**LAST ACTION:** [The Peoria Chiefs beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 2-0 at Dozer Park on Sunday.](#) The Chiefs had just four hits in the game, but they broke a scoreless tie with three hits to score a run in the bottom of the fifth and added a run on a home run by Moises Castillo in the top of the sixth.

**ODYSSEY OF HOMERS:** In 24 games between Wisconsin and Peoria this season, the teams combined for 56 home runs. The Chiefs have hit 33 and the Rattlers have hit 23. Peoria had at least one homer in the last eleven games of the series and in ten straight games against Wisconsin at Dozer Park.

**A MONTH APART:** Wisconsin was shutout for just the third time this season when they were held off the scoreboard on Sunday at Peoria. The last time the Rattlers were shutout this season prior to Sunday was on June 18 when they lost 9-0 to Quad Cities in a no-hitter.

**MAKING HAY:** Hayden Cantrelle was 2-for-4 on Sunday. He is currently on a five-game hitting streak (7-for-17, .412). Cantrelle has also scored five runs, walked five times, and compiled a 1.051 OPS during the streak.

**WELCOME HOME:** Wisconsin is starting a twelve-game homestand today. They have the Cubs for six games starting tonight. The Cedar Rapids Kernels are in town for six more games starting next Tuesday. Wisconsin is 16-14 at home this season. In the Western Division standings, The Kernels are in second place, the Rattlers are third, and the Cubs are fourth.

**PLAYOFF UPDATE:** The teams with the top two records in the High-A Central League will qualify for the playoffs at the end of the season. Currently, Quad Cities (43-21) and Dayton (36-29) are the top two teams. Great Lakes, Lake County, and Cedar Rapids are all just a half-game behind Dayton. The Rattlers are five games out of a playoff spot right now.

**ABOUT SOUTH BEND:** The South Bend Cubs started as the South Bend White Sox when the Midwest League added them as an expansion team in 1988. They changed their name to the Silver Hawks for the 1994 season and became an affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks in 1997. South Bend became an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs. South Bend won Midwest League pennants in 1989, 1993, 2005, and 2019. Notable alumni for the South Bend franchise include Justin Upton, Gleyber Torres, Ian Happ, and Carlos Gonzalez. Terry Franco was the manager of the South Bend White Sox in 1982.

**ABOUT THE CUBS:** The Chicago Cubs had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in South Bend in 2015. They were affiliated with Quad Cities from 1979 through 1984, Peoria from 1985 through 1994 and again from 2005 through 2012, Rockford from 1995 through 1998, Lansing from 1999 through 2004, Kane County in 2013 and 2014.

**PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES:** [MLB Pipeline](#) puts six Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Carlos Rodríguez (#14), Hayden Cantrelle (#16), Nick Kahle (#20), Thomas Dillard (#22), Dylan File (#26), and David Hamilton (#27). [MLB Pipeline](#) has three current South Bend players on their list of Chicago Cubs prospects: Ryan Jensen (#8) and Burl Carraway (#17), and Bryce Ball (#29). Cole Roederer (#12) is on the injured list.

### 2005 MWL CHAMPIONSHIP SERIES:

**GAME 1 (9/13 @SB):** [Silver Hawks 6, Wisconsin 4](#)  
Mark Reynolds and Emilio Bonifacio homered in the second inning to break a 1-1 tie and Kellen Raab scattered nine hits over five innings while allowing three runs – two earned – for the win.

**GAME 2 (9/14 @SB):** [Silver Hawks 4, Wisconsin 1](#)  
South Bend broke a 1-1 tie with three runs in the bottom of the eighth inning. Orlando Mercado drove in the tie-breaking run.

**GAME 3 (9/15 @WIS):** [Wisconsin 1, South Bend 0](#)  
Robert Rohrbaugh pitched eight scoreless innings and Chris Colton drew a bases-loaded walk in the bottom of the eighth to drive in the only run of the game.

**GAME 4 (9/16 @WIS):** [Wisconsin 11, South Bend 6](#)  
Mike Wilson homered, drove in three runs, and scored three runs to lead Wisconsin and force Game Five.

**GAME 5 (9/17 @WIS):** [South Bend 4, Wisconsin 0](#)  
Cesar Nicolas hit a two-run homer in the top of the seventh to break a scoreless tie. The Rattlers had five hits.

## WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP REESE OLSON:** Selected by Milwaukee in the 13<sup>th</sup> round of the 2018 draft out of North Hall High School in Gainesville, Georgia.

**NOT GOING TO GET TECHNICAL:** Olson signed with the Brewers over a scholarship to Georgia Tech.

**MY OLD SCHOOL:** Olson was a junior when North Hall High School won the Georgia State 3A Baseball Championship in 2017. The Bulldogs made the state playoffs again in 2018.

**DESERT DEBUT:** Olson went 0-2 with a 5.23 ERA in four games – two starts – for the AZL Brewers in 2018. He walked four and struck out six in 10-1/3 innings pitched.

**FIRST PRO WIN:** Olson came on in relief at Lansing on May 1 after the April 30 game had been suspended at Cooley Law School Stadium. He pitched five innings and picked up the win for his first professional victory.

**2019:** Olson was 4-7 with a 4.66ERA in 27 games – 14 starts – with Wisconsin in 2019. Olson walked 47 and struck out 84 in 94-2/3 innings.

**LAST START:** Olson won at Peoria [on July 14](#). He allowed two runs on three hits with two walks and seven strikeouts over five innings.

**VS. SOUTH BEND (2021):** Olson lost his only start against the Cubs in 2021. He allowed five runs on nine hits over 4-1/3 innings with two walks and five strikeouts on [June 12 at South Bend](#).

## SOUTH BEND STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP JOE NAHAS:** The Chicago Cubs signed Nahas as a non-drafted free agent in 2019 before he returned to Georgia Southern for his senior season.

**ON THE CAPE:** Nahas was pitching for Cotuit in the Cape Cod League after he was not drafted in 2019. He was 1-1 with a 1.50 ERA in five games – two starts – with Cotuit. He walked six and struck out 27 in 18 innings pitched there.

**STATE OF GEORGIA:** Nahas went 2-0 with a 4.78 ERA in fourteen games – six starts – in his lone season at Georgia Southern. He walked fourteen and struck out 42 over 43-1/3 innings pitched.

**IN MARYLAND:** Nahas pitched as a freshman at the University of Maryland-Baltimore County and went to Chesapeake College for his sophomore season before transferring to Georgia Southern.

**2019:** Nahas was 0-2 with a 5.74 ERA in eleven games – two starts – for the AZL Cubs-1 and Eugene after signing with Chicago. He walked eleven and struck out 20 in 15-2/3 innings pitched as a pro in 2019.

**ON THE BEACH:** Nahas started the 2021 season with the Myrtle Beach Pelicans. He was 2-1 with a 2.70 ERA in nine games – one start – before his promotion to South Bend.

**LAST START:** Nahas had a no decision against the [Cedar Rapids Kernels at home on July 14](#). He allowed three runs on five hits with a walk and two strikeouts over 4-1/3 innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Nahas has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will face an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
