Friday: RubberDucks 3, Curve 0: Cleveland Indians rehabbing catcher Roberto Pérez worked with left-hander Adam Scott for six hitless innings, and Akron was a strike away from pitching a combined no-hitter. Altoona first baseman Mason Martin hit a two-out, 3-2 pitch for a single to left field off **Nic Enright** in the ninth inning for the only Curve hit. Akron pitching has tossed 20 consecutive scoreless innings. The last RubberDucks no-hitter was July 11, 2015 (Ryan Merritt, 7 innings vs. Reading at Canal Park).

Rehab week continues with Clement Saturday: 2018-19 RubberDuck Ernie Clement is the third Cleveland Indian to play for Akron this week on a rehab assignment. He was placed on the Injured List Aug. 26. Catcher Roberto Pérez, placed on the 10-day Injured List Aug. 6 with right shoulder inflammation, played three games Tuesday (5 innings), Thursday and Friday (6 innings each), going a combined 5-for-10 with two doubles and three RBIs. He has caught 17 consecutive scoreless innings of Akron pitching. Aaron Civale (right middle finger sprain since June 24) allowed one earned run and struck out six batters in a five-inning start Wednesday to earn a win.

New-look RubberDucks: Since July 30, four lineup regulars have joined Akron from High-A Lake County - infielders Brayan Rocchio and Victor Nova and outfielders Will Brennan and George Valera. Rocchio had a nine-game hitting streak Aug. 10-19 and four homers in six games Aug. 12-17, and now has six homers and 24 RBIs in 30 games. Nova has seven hits (two doubles) in nine games. Brennan is hitting .268 with two homers in 26 games. Valera is 10-for-37 with a home run and nine RBIs in 10 games. Valera (#2), Rocchio (#7) and Brennan (#29) are all Top-30 Indians prospects (MLB.com).

**Playoff race:** Akron has the best record in the Double-A Northeast, with 14 games to play. Bowie is 4.5 games back and would play Akron in a best-of-five championship if the season ended today. Somerset is five games back, and Portland is 6.5 back. Akron has six more with Somerset. The Patriots play two more in Bowie this week. Akron's magic number (combination of RubberDucks wins and losses by the third-place club needed) to clinch a playoff berth is 10.

Home cooking: The RubberDucks won their first six home games and are 34-18 at Canal Park. In 2019, the RubberDucks were 30-40 at home - their first losing record at Canal Park since 2014 (32-39).

Leading the Southwest: From June 1-Aug. 8, the RubberDucks exclusively played Southwest Division clubs for 10 consecutive series. Akron won six series and went 35-25 in that span (26-22 against winning teams, and 19-7 in July), to open a 1.5-game division lead. From June 29-Aug. 1, Akron had five straight series wins against each divisional opponent - Bowie, Altoona, Harrisburg, Richmond, Erie).

RubberDucks host Curve: Akron is playing the last of four scheduled series this season with Altoona and now leads the season series, 12-10. The Curve won four of six games June 8-13 in Altoona, where Akron won three of five July 6-10. Altoona won four of seven at Canal Park Aug. 3-8. According to MLB.com, top prospects in this series include:

Ducks split series with Patriots: In their first meeting with the Northeast Division's leader, the RubberDucks split a six-game series for the first time on the road this season by winning three of six in Somerset Aug. 24-29. The Patriots won the opener, 6-2, while Corey Kluber and Gio Urshela were on rehab assignments from the Yankees. Akron won, 5-3 in 10 innings, on Wednesday, after Somerset had tied the game on a ninth-inning home run. The Patriots came back to win, 7-3, on Thursday, scoring four in the eighth inning to seal the win. Akron won again in 10 innings, 4-2, on Friday, and then rolled to a 6-1 win Saturday. Somerset fought off a 4-0 Akron lead with six homers in Sunday's 7-4 win.

Top backstop: Bo Naylor leads Double-A Northeast catchers with 50 assists and 19 runners caught stealing (56 attempts) while behind the plate. Naylor hit just .138 (13-for-94), 1 HR, 5 RBI through 26 Double-A games. But in 49 games since June 19, Naylor is 37-for-176 (.210) with eight doubles, nine homers, 38 RBIs, and a .713 OPS. He has reached base on a hit or walk in 17 of his last 21 games, with hits in 12 of those games. He has two of Akron's three grand slams in 2021.

Tough competition: The RubberDucks (66-39, .629) have the best record in the Double-A Northeast, 4.5 games ahead of Bowie (61-43), five ahead of Somerset, and 6.5 ahead of Portland. Akron has played 70 of its 105 games against winning teams (40-30 in those games). Only Harrisburg (81), Erie (72) and Reading (72) have played more such games in the league. By comparison, Somerset has played 64 such games, Bowie has played 63, and Portland has played 12 against a winning team.

Limited experience: Among 25 active RubberDucks, two played as high as Double-A before this season. Both are left-handed pitchers who appeared for Akron in 2019: Adam Scott (4-6, 3.94 ERA in 14 Akron starts in 2019), and Ben Krauth (1-3, 4.66 ERA in 56 relief IP in 2019).

Pilkington held Somerset scoreless until the third inning, when a double and walk put two runners on base, but he got a double play to limit the damage to a run. He did not allow another run in his fifth straight five-inning appearance. Dakody Clemmer (2 IP), Skylar Arias (1 IP) and Aaron Pinto (1 IP) provided scoreless relief.

