INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Matt Fraizer's go-ahead RBI single in the eighth inning propelled the Indianapolis Indians to a 5-4 comeback victory over the Nashville Sounds on Friday night at Victory Field. Trailing, 4-3, entering the eighth inning, the Indians rallied for a pair of runs to reclaim the lead. After Craig Yoho recorded the first two outs of the inning, Brett Sullivan sparked the comeback with a walk and steal of second base. Tsung-Che Cheng knotted the game, 4-4, with an RBI single to bring home Sullivan and subsequently advanced to second base on a fielding error by Eddie Rosario. Fraizer then blooped a ball into left-center to put the Indians ahead, 5-4. Indianapolis opened the game with a trio of unanswered runs for an early advantage over the Sounds. Fraizer scored on a wild pitch in the first inning, DJ Stewart socked a solo homer in the fourth and Nick Yorke doubled home a run in the fifth frame. Nashville chipped away with a run in the sixth inning and Jorge Alfaro delivered them a 4-3 advantage with a three-run, go-ahead homer off Burch Smith in the eighth frame. Indy stormed back against Craig Yoho in the bottom half of the inning on Cheng's single and Fraizer's go-ahead hit. Kyle Nicolas pitched a perfect ninth inning with one strikeout to seal victory for the Indians. Starter Bubba Chandler tossed 5.0 shutout innings in the win, allowing just four hits and one walk with eight strikeouts.

CARDIAC KIDS: The Indians moved to 17-7 in one-run games and picked up their 14th comeback win of the season with last night's 5-4 victory. The Indians 14 comebacks are their most to this point in the season since they totaled 15 through 53 games in 2019. Indians hitters lead International League teams with a .290 batting average in tie games and rank fourth among International League teams with a .264 batting average in games where they are trailing or tied.

CAN'T TOUCH CHANDLER: Bubba Chandler tossed his fifth scoreless start and his fourth start of eight or more strikeouts this season last night. Chandler lowered his season ERA to 2.03 (11er/48.2ip) and has now held opponents to a .181 batting average (31-for-171) and a .540 OPS, ranking second among qualified Triple-A pitchers in each category. He also ranks second in strikeouts per nine innings (12.76, 69 K) while having the third-most strikeouts among Triple-A pitchers. Chandler has allowed four or fewer hits in nine of his 11 starts this season, good for the second-fewest hits allowed of any qualified Triple-A starter. Chandler also lowered his career ERA with the Indians to 1.94 (19er/88.0ip), surpassing Tyler Glasnow for the lowest ERA by an Indians pitcher with at least 80.0 innings pitched since 2005. Additionally, he leads Indians pitchers since 2005 in opponent OPS (.537) and strikeouts per nine (12.58, 123 K/88.0ip).

VICTORY FIELD (LITERALLY): With last night's win, Indy improved to 20-7 at home, tying Lehigh Valley for the best home winning percentage (.741) in Triple-A this season and the seventh best in full-season Minor League Baseball. Since April 16, the Indians are 18-3 at home, good for a .857 winning percentage that paces all Triple-A teams and trails only High-A Brooklyn (14-2, .875) for the highest winning percentage among all minor league teams in that stretch. In May, they have a .813 winning percentage (13-3) at Victory Field, which is tied with June 2010 (13-3) and May 2012 (13-3) for their highest winning percentage in a month (min. 7 games) since 2005.

WHO COOKED HERE: Billy Cook went 2-for-5 on Thursday to extend his active hitting streak to six games dating back to May 23 at Toledo. Cook has started each of his last five games in the leadoff spot since May 24 and has hit leadoff in eight games this season, recording a hit in each contest and reaching base safely multiple times in six of eight. While leading off this season, Cook is hitting .333 (10-for-30) with three doubles and a .877 OPS. Cook has also hit well against the Sounds since his Triple-A debut in 2024, ranking third among opponents with at least 50 plate appearances in on-base percentage (.423) and fourth in OPS (.949).

NEW YORK(E) STATE OF MIND: Nick Yorke went 2-for-3 with an RBI double last night to continue his hot stretch in May. He has hit safely in 19 of 23 games in the month and has picked up multiple hits in seven. In May, he leads qualified Indians hitters in batting average (.321, 27-for-84), hits, OPS (.781), total bases (36) and stolen bases (5). Yorke has recorded a hit in nine of 10 career games against the Sounds, leading Nashville opponents since the beginning of 2024 (min. 30 PA) in batting average (.394, 13-for-33) and ranking second in on-base percentage (.474).

