WHAT A HOMESTAND

One of the best homestands in South Bend history came to a conclusion on Sunday with the Cubs 5-1 victory over the TinCaps. After rattling off 8-straight wins to start the homestand, the Cubs ultimately went 11-1 against Peoria and Fort Wayne.

Sunday Joe Nahas made his first start of the season and became the first SB Cub starter to go 6 innings, he allowed 1 run in South Bend's first quality start. The offense was powered by Jake Washer who in his first game of the series scored 3 times, drove in 3 and finished a triple shy of the cycle. His 3-run HR in the 6th broke the game open and made it 5-1.

In their last 3 games the Cubs scored 27 runs on 46 hits and gave up just 10 runs on 19 hits.

CLUTCH MERV

Matt Mervis is 7 of his last 9 in the 8th inning or later, with 3 HRs, all of which either tied the game or gave the Cubs the lead. Mervis was last week's MWL Player of the Week. He leads the league in AVG (.350) and is 2nd in RBIs (29) and OPS (1.039). He was promoted to AA Tennessee this morning.

PINANGO POWER

In three consecutive at-bats from Friday and Saturday, South Bend Cubs slugger Yohendrick Pinango hit a home run. On Friday, the round trippers came in consecutive innings against lefty Danny Denz. The first was a long two run homer, while the second was South Bend's second grand slam of the season and series. Owen Caissie owns the other. On Saturday in the 1st inning, Pinango did it again and has eight RBI in his last 3 games.

WASH THIS

Jake Washer currently has a 10-game hitting streak, tied for the active longest in the MWL. He's only played 12 games

but has 19 hits, 9 XBH, 5 HRs (had 2 in 2021) is batting .432 and slugging .864

CAISSIE COMING ON

19-year-old Cubs top-10 prospect Owen Caissie had a slow start to the season but is coming off a great series. In Tuesday's game with the Cubs down 7-2 he hit a grand slam and the Cubs came back won 9-7 on a Mervis Walk off HR. In 5 games last week he went 8-17 with 7 RBI, and a HR

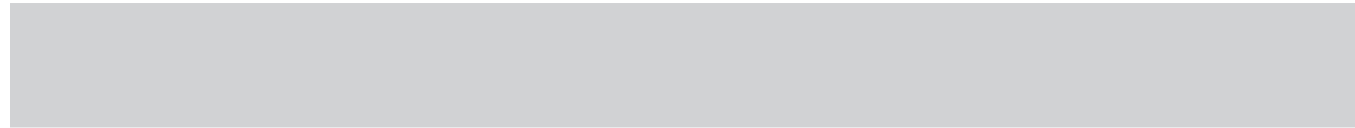

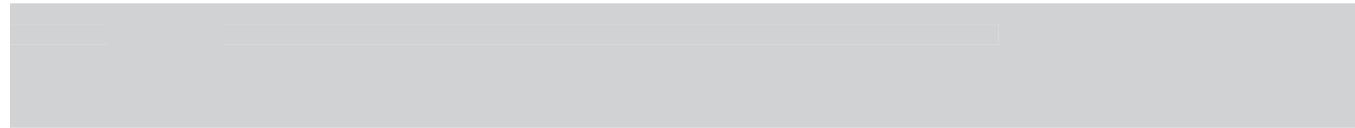

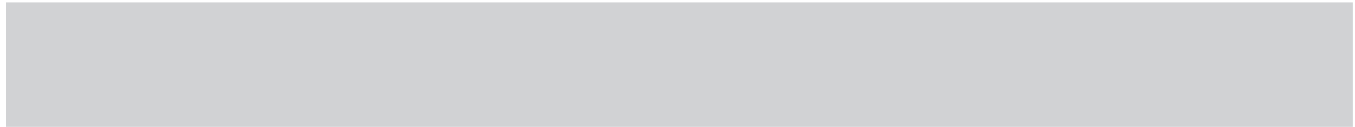
