ABOUT LAST NIGHT: A five-run second inning carried the Buffalo Bisons to a 5-3 win over the Indianapolis Indians on Thursday night at Victory Field. After a scoreless first inning, the Bisons scored five runs off Sean Sullivan to break the game open early in the second frame. Jonatan Clase capped the offensive outburst with a three-run homer, his sixth of the season. The Indians got on the board with a solo home run by Ryan Kreidler in the sixth inning. It was his fifth of the Triple-A season and first with Indianapolis. Indy mounted a comeback in the ninth inning but fell two runs short. With a pair of runners aboard, Jase Bowen smashed a two-run triple to cut the deficit, 5-3. Thomas Harrington was reinstated from the 7-day injured list today and started, tossing a perfect first inning with one strikeout. Sullivan took over in the second inning. CJ Van Eyk tossed 5.0 scoreless innings for Buffalo with two hits, two walks and four strikeouts.

SPREE STOPS AT THREE: The Indians are currently on their fourth three-game skid of the season, which is their longest losing streak on the campaign. Indy currently stands as the only Triple-A club to have not sustained a losing streak of four or more games this season. This is the first time since 2006 that the Indians have not a losing streak of three-plus games to this point in the season. That season, the Indians endured seven three-game losing streaks but were never vanquished in four straight. If the Indians were to win tonight and continue to stave off a four-game losing streak, they would be the first Triple-A team to finish a season without losing four or more game in a row since Tacoma in 2021.

ALIKA OWNS AUGUST Alika Williams today was named the Indians' August Player of the Month. Williams has hit safely in 18 of 21 games in August, including a 12-game hitting streak from Aug. 14-27. In the month, he ranks among International League hitters in home runs (T-5th, 6), batting average (6th, .354), hits (7th, 29), runs scored (T-7th, 19), total bases (9th, 52), OPS (10th, 1.047) and RBI (T-10th, 19). Williams surpassed his career highs in a calendar month in home runs (previously: June 2022, 5), hits (June 2025, 27), runs scored (16, July 2024, 16), RBI (Aug. 2021, 18) and OPS (.950, Sept. 2021). Additionally, he's posted the highest OPS in a month by an Indians' hitter (min. 80 PA) since Henry Davis (1.052) in May 2024. He also bested Nick Solak's 45 total bases in April and Ji Hwan Bae's 18 runs in the same month for the best marks on the team this season and is tied with Nick Yorke this month for the most hits.

RAFA RAKES: Catcher Rafael Flores recorded his third-career triple last night, a part of a 3-for-4 effort in the loss. He joined Brett Sullivan on June 4 at Memphis as the second Indians' catcher this season to record three-plus hits and a triple in a game this year. Before Sullivan, Jacob Stallings was the last to do so, on Aug. 7, 2018, vs. Lehigh Valley. It's the sixth time since at least 2005 that an Indians' catcher has done so in a game and the first time it has occurred twice in one season. Since his career-high matching four-hit day on Aug. 21 at Syracuse, he ranks among International League hitters in hits (T-3rd, 12), RBI (T-5th, 9), total bases (7th, 21), batting average (T-6th, .444) and OPS (9th, 1.262). Flores has hit safely in 11 of his last 13 games since Aug. 13 at Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, good for a .333 batting average (17-for-51) with a double, three homers, 12 RBI and a .966 OPS in that span.

PAIR O' PIRATES: Left-handed pitcher Tim Mayza and right-handed pitcher Justin Lawrence both had their rehab assignments transferred from Single-A Bradenton prior to yesterday's game. Mayza, 33, was placed on the 15-day IL on April 19 with a left shoulder lat strain and was later transferred to the 60-day IL on April 24. Before his stint on the injury list, Mayza appeared in seven games for Pittsburgh and pitched to a 2.45 ERA (3er/9.1ip) with eight strikeouts and a 1.07 WHIP. He's made three rehab appearances between Bradenton and Indy and has allowed one run across 3.2 innings of work, good for a 2.45 ERA. Lawrence, 30, did not allow a run in 10 of 11 appearances with Pittsburgh before being placed on the 15-day IL on April 24 and being transferred to the 60-day IL on May 3 with right elbow inflammation. He has not allowed a hit in any of his three rehab appearances between Bradenton and Indy and has pitched to a 2.70 ERA (1er/3.1ip) with a 0.90 WHIP across those outings.

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP: The Indianapolis Indians and Buffalo Bisons play in Game 4 of their six-game series from Victory Field tonight at 7:05 PM. RHP Drake Fellows will take the mound for Indy for his 15th start and 29th appearance of the season. Fellows has logged the most starts by an Indians' pitcher with at least 30 appearances in a season since Cam Alldred in 2023 (31 G, 17 GS). In six home starts this season, Fellows has pitched to a 2.19 ERA (6er/24.2ip) with 22 strikeouts and a 1.01 WHIP. This will be Fellows' first-career appearance against the Bisons. He will be opposed by fellow right Adam Kloffenstein in his 13th start and 16th appearance of the season for Buffalo. Kloffenstein has faced the Indians' once in his career, on April 6 at Victory Field while with Memphis, and he allowed five runs on three hits and five walks in 4.1 innings of work.

ON THIS DATE IN 2009: Third baseman Neil Walker and left fielder Brian Myrow combined to drive in nine of the 12 Indians' runs in a shutout win at Toledo. Walker went 3-for-5 with three runs scored and five RBI as he began the scoring with a two-run homer in the second inning and tacked on with a fifth-inning three-run shot. Myrow hit a three-run home run of his own in the sixth and finished 2-for-4 with two runs scored and four RBI. Indy's bullpen held the Mud Hens hitless through the final three innings after they only recorded three off starter Brad Lincoln.

TONIGHT'S PITCHER

Drake Fellows: He will be making his 15th start of the season and his 35th career start compared to 34 career relief appearances.

Last Outing: Fellows allowed three runs (two earned) on five hits and three walks while striking out one on Aug. 23 at Syracuse.

Against the Bisons: This will mark Fellows' first career start against Buffalo.

Fellows Posts Zeroes: Fellows owns the longest scoreless streak by an Indians pitcher this season, tossing 15.0 scoreless frames across four starts from July 12-31.

May Flowers: Fellows was named the Indians May Player of the Month earlier this season. In six appearances, he ranked sixth among Triple-A pitchers with at least 15.0 innings pitched in ERA (1.15, 2er/15.2ip) and 11th in WHIP (0.96). He was the first Indians reliever to earn the award since Hunter Stratton in Aug. 2023.

Fab Five: Fellows picked up a win in a career and team-high five straight decisions from April 20-May 31. He pitched to a 2.08 ERA (5er/21.2ip) with 25 strikeouts in nine appearances across that stretch.

Miscellaneous: Selected by San Diego in the sixth round (173rd overall) of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of Vanderbilt (Nashville, Tenn.) University... Acquired by Pittsburgh from San Diego on Jan. 19, 2021 with RHP David Bednar, OF Hudson Head and LHP Omar Cruz in exchange for RHP Joe Musgrove; New York (NL) received LHP Joey Lucchesi from San Diego and sent C Endy Rodriguez to Pittsburgh.
