Game 96 of 120 – Sunday, August 22, 2021 – 2:05pm CT – Perfect Game Field at Veterans Memorial Stadium (5,300)

TODAY'S MATCHUP: The Cedar Rapids Kernels finish a six-game series with the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers...Cedar Rapids leads the season series by a 10-7 margin including a 4-1 advantage in this week's homestand...The Kernels added left-handed relief pitcher Aaron Rozek to the roster ahead of the series finale which will feature right-hander Ryan Shreve making his first start of the entire season

LAST TIME OUT: Wisconsin defeated Cedar Rapids, 12-5, Saturday...The Timber Rattlers never trailed and finished their offensive outburst with a six-run ninth inning...Former Iowa Hawkeye Brady Schanuel was the winning pitcher for Wisconsin in relief...The Kernels hosted a near-season-high 3,439 fans at Perfect Game Field at Veterans Memorial Stadium for the contest

"DINGERS! DINGERS!": The Kernels have 117 home runs this year and sit in a tie with the 2004 club for the Kernels-era (1993 to present) single-season home run record...Matt Wallner and Michael Helman added the latest round-trippers with solo shots Saturday...Cedar Rapids is averaging 1.23 homers per game which would be the best single-season average in franchise history

TOP OF THE LIST: Edouard Julien tops Minor League Baseball in walks with Wander Javier tied for first in triples...Julien, who has been the outright leader in free passes dating back to June 20, has 88 bases on balls between Cedar Rapids and Low-A Fort Myers...Javier was the first Minor League Baseball hitter to get to double digits in triples and is in a three-way tie for first with 10 three-baggers this year

KERNELS OF WISDOM: The Kernels pace High-A Central teams and rank second among all Minor League Baseball teams with 1,043 total strikeouts (High-A Hudson Valley Renegades lead MiLB with 1,048 strikeouts)...Edouard Julien's 18-game on-base streak is tied for the longest Cedar Rapids streak this year...Yunior Severino has reached safely in 13 games starting with a career-high 12-game hit streak

CHAMPIONSHIP CHASE: Minor League Baseball has announced 2021 postseason schedules for all full-season minor leagues...A best-of-five High-A Central championship series will be played beginning September 21st...The qualifiers will be the top two teams in the league based on overall win percentage...Cedar Rapids currently holds a two-game advantage within the race for second place

2019 IN REVIEW: In its last season, Cedar Rapids made a run to the 2019 Midwest League semifinals...The Kernels qualified as the Western Division First-Half Wild Card after rallying from 6.5 games of that spot in the standings...Cedar Rapids recorded 1,240 strikeouts to set a new franchise single-season record...It was also the final season for the Kernels in the Midwest League and as a "Low-A" affiliate

"TWIN" STREAK: Cedar Rapids put together a city-record seven-year postseason streak throughout its time as a Minnesota Twins affiliate in the Midwest League (2013-19)...The Kernels were the league's first team to earn seven playoffs bids in a row since the 2009-15 Fort Wayne TinCaps and the first franchise to qualify for the semifinals in at least six consecutive seasons since the 1975-81 Waterloo Royals/Indians

HEYYYYY KERNELS: 2021 marks the 29th year of the Cedar Rapids Kernels...A "Name The Team" contest in the fall of 1992 drew over 650 entries including four for "Kernels"...Six-year-old Matthew Antonitis won the contest via random drawing...Previous nicknames are: **Canaries** (1890-91), **Rabbits** (1896-99, 1901-03), **Bunnies** (1904-09, 1913-17, 1920-32), **Raiders** (1934-42, 1955-57), **Rockets** (1949), **Indians** (1950-54), **Braves** (1958-62), **Red Raiders** (1963-64), **Cardinals** (1965-72), **Astros** (1973-74), **Giants** (1975-79), and **Reds** (1980-92)...Cedar Rapids has also won 13 league championships: **Western Association** (1897), **Three-I League** (1906, 1940-42, 1958), **Mississippi Valley League** (1922, 1925, 1930), **Western League** (1937), and **Midwest League** (1988, 1992, 1994)