PITCHER'S DUEL: In May, Indians pitchers lead Triple-A in strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.08, 265 K/86 BB) and strikeouts per nine innings (10.96), are tied for the most strikeouts (265) and rank second in ERA (3.46, 84er/218.1ip), WHIP (1.23), opponent batting average (.225) and OPS (.668). They have also allowed the fewest hits (182) and the fourth-fewest walks (86) in May. Indy's bullpen has a 2.52 ERA (28er/100.0ip) with a 1.10 WHIP and a .605 opponent OPS in the month, all of which lead Triple-A teams. On the flip side, Nashville's staff has been dominant all season, leading Triple-A pitching staffs with a 3.24 ERA (168er/466.2ip) while holding the second-lowest opponent OPS (.655) and the third-lowest WHIP (1.26). Nashville's bullpen has pitched to a Triple-A leading 3.04 ERA (74er/219.1ip) so far this season, far surpassing Jacksonville's 3.46 ERA (99er/257.1ip), which is the second-lowest ERA by a Triple-A bullpen.

PAIR O' PIRATES: The Indians roster boasts two major league rehabbers in Nick Gonzales and Dauri Moreta. Gonzales has picked up a hit in each of his last four games, including three in last night's contest. Across those games, he's hitting .389 (7-for-18) with three runs scored, a triple, an RBI and a .868 OPS. He was placed on the 10-day injured list on March 28 with a non-displaced left ankle fracture, sustained after hitting a two-run home run in the sixth inning on Opening Day at Miami. Moreta was placed on the 60-day injured list on Feb. 16 after undergoing Tommy John surgery and being sidelined for the entire 2024 season. Nearly 14 months after his last professional appearance, the right-hander began a rehab assignment with High-A Bradenton on April 29 and tossed 2.0 scoreless innings in two games. He has since pitched to a 2.25 ERA (2er/8.0ip) with Indy, allowing five hits while striking out 11 across his nine appearances.

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP: Indianapolis looks to clinch its fourth-straight series win at home tonight against Nashville at 6:35 PM. The series win would be Indy's first against Nashville since the two teams resumed play against each other in 2021. Southpaw Hunter Barco will take the bump for Indy for the first time since May 15 vs. Louisville. In that start, his second in Triple-A, he was removed from the game after recording one out and was placed on the seven-day injured list with a muscle strain in his left shoulder on May 17. He will face off against Nashville's 6'7" righty Jacob Misiorowski. Misiorowski duelled with Indians' starter Po-Yu Chen on Monday and took the loss, allowing two runs, one earned, and striking out eight. He has not allowed more than one earned run in each of his last seven starts and in 10 of his 11 appearances (10 starts) on the season. He leads qualified Triple-A pitchers this season in ERA (1.60, 10er/56.1ip), opponent batting average (.169, 33-for-195), and WHIP (1.07) and ranks second in strikeouts (71).

ON THIS DATE IN 2016: Jacob Stallings set a single-game Victory Field record with seven RBI in the Indians' 9-3 win vs. Rochester. The catcher went 4-for-4 with a solo home run, three-run double, RBI triple and another home run to drive in two. Stallings had his contract selected by Pittsburgh just a few weeks later and made his major league debut on June 19.

TONIGHT'S PITCHER

Hunter Barco: The southpaw ranks as Pittsburgh's No. 5 prospect and Minor League Baseball's No. 93 overall prospect according to MLB Pipeline.

Historic Zeroes: Barco did not allow a run in his six starts with Double-A Altoona, totaling 25.2 consecutive scoreless innings to begin the season, marking the longest scoreless streak in Curve history.

Last Outing: Barco was pulled after recording one out against Louisville on May 15, and was tagged for two earned runs. He was placed on the seven-day injured list on May 17 with a mild muscle strain in his left shoulder.

Against the Sounds: Tonight marks Barco's first career start against the Sounds.

EAS Pitcher of the Month: Barco was awarded the 2025 Eastern League April Pitcher of the Month Award after leading the league (min. 20ip) in ERA (0.00, 20.2ip) and batting average against (.132, 9-for-68), while ranking second in WHIP (0.63) and tied for fourth in strikeouts (30).

Mowing Them Down: Barco finished his award-winning April with back-to-back eight-strikeout starts, the last of which came in just 3.0 innings of work on April 27 at Double-A Chesapeake. He became the first Pirates full-season farmhand to strike out eight or more batters in 3.0 innings or less since Osvaldo Bido also struck out eight in 3.0 innings vs. Triple-A Louisville on Aug. 4th, 2022.

Miscellaneous: Barco was selected by the Pirates in the second round (44th overall) of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Florida (Gainesville).