2020: Entered the season rated by MLB Pipeline as the No. 24 prospect in the White Sox organization.

### **2021 RUBBERDUCKS FIELD STAFF**

**#24 Rouglas Odor**, *Manager* (Second Season) – Odor, 53, became the 18<sup>th</sup> manager in club history when he led the club in 2019. The RubberDucks posted a 61-79 record, good for fifth in the Eastern League Western Division following a 34-35 first half record. Odor has twelve seasons of managerial experience where he has compiled a career record of 422-442 (.488).

When Odor was Akron's hitting coach in 2014, he became the first person to wear the uniforms of the Canton-Akron Indians, Akron Aeros, and Akron RubberDucks. He played 197 games for Canton-Akron during the 1991, 1993-94 seasons, and he was the hitting coach for the Aeros' 2012 Eastern League Championship squad.

The 2021 season is Odor's 34<sup>th</sup> in the Cleveland organization as a player or coach (21<sup>st</sup> as a coach). The former shortstop was a 32<sup>nd</sup>-round draft pick by the Indians in 1988 and played in the minor leagues for the Indians from 1988-94 and for the Milwaukee Brewers organization in 1995. The 2019 season was Odor's first as a manager since 2008. He managed San Felipe in the Venezuelan Summer League (1999-2000), the Burlington Indians (2001-2004), the Mahoning Valley Scrappers (2005-2006), Gulf Coast League Indians (2007-2008). In 2009, Odor began serving as hitting coach for the Kinston Indians (2009-2010), Double-A Akron Aeros (2011-2012), High-A Carolina Mudcats (2013), Double-A Akron RubberDucks (2014), and Triple-A Columbus Clippers (2015-2017).

The Maracaibo, Venezuela, native resides in Winter Haven, Florida, with his wife, Milagros. He has three sons and is the uncle of Texas Rangers infielder Rougned Odor.

#35 Owen Dew, *Pitching Coach* (1st Season) — Owen Dew, 32, makes his first visit to Akron after serving as the pitching coach for the Lake County Captains in the Class-A Midwest league in 2019. Dew began his baseball journey as a right-handed pitcher for Seminole State College of Florida (2008-2009), before moving to the University of Central Florida in 2010, when he was drafted in the 21st round of the 2010 amateur draft by the Cleveland Indians. That same year, Dew advanced through Mahoning Valley with a strong 2.64 ERA in nine starts for the Scrappers. At Class-A Lake County, Dew was converted to a relief pitcher where he appeared in 15 games over the 2010 and 2011 seasons. In Dew's final season as a player, the right hander appeared in 34 games, accruing 70 innings and posted a 3.86 ERA with 41 strikeouts.

Since his playing career, Dew served as an assistant coach at Seminole State College of Florida while also assisting the Cleveland Indians as an associate scout from 2014-2017. Dew was then appointed as a full-time minor league pitching coach within the organization, making stops with the Mahoning Valley (2017), Arizona League Indians 2 (2018), and Lake County Captains (2019). The 2019 Lake County Captains pitching staff posted a team ERA of 3.73 over 1191 innings, good for eighth in the Midwest League.

#16 Junior Betances, Hitting Coach (First Season) — Betances, 47, hits Akron for the first time in his 21-year coaching career with the Cleveland Indians organization. After posting a .289 batting average over 165 games in 1998-1999 with the Akron Aeros, Betances joined the coaching ranks in various roles for the Cleveland Indians Dominican Summer League team from 2000-2010. Betances then served as Arizona League Indians coach from 2010-2015, and moved to Lake County in 2017 as the Bench coach for Manager Larry Day. The native of La Vega, Dominican Republic, Betances has developed a wealth of experience in various player development roles within the Indians organization.

**#28 Mike Mergenthaler**, *Bench Coach* (*First Season*) — Mergenthaler, 32, moves up the Indians farm system to Akron in 2021, following his 2019 season serving as the Lynchburg Hillcats bench coach for Manager Jim Pankovits. In 2018 and 2019, Merganthaler worked as a hitting coach for the Cleveland Indians' and Milwaukee Brewers' joint Dominican Super League team. The Thiells, NY, native was drafted as a player in the 32<sup>nd</sup> round of the 2011 amateur draft by the San Francisco Giants, playing in their system for parts of 2011 and 2012.

Jacob Legan, Athletic Trainer (First Season) — Legan heads to Akron for the first time in his six-year career with the Cleveland Indians. Legan previously served as the Lynchburg Hillcats' athletic trainer in 2019.

Scott Nealon, Strength and Conditioning Coach (Second Season, not consecutive) — Nealon enters his eighth season in the Cleveland Indians organization, returning to the same position he held in 2016 for the RubberDucks Eastern League Championship season. Nealon was the Triple-A Columbus strength and conditioning coach the last three seasons (2017-2019), including the Clippers' 2019 Governor's Cup championship season. Previously, Nealon served as strength and conditioning coach for the Carolina Mudcats (2013-2014), Lynchburg Hillcats (2015), before he made his way to Double-A Akron. Nealon earned his master's degree in exercise science from Baldwin Wallace University in Berea, Ohio.
