split time between the Florida Complex League Cardinals and the Palm Beach Cardinals in 2022, all 2023 with Palm Beach in the Florida State League, and last season in Peoria.

LIFE AMONG THE PALMS IN 2023: Rincon was 9-6 with a 3.26 ERA for Palm Beach last season. He made 24 appearances – 23 starts - while walking 20 and striking out 97 over 132-2/3 innings pitched. Rincon led the Florida State League in innings (132-2/3), WHIP (0.97), and opponent batting average (.219) in 2023.

STARS AND AWARDS: The Cardinals named Rincon their Minor League Pitcher of the Month for May 2023. He was also named a Postseason All-Star for the Florida State League by Minor League Baseball.

CHIEFLY: Rincon was 9-7 with a 3.80 ERA in 24 starts for Peoria last season. He had 105 strikeouts and 48 walk in 132-2/3 innings.

LAST START: Rincon had a no decision at home against Dayton on [May 21](#). He allowed two runs on five hits with two walks and six strikeouts over 5-2/3 innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Rincon had a no decision at Dozer Park against the Rattlers on [May 8](#) with two runs on six hits with a walk and six strikeouts over 5-1/3 innings. In 2024, Rincon was 0-1 in three starts – [April 6](#), [April 26](#), and [August 16](#) – against the Timber Rattlers. He allowed nine runs on seventeen hits and five walks with seven strikeouts over 12-2/3 innings last year. Wisconsin hit three homers off Rincon on April 26, 2024.
