ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Cedar Rapids Kernels beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 13-2. Anthony Prato had four hits, scored three runs, and drove in two runs for Cedar Rapids. Prato was missing only a home run for

DOWN EARLY: The Kernels built an 11-0 lead with three runs in the second, three runs in the third, two runs in the fourth, and three runs in the fifth. In the second inning, Cedar Rapids had a runner at second with two outs and two strikes on Kyler Fedko. Then, Fedko had an RBI single. Will Holland followed with a single, and Prato tripled in both runners for a 3-0 lead.

OUT OF CONTROL: Wisconsin pitchers matched their season high for walks in a game with ten free passes issued to the Kernels last night. There was also a hit batsman and the defense committed two errors.

POSITION PLAYER PITCHING: Infielder Ashton McGee was called to the mound for the bottom of the eighth inning. McGee allowed three hits, including a two-run home run to Christian Encarnacion-Strand.

A WORD ABOUT THE OFFENSE: Wes Clarke and Carlos Rodríguez each had two hits for Wisconsin. Clarke had a hand in both of Wisconsin's runs. He doubled and scored on a double by Rodríguez in the seventh inning. In the top of the eighth, Clarke doubled to drive in Tristan Peters. Clarke leads Wisconsin in RBI with 26.

MULTIBALL: Rodríguez has eight multi-hit games this season. He is tied for second on the team in multi-hit games. Zavier Warren leads the team with ten multi-hit games.

ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS: The current franchise began its existence as the Cedar Rapids Braves, an affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves in the Three-I League, in 1958. That was the same year and league the current Timber Rattlers franchise joined the Three-I League as the Fox Cities Foxes. Both teams moved to the Midwest League when the Three-I League ended after the 1961 season. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels have made the Midwest League playoffs every year they have been affiliated with the Twins. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, Trevor Hoffman, Brewers Pitching Coach Chris Hook, and Ted Simmons

ABOUT THE TWINS: Minnesota has a long history of in the Midwest League. They started out with Wisconsin Rapids (1964-1983) and moved to Kenosha (1984-1992) and to Fort Wayne (1993-1998) as the franchise moved. Minnesota has also been with Quad Cities (1999-2004) and Beloit (2005-2012) before their current affiliation with Cedar Rapids Kernels started in 2013.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline puts seven Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Tyler Black (#6), Joe Gray Jr. (#13), Antoine Kelly (#14), Russell Smith (#16), Zavier Warren (#17), Carlos Rodríguez (#21), and Cam Robinson (#26). PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP JUSTIN JARVIS: Selected by Milwaukee in the 5th round of the 2018 draft out of Lake Norman High School in Mooresville, North Carolina.

THE SENIOR SEASON: In his final season of high school, Jarvis was 8-2 with a 1.60ERA, and 95 strikeouts. Former Major Leaguer Ty Wigginton was his head coach.

A PERFECT DAY: Jarvis pitched a perfect game with 18 strikeouts in a game against East Rowan High School early in his senior season of high school

NOT ON CAMPUS: Jarvis signed with the Brewers over a commitment to UNC-Wilmington.

YEAR ONE: Jarvis was 1-2 with a 6.63ERA in ten games – three starts – for Milwaukee's Arizona League affiliate after signing with Milwaukee. He walked four and struck out 18 over 19 innings pitched in the Arizona League.

2019: Jarvis was 4-1 with a 3.50 ERA in 18 games – eleven starts – for the Timber Rattlers in 2019. He had 52 strikeouts over 74-2/3 innings.

2021: Jarvis was 1-7 with a 5.40 ERA in seventeen starts for the Timber Rattlers in 2021. He had 62 strikeouts over 63-1/3 innings.

LAST START: Jarvis had a <u>no decision against South Bend at home on May 19</u>. He allowed two runs – one earned – on four hits with two walks and ten strikeouts over six innings.

VS. CEDAR RAPIDS (2021): Jarvis was 0-1 in three starts against the Kernels last season. He allowed nine runs on twelve hits with five walks and ten strikeouts over 11-2/3 innings. Cedar Rapids hit five homers off Jarvis in 2021.

CEDAR RAPIDS SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

LHP CADE POVICH: The Minnesota Twins selected Povich in the third round of the 20-21 draft out of Nebraska. MLB Pipeline rates Povich as the #26 prospect in the Minnesota minor league system.

SOUTHWEST: Povich pitched a season at South Mountain Community College in Phoenix, Arizona and was 10-1 with a 1.52 ERA. He had eight complete games and pitched five shutouts.

HUSKY: Povich transferred to Nebraska for the 2020 season and made four appearances before the shutdown. He was a First Team All-Big Ten selection in 2021 after he went 6-1 in fifteen starts. Povich had 88 strikeouts over 81 innings during his final season at Nebraska.

STARTING OUT: Povich pitched in the Florida Complex League and for Fort Myers after signing with the Twins. He had no record and allowed one earned run over ten innings in four games – three starts in those two levels.

LAST START: Povich beat Lake County at home on May 19. He allowed two hits, walked one, and struck out five over 5-1/3 scoreless innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Povich has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this afternoon. This is also the first time he will face an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
